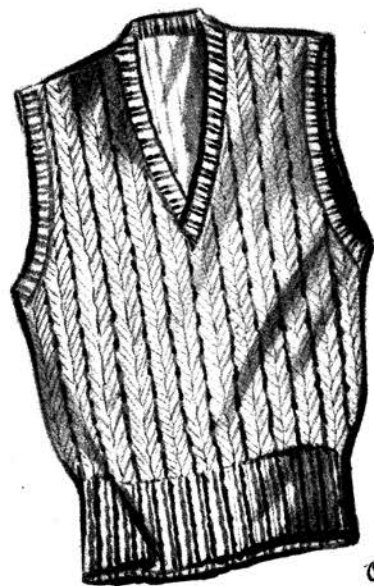

## Herringbone Sleeveless Sweater

No. BM-449

### MATERIALS:

5—2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn for size 38.  
6—2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn for sizes 40 and 42.  
1 pr. #1 knitting needles (Standard)  
1 pr. #3 knitting needles (Standard)  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 in.; 10 rows to 1 in.

Directions written for size 38. Sizes 40 and 42 written in parentheses.

**PATTERN:** Multiple of 7 sts. plus 1

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: \* K 2 tog, k 2, inc. 1 st. (by knitting 1 st. in next st. of row below in back, then k the next st.) k 2, repeat from \* across row, end k 3.

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K 3, \* inc. 1 st. as in row 2, k 2, k 2 tog, k 2, repeat from \* across row, end k 2 tog.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern.

**BACK:** With #1 needles, cast on 148 (152, 156) sts. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 4 ins. Inc. 3 sts. for size 40, 6 sts. for size 42; 148 (155, 162) sts. on needle. Change to #3 needles. Work even in pattern until piece measures 15 (16, 16) ins. from start or desired length to underarm. Place 11 (12, 12) sts. from each side on holders. Dec. 1 st. at beg. and end of every row 10 (11, 11) times. Work

## Golf Club Mitts

No. BM-450

### MATERIALS:

1—4 oz. skein "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted (M. C.)  
1—2 oz. skein "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted (C. C.)  
Suggested colors: M.C. #55; C.C. white  
1 pr. #5 knitting needles (Standard)  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 5 sts. to 1 inch; 7 rows to 1 inch

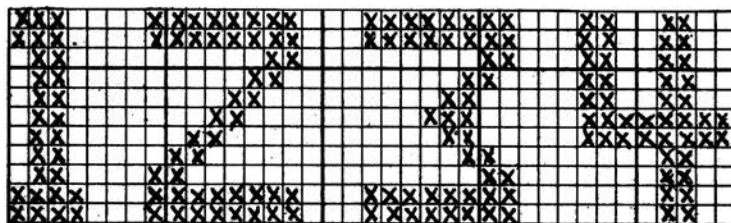
With M. C. cast on 32 sts. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 5 ins. Change to stockinette st. and work 20 rows ending with a p row. Next row dec. for top as follows: Row 1: \* K 2 tog., k 6 repeat from \* across row, end k 6. Row 2: Purl. Row 3: \* K 2 tog., k 5 repeat from \* across row, end k 5. Row 4: Purl. Row 5: \* K 2 tog., k 4 repeat from \* across row, end k 4. Row 6: Purl. Row 7: \* K 2 tog., k 3, repeat from \* across row, end k 3. Row 8: Purl. Row 9: \* K 2 tog., k 2 repeat from \* across row, end k 2. Row 10: Purl. Break yarn, draw through remaining sts. Fasten off. Make four more golf mitts the same.

Work numbers in duplicate st. (1, 2, 3 and 4) in C. C. in center of each mitt according to chart. The fifth mitt is plain to be used as a spare.

Weave back seam.

**CONNECTING CHAIN:** Tie in double strand of cc to top of 1st golf mitt. Make a chain of 5 inches, connect to top of 2nd golf mitt. Continue in this manner connecting the 5 mitts.

**POM-PONS:** (Make 5) Wind 60 strands of mc around a 2-inch cardboard. Tie in center. Trim into a ball. Attach one pom-pon to each mitt.

## Man's Ice Boat Slipover

### MATERIALS:

5-4 oz skeins "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted (M. C.) for sizes 38, 40 and 42  
A few yards of "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted each of 4 contrasting colors for ice boat

Suggested Colors: M. C.—white

C. C.—1st C. C.—#654

2nd C. C.—#658

3rd C. C.—#1095

4th C. C.—#57

1 pr. #2 knitting needles (Standard)

1 pr. #5 knitting needles (Standard)

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 5 sts. to 1 inch; 7 rows to 1 inch

Directions are written for size 38. Sizes 40 and 42 written in parentheses.

**BACK:** With #2 needles, cast on 96 (102, 108) sts. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 4 ins. Change to #5 needles and stockinette st. until piece measures 15 (15½, 16) ins. from start or desired length to underarm. Bind off 6 sts at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at the

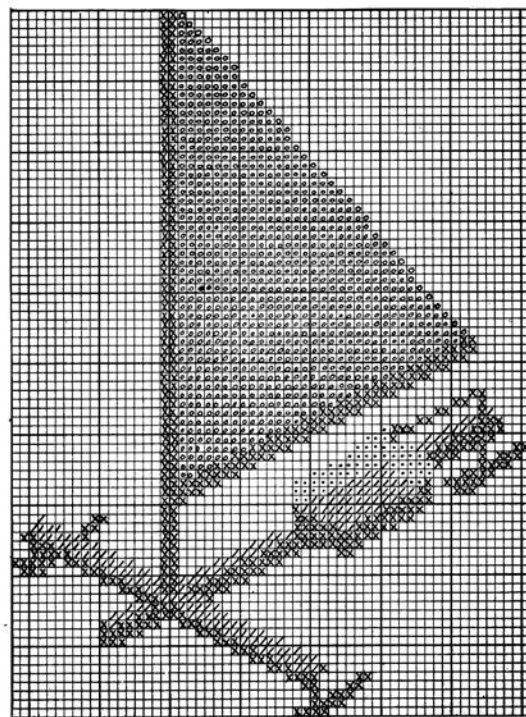

beg. and end of every other row 6 times, 72 (78, 84) sts. on needle. Work even until armhole measures 8½ (8¾, 9) ins. from first bind off. Bind off 12 (13, 14) sts. at the beg. of the next 4 rows. Change to #2 needles and on remaining 24 (26, 28) sts., k 1, p 1 in ribbing for ¾ inch. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

**FRONT:** Work same as for back until armhole is shaped, 72 (78, 84) sts. on needle. On next k row work across 36 (39, 42) sts., place remaining sts. on a holder. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge every other row until 24 (26, 28) sts. remain. Work even until armhole measures 8½ (8¾, 9) ins. from first bind off. Bind off 12 (13, 14) sts. at armhole side 2 times. Tie in yarn to other side and work to correspond, reversing shaping.

**SLEEVES:** With #2 needles, cast on 54 sts. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 4 inches. Change to #5 needles and stockinette st. Inc. 4 (4, 6) sts. evenly spaced in first row. Inc. 1 st. on each side every 8th row until 82 (82, 84) sts. are on needle. Work even until sleeve measures 19 (20, 21) ins. from start or desired sleeve length. Bind off 6 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. and end of every other row until cap measures 5½ (5¾, 6) ins. Bind off 3 sts. at the beg. of the next 6 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

**FINISHING:** Front neck band—with #2 needles, pick up 89 sts. around front of neck. Place a marker on needle on either side of center st. K 1, p 1 in ribbing, decreasing 1 st., before first marker and 1 st. after second marker every other row for ¾ inch. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place. Work design in duplicate st. according to chart on center 59 sts.

# Norwegian Ski Sweater

No. BM-451

## MATERIALS:

6-2 oz. skeins "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted (M. C.) for sizes 38 and 40.  
7-2 oz. skeins "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted (M. C.) for size 42.  
1-2 oz. skein "Botany" Germantown Knitting Worsted in each of 2 contrasting colors (1st C. C.—2nd C. C.)  
Suggested colors: M. C.—#860

1st C. C.—white

2nd C. C.—black

1 pr. #2 knitting needles (Standard)

1 pr. #5 knitting needles (Standard)

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 5 sts. to 1 inch; 7 rows to 1 inch

Directions written for size 38. Sizes 40 and 42 written in parentheses.

**BACK:** With #2 needles and M. C. cast on 104 (108, 112) sts. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for  $3\frac{1}{4}$  ins. Change to #5 needles and stockinette st. until piece measures 14 ( $14\frac{1}{2}$ , 15) ins. from start. Work design according to chart. After 1 inch, shape armholes as follows: Bind off 7 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. and end of next row. 88 (92, 96) sts. on needle. Work even until armhole measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $8\frac{3}{4}$ , 9) ins. from first bind off. At same time when design has been completed work in M. C. and stockinette st. Bind off 15 (15, 16) sts. at the beg. of the next 4 rows. Change to

# J-Shirt

No. BM-452

## MATERIALS:

5-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.) for size 38  
6-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.) for sizes 40 and 42  
1-2 oz. skein "Botany" Sock and Sweater Yarn (C. C.) for all sizes  
Suggested colors: M. C.—white; C. C. #594

1 pr. #1 knitting needles (Standard)

1 pr. #3 knitting needles (Standard)

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 inch; 10 rows to 1 inch.

Directions are written for size 38. Sizes 40 and 42 written in parentheses.

### Pattern Stripe:

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17: M. C. knit.

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18: M. C. purl.

Row 19: C. C. knit.

Row 20: C. C. purl.

Row 21: Same as row 1.

Row 22: Same as row 2.

Row 23: Same as row 19.

Row 24: Same as row 20.

Repeat these 24 rows for pattern.

**BACK:** With #1 needles, cast on 152 (160, 168) sts. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 3 ins. Change to #3 needles and pattern until piece measures 13 ( $13\frac{1}{2}$ , 14) inches from start or desired length to underarm. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. and end of every other row 15 times. Work even until armhole measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $8\frac{3}{4}$ , 9) ins. from first bind off. Place first and last 32 (33, 34) sts. on holders for shoulders. Bind off center sts.

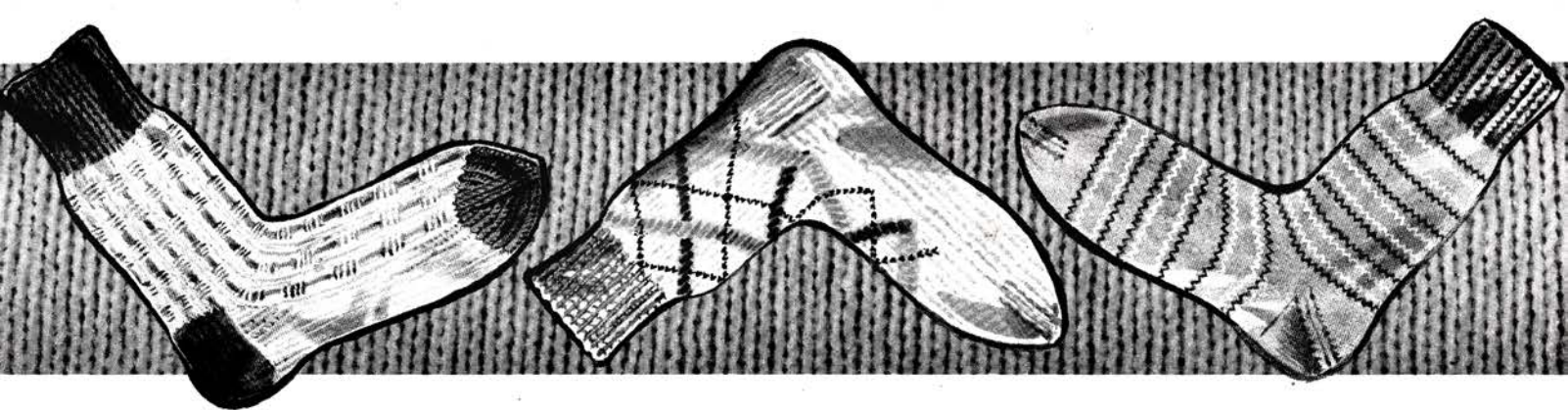
**FRONT:** Work exactly like the back.

**SLEEVES:** With M. C. cast on 104 (108, 112) sts. With M. C. work 8 rows of stockinette st. Start with Row 19 of pattern and continue in pattern until sleeve measures 3 ins., making sure that you end with same row at underarm as back and front. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. and end of every other row 15 times. Bind off remaining sts.

**FINISHING:** Weave side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place being careful to match stripes. Fold neck  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch to inside and hem neatly.







## Two-Tone Socks

No. BM-453

### MATERIALS:

1-2 oz. skein "Botany" Aquatones (M. C.)  
1-2 oz. skein "Botany" Saxatones (C. C.)  
1 set #1 d. p. needles (Standard)  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 9 sts. to 1 in.; 12 rounds to 1 in.

**PATTERN:** Multiple of 6 sts.

*Rounds 1, 3, 5, 7:* Knit.

*Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8:* K 4 \* p 1, k 5 repeat from \* around, end p 1, k 1.

*Rounds 9, 11, 13, 15:* Knit.

*Rounds 10, 12, 14, 16:* \* K 3, p 3 repeat from \* around.

Repeat these 16 rounds for pattern.

**LEG:** With C. C. cast on 72 sts. Divide sts. on 3 needles. Join, being careful not to twist. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 3 inches. Change to M. C. and pattern until sock measures  $9\frac{3}{4}$  ins. from start or desired length to back of heel.

**HEEL:** On first needle, k 20 sts., slip remaining sts. from first needle on to 2nd needle. Tie in C. C. and p back over 20 sts. and p 17 sts. from 3rd needle. Slip remaining sts. on to 2nd needle (35 sts. along instep). Work back and forth on 37 heel sts. in stockinette st. always slipping first st. on each row for 30 rows. Turn heel. Slip 1, k 21 sts., slip 1, k 1, psso, k 1, turn. Slip 1, p 8, p 2 tog., p 1, turn. Slip 1, k 9, slip 1, k 1, psso, k 1. Continue to work in same manner until 23 sts. remain on needle.

**GUSSET:** With M. C. and same needle, pick up and k 16 sts. along side of heel. Work in pattern across 35 instep sts. With another needle, pick up and k 16 sts. along other side of heel and k 11 sts. from heel on to same needle (28 sts. on first needle, 35 sts. on 2nd needle, 27 sts. on 3rd needle). Continue in pattern on instep sts. \* Work 1 round even. First needle—k to within 3 sts. of end, k 2 tog., k 1. Work in pattern

## Plaid Socks

No. BM-454

### MATERIALS:

2-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.)

A few yards of Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn each of 3 contrasting colors.

Suggested colors: M. C.—#1037

C. C.—1st C. C.—#990

2nd C. C.—#295

3rd C. C.—#57

1 pr. #3 knitting needles (Standard)

1 set #3 d. p. needles

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 in.; 10 rnds. to 1 in.

**LEG:** With M. C. and #3 knitting needles cast on 68 sts. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Work pattern according to chart to heel. Place first and last 16 sts. on holder for heel and continue in pattern on 36 sts. until chart is completed. Leave these sts. on holder.

**HEEL:** (32 sts.) *Row 1:* \* Slip 1, k 1, repeat from \* across. *Row 2:* Slip 1, p to end of row. Repeat these 2 rows until 36 rows have been completed. Turn heel: K 20, slip 1, k 1, psso, turn. Slip 1, p 10, p 2 tog., turn. Slip 1, k 10, slip 1, k 1, psso, turn. Continue in this manner until 12 sts. remain. Pick up 18 sts. on each side of heel. Work in stockinette st., decreasing 1 st. on each side every other row until 32 sts. remain. Work even until piece measures same length as to instep. Using d. p. needles, divide sts. so that there are 16 sts. on first needle, 32 sts. (instep) on second needle and 16 sts. on third needle. K around until foot measures 2 ins. less than desired length from back of heel. For example: 8 ins. for size 10; 9 ins. for size 11; 10 ins. for size 12.

**TOE:** Place 34 instep sts. on one needle and 17 sts. on each of 2 needles. *Rnd. 1:* First needle K 1, k 2 tog., k to within last 3 sts.,

## Striped Socks

No. BM-455

### MATERIALS:

2-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.)

A few yards of Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn each of 2 contrasting colors (1st C. C.; 2nd C. C.)

Suggested Colors: M. C.—#324

C. C.—1st C. C.—#57

2nd C. C.—#1037

1 set #1 d. p. needles (Standard)

1 set #3 d. p. needles (Standard)

1 extra #3 d. p. needle

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 in.; 10 rows to 1 in.

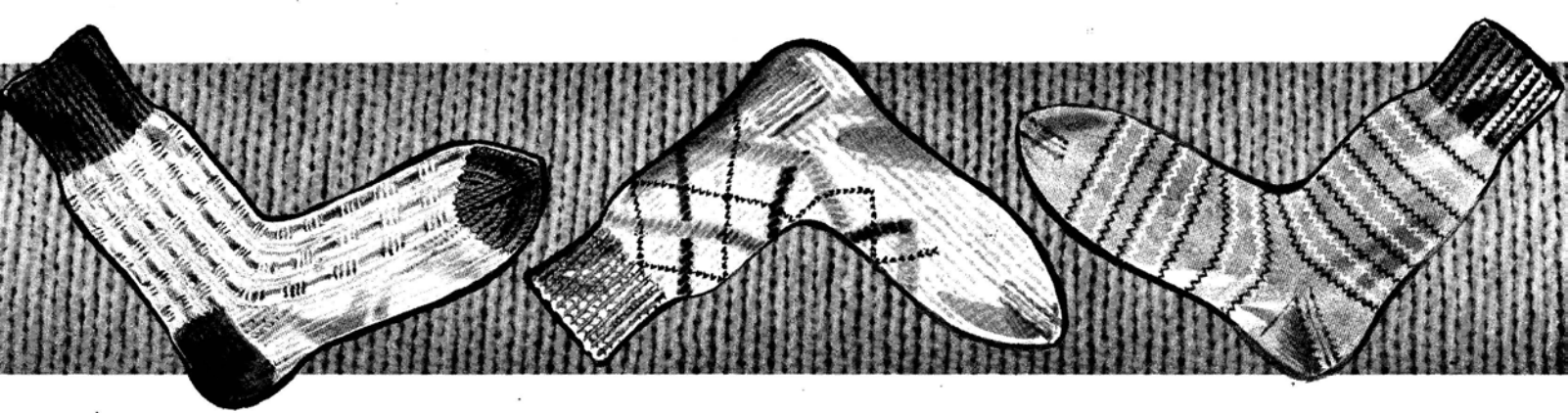
**LEG:** With M. C. and #1 d. p. needles, cast on 64 sts. (22, 22, 20). Join, being careful not to twist. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 3 ins. Change to #3 d. p. needles and work pattern stripes as follows: \* M. C.—k 8 rounds; 1st C. C.—k 1 round; M. C.—k 2 rounds; 2nd C. C.—k 1 round; M. C.—k 4 rounds; 2nd C. C.—k 1 round; M. C.—k 2 rounds; 1st C. C.—k 1 round. Repeat from \* for pattern until sock measures  $8\frac{1}{4}$  ins. from start or desired length to back of heel.

**HEEL:** (to be worked in M. C.) First needle, work 16 sts., slip remaining sts. on 2nd needle, cast on 3 sts. Cast on 37 sts. on extra needle. Slip 5 sts. from 3rd needle to 2nd needle, cast on 3 sts. on 3rd needle, k remaining 15 sts. \* Work 1 round even. Next round, k to within 3 sts. of end on first needle, k 2 tog., k 1. On extra needle, k 1, slip 1, k 1, psso, k to within 3 sts. of end of needle, k 2 tog., k 1. Third needle, k 1, slip 1, k 1, psso, k to end of needle. Repeat from \* 3 times, then dec. in same manner every round until 10 sts. remain. Slip 2 sts. from extra needle to first needle, 3 sts. from extra needle to 3rd needle. Weave heel sts. tog.

**GUSSET:** With 3rd needle, pick up and k 22 sts. of cast on sts., with first needle pick

## Two-Tone Socks

No. BM-453

### MATERIALS:

1-2 oz. skein "Botany" Aquatones (M. C.)  
1-2 oz. skein "Botany" Saxatones (C. C.)  
1 set #1 d. p. needles (Standard)  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 9 sts. to 1 in.; 12 rounds to 1 in.

**PATTERN:** Multiple of 6 sts.

*Rounds 1, 3, 5, 7:* Knit.

*Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8:* K 4 \* p 1, k 5 repeat from \* around, end p 1, k 1.

*Rounds 9, 11, 13, 15:* Knit.

*Rounds 10, 12, 14, 16:* \* K 3, p 3 repeat from \* around.

Repeat these 16 rounds for pattern.

**LEG:** With C. C. cast on 72 sts. Divide sts. on 3 needles. Join, being careful not to twist. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 3 inches. Change to M. C. and pattern until sock measures  $9\frac{3}{4}$  ins. from start or desired length to back of heel.

**HEEL:** On first needle, k 20 sts., slip remaining sts. from first needle on to 2nd needle. Tie in C. C. and p back over 20 sts. and p 17 sts. from 3rd needle. Slip remaining sts. on to 2nd needle (35 sts. for instep). Work back and forth on 37 heel sts. in stockinette st. always slipping first st. on each row for 30 rows. Turn heel. Slip 1, k 21 sts., slip 1, k 1, pssso, k 1, turn. Slip 1, p 8, p 2 tog., p 1, turn. Slip 1, k 9, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k 1. Continue to work in same manner until 23 sts. remain on needle.

**GUSSET:** With M. C. and same needle, pick up and k 16 sts. along side of heel. Work in pattern across 35 instep sts. With another needle, pick up and k 16 sts. along other side of heel and k 11 sts. from heel on to same needle (28 sts. on first needle, 35 sts. on 2nd needle, 27 sts. on 3rd needle). Continue in pattern on instep sts. \* Work 1 round even. First needle—k to within 3 sts. of end, k 2 tog., k 1. Work in pattern

## Plaid Socks

No. BM-454

### MATERIALS:

2-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.)

A few yards of Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn each of 3 contrasting colors.

Suggested colors: M. C.—#1037

C. C.—1st C. C.—#990

2nd C. C.—#295

3rd C. C.—#57

1 pr. #3 knitting needles (Standard)

1 set #3 d. p. needles

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 in.; 10 rnds. to 1 in.

**LEG:** With M. C. and #3 knitting needles cast on 68 sts. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Work pattern according to chart to heel. Place first and last 16 sts. on holder for heel and continue in pattern on 36 sts. until chart is completed. Leave these sts. on holder.

**HEEL:** (32 sts.) *Row 1:* \* Slip 1, k 1, repeat from \* across. *Row 2:* Slip 1, p to end of row. Repeat these 2 rows until 36 rows have been completed. Turn heel: K 20, slip 1, k 1, pssso, turn. Slip 1, p 10, p 2 tog., turn. Slip 1, k 10, slip 1, k 1, pssso, turn. Continue in this manner until 12 sts. remain. Pick up 18 sts. on each side of heel. Work in stockinette st., decreasing 1 st. on each side every other row until 32 sts. remain. Work even until piece measures same length as to instep. Using d. p. needles, divide sts. so that there are 16 sts. on first needle, 32 sts. (instep) on second needle and 16 sts. on third needle. K around until foot measures 2 ins. less than desired length from back of heel. For example: 8 ins. for size 10; 9 ins. for size 11; 10 ins. for size 12.

**TOE:** Place 34 instep sts. on one needle and 17 sts. on each of 2 needles. *Rnd. 1:* First needle K 1, k 2 tog., k to within last 3 sts.,

## Striped Socks

No. BM-455

### MATERIALS:

2-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.)

A few yards of Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn each of 2 contrasting colors (1st C. C.; 2nd C. C.)

Suggested Colors: M. C.—#324

C. C.—1st C. C.—#57

2nd C. C.—#1037

1 set #1 d. p. needles (Standard)

1 set #3 d. p. needles (Standard)

1 extra #3 d. p. needle

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 in.; 10 rows to 1 in.

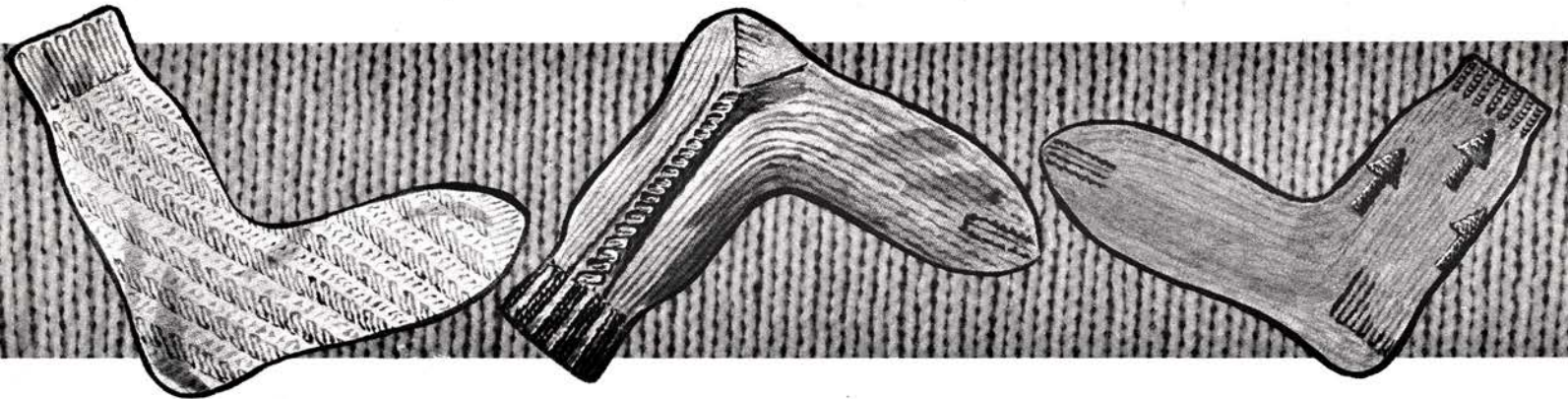
**LEG:** With M. C. and #1 d. p. needles, cast on 64 sts. (22, 22, 20). Join, being careful not to twist. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 3 ins. Change to #3 d. p. needles and work pattern stripes as follows: \* M. C.—k 8 rounds; 1st C. C.—k 1 round; M. C.—k 2 rounds; 2nd C. C.—k 1 round; M. C.—k 4 rounds; 2nd C. C.—k 1 round; M. C.—k 2 rounds; 1st C. C.—k 1 round. Repeat from \* for pattern until sock measures  $8\frac{1}{4}$  ins. from start or desired length to back of heel.

**HEEL:** (to be worked in M. C.) First needle, work 16 sts., slip remaining sts. on 2nd needle, cast on 3 sts. Cast on 37 sts. on extra needle. Slip 5 sts. from 3rd needle to 2nd needle, cast on 3 sts. on 3rd needle, k remaining 15 sts. \* Work 1 round even. Next round, k to within 3 sts. of end on first needle, k 2 tog., k 1. On extra needle, k 1, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k to within 3 sts. of end of needle, k 2 tog., k 1. Third needle, k 1, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k to end of needle. Repeat from \* 3 times, then dec. in same manner every round until 10 sts. remain. Slip 2 sts. from extra needle to first needle, 3 sts. from extra needle to 3rd needle. Weave heel sts. tog.

**GUSSET:** With 3rd needle, pick up and k 22 sts. of cast on sts., with first needle pick

## Spiral Socks

No. BM-456

### MATERIALS:

2-2 oz. skeins "Botany" Sport Yarn  
Suggested color: #950  
1 set #2 d. p. needles (Standard) for small size  
1 set #4 d. p. needles (Standard) for medium size  
1 set #5 d. p. needles (Standard) for large size  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** #2 needles—15 sts. to 2 ins.—19 rows to 2 ins. #4 needles—13 sts. to 2 ins.—17 rows to 2 ins. #5 needles—6 sts. to 1 in.—8 rows to 1 in.

Directions written for small size. Medium and large sizes written in parentheses.

**PATTERN:** Multiple of 4 sts.

*Rnds. 1, 2, 3:* \* K 2, p 2 repeat from \* around.

*Rnds. 4, 5, 6:* P 1, \* k 2, p 2, repeat from \* around end k 2, p 1.

*Rnds. 7, 8, 9:* \* P 2, k 2 repeat from \* around.

*Rnds. 10, 11, 12:* K 1, \* p 2, k 2 repeat from \* around, end p 2, k 1.

Repeat these 12 rnds. for pattern. Cast on 40 sts.

Divide sts. on 3 needles. Join, being careful not to twist. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 1½ (2, 2½) ins. Start pattern and continue to work until piece measures 10 (11, 12) ins. or desired length from start.

**TO SHAPE TOE:** Divide sock in half and work as follows: Place a marker on the 1st and 20th sts.; k 2 tog. before the marked sts., k the marked sts., k 2 tog. after the marked sts. Continue to decrease in this manner every other row until 8 sts. remain. Break yarn, leaving an 8 inch end, thread this end in a tapestry needle and draw through all sts. Fasten off.

## Cable Socks

### MATERIALS:

2-2 oz. skeins "Botany" Terratones  
Suggested color: #86  
1 set #1 d. p. needles (Standard)  
1 set #4 d. p. needles (Standard)  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 7 sts. to 1 in.; 9 rows to 1 inch.

**LEG:** With #1 d. p. needles, cast on 60 sts. Divide evenly on 3 needles. Join, being careful not to twist. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 36 rows, change to #4 d. p. needles and work pattern as follows: *Row 1:* K 2, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 20, p 2, k 6, p 2, k 18. *Row 2:* K 2, \* p 2, slip next 3 sts. to cable needle and hold in front of work, k next 3 sts., k 3 sts. from cable needle, p 2, \* k 20, repeat between \*'s, k 18. *Rows 3, 4, 5, 6:* Same as row 1. Repeat these 6 rows until sock measures 11 ins. from start or desired length to heel. Place 30 sts. on 2 needles for instep, including 3 sts. of cable at each end. On remaining 30 sts., k 1 row, p 1 row for 2 ins. Turn heel as follows: Starting on a p row, p 17, p 2 tog., p 1, turn. Slip 1, k 5, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k 1, turn. Slip 1, p 6, p 2 tog., p 1, turn. Slip 1, k 7, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k 1, turn. Slip 1, p 8, p 2 tog., p 1, turn. Continue in this manner, working 1 st. more each row until all sts. have been worked; 18 sts. on needle. Place 9 sts. on each of 2 needles. Keeping 9 sts. on needle, pick up 13 sts. along side of heel (first needle—22 sts.) Work in pattern across instep sts. (second needle—30 sts.) Pick up 13 sts. along other side of heel and k 9 sts. onto same needle (third needle—22 sts.) Shape gusset as follows: *Row 1:* \* K to last 3 sts. of first needle, k 2 tog., k 1; work in pattern across second needle; k 1, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k to end of third needle. *Row 2:* Knit. Repeat these 2 rows until there are 15 sts. on both the first and third needles. Work even keeping the instep sts. in pattern until foot measures 2 ins. less than desired length from

## Arrow Anklelets

### MATERIALS:

1-2 oz. skein Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn  
Suggested color: #55  
1 set #1 d. p. needles (Standard)  
1 set #3 d. p. needles (Standard)  
1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 in.; 10 rounds to 1 in.

**LEG:** With #1 d. p. needles, cast on 60 sts. Divide sts. evenly on 3 needles (20 sts. on each). Join being careful not to twist. K 1, p 1 in ribbing for 1 in. Change to #3 d. p. needles and k 3 rnds. even. Work in pattern as follows: *Rnds. 1, 2:* K 9, \* p 1, k 19, repeat from \* around, end k 10. *Rnds. 3, 4:* K 8, \* p 3, k 17 repeat from \* around, end k 9. *Rnds. 5, 6:* K 7, \* p 5, k 15, repeat from \* around, end k 8. *Rnds. 7, 8:* K 6, \* p 7, k 13, repeat from \* around, end k 7. *Rnds. 9 to 18:* Same as row 3. *Rnds. 19, 20:* \* K 19, p 1, repeat from \* around. *Rnds. 21, 22:* P 1, \* k 17, p 3, repeat from \* around, end p 2. *Rnds. 23, 24:* P 2, \* k 15, p 5, repeat from \* around, end p 3. *Rnds. 25, 26:* P 3, \* k 13, p 7, repeat from \* around, end p 4. *Rnds. 27 to 36:* Same as row 21. After these 36 rnds. have been completed start heel as follows: K 15 sts. from first needle, turn. P 15, then p 15 sts. from 3rd needle. Divide remaining 30 sts. on 2 needles (instep). Work back and forth on 30 heel sts. as follows. *Row 1:* \* K 1, slip 1, repeat from \* around, end k 2. *Row 2:* Purl. Repeat these 2 rows for 2½ ins. ending with row 1. To turn heel: P 17, p 2 tog., p 1, turn; slip 1, k 5, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k 1, turn; slip 1, p 6, p 2 tog., p 1, turn; slip 1, k 7, slip 1, k 1, pssso, k 1, turn; slip 1, p 8, p 2 tog., p 1, turn. Continue in this manner working 1 st. more each time until all sts. have been worked, ending with a k row (18 sts. on needle). Pick up and k 15 sts. along side of heel piece; on 2nd needle (instep), work across 30 sts. making one more arrow pattern; pick up

even until armhole measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $8\frac{3}{4}$ , 9) ins. from first bind off. Bind off 18 (18, 19) sts. at the beg. of the next 4 rows. On remaining sts. dec. to an even number of sts. and k 2, p 2 in ribbing for 1 in. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

**FRONT:** Work same as back to underarm. Dec. armhole same as back. At SAME TIME, after second dec., divide sts. in half. For size 40, dec. 1 st. in center. Place half on holder and work on other half. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge every 4th row until 36 (36, 38) sts. remain on needle. Work even until armhole measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $8\frac{3}{4}$ , 9) ins. from first bind off. Bind off 18 (18, 19) sts. at armhole side 2

times. Tie in yarn to other side and work to correspond, reversing shaping.

**FINISHING:** With #1 needles, pick up 104 (108, 108) sts. around front of neck. Mark center 2 sts. K 2, p 2, in ribbing. Dec. 1 st. on each side of marked sts. every other row for 1 in. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave shoulders tog. Place 11 (12, 12) sts. from holder at underarm on needle, tie in yarn and with #1 needles pick up 112 (114, 118) sts. around armhole to other holder, k across these sts. K 2, p 2, in ribbing for 1 in. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave underarm seams.

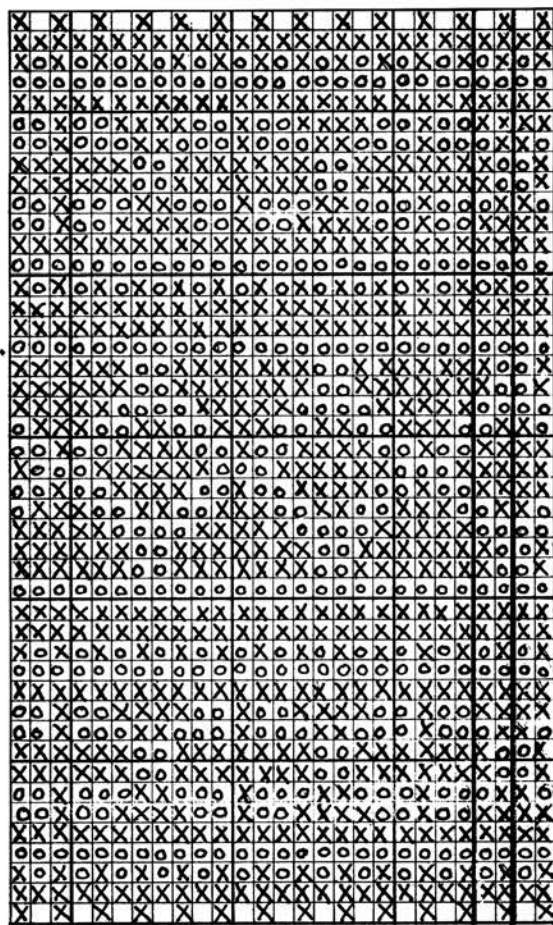

#2 needles and on remaining 28 (32, 32) sts., k 2, p 2 in ribbing for 1 inch. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

**FRONT:** Work same as for back until armhole measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$  ( $6\frac{3}{4}$ , 7) ins. from first bind off, ending with a p row. Next row shape neck as follows: K 33 (33, 35) sts., place remaining sts. on holder. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge every other row 3 times. Work even until armhole measures  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $8\frac{3}{4}$ , 9) ins. from first bind off. Bind off 15 (15, 16) sts. at armhole side 2 times. Leave center 22 (26, 26) sts. on holder for neck. Tie in yarn to other side and work to correspond reversing shaping.

**SLEEVES:** With #2 needles and M.C., cast on 54 sts. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Change to #5 needles and stockinette st., inc. 4 (4, 6) sts., in first row. Continue in stockinette st., inc. 1 st. on each side every 8th row until sleeve measures  $9\frac{1}{2}$  ins. from start. Work design according to chart, continuing to inc. as before until 82 (82, 84) sts. are on needle. Work even until sleeve measures 19 (20, 21) ins. from start or desired sleeve length. Bind off 7 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. and end of every other row until cap measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ( $5\frac{3}{4}$ , 6) ins. Bind off 3 sts. at the beg. of the next 6 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

**FINISHING:** Front neck band—with #2 needles pick up 70 (74, 74) sts. around front of neck, including sts. on holder. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 1 inch. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place.

15 sts. along other side of heel, then k 9 sts. from heel needle onto this same needle. There are now 24 sts. on each heel needle. Starting at center of heel, shape gusset as follows: Rnd. 1: First needle—k to last 3 sts., k 2 tog., k 1; 2nd needle—work in pattern; 3rd needle—k 1, slip 1, k 1, psso, k to end of rnd. Rnd. 2: First needle—k; 2nd needle—work in pattern; 3rd needle—k. Repeat these 2 rnds. until 15 sts. are on both first and 3rd needles. AT SAME TIME when arrow has been completed, k all rnds. K even until sock measures 2 ins. shorter than desired sock length from back of heel. For example: 8 ins. for size 10; 9 ins. for size 11; 10 ins. for size 12.

**TO SHAPE TOE:** Rnd 1: First needle—k to last 3 sts., k 2 tog., k 1; 2nd needle—k 1, slip 1, k 1, psso, k to last 3 sts., k 2 tog., k 1; 3rd needle—k 1, slip 1, k 1, psso, k to end of needle. Rnd 2: k. Repeat these 2 rnds. until 5 sts. are on each heel needle. Slip sts. from first and 3rd needles to one needle and weave toe tog.

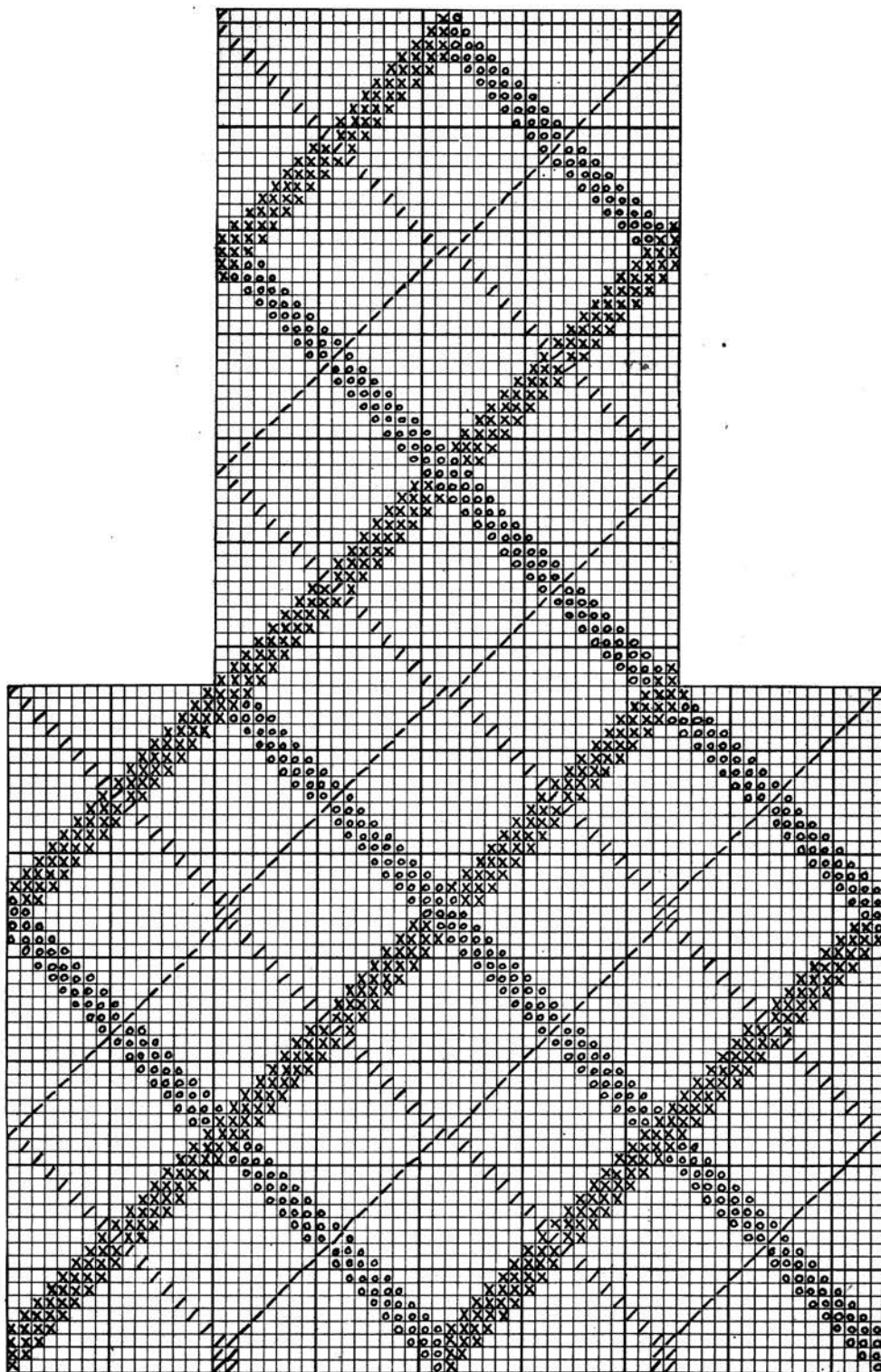

# Man's Cardigan

## MATERIALS:

5-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.) for sizes 38 and 40

6-2 oz. skeins Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (M. C.) for size 42

1-2 oz. skein Botanized 4 ply Sock and Sweater Yarn (C. C.) for all sizes

Suggested colors: M. C.—white; C. C. #124

1 pr. #1 knitting needles (Standard)

1 pr. #3 knitting needles (Standard)

#3 steel crochet hook (Standard)

24 in. open zipper

1 tapestry needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts. to 1 inch; 10 rows to 1 inch.

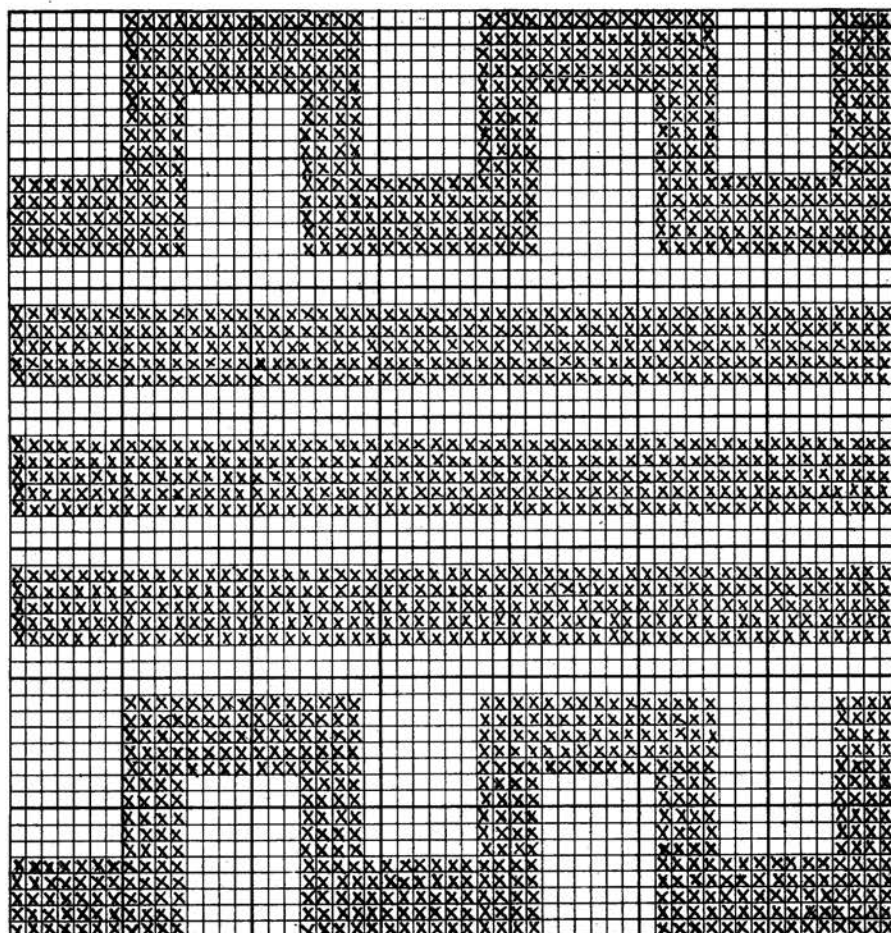
Directions are written for size 38. Sizes 40 and 42 are written in parentheses.

**BACK:** With #1 needles and M. C. cast on 156 (164, 172) sts. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 3 ins. Change to #3 needles and stockinette st. until back measures 16 (16½, 17) ins. from start or desired length to underarm. Bind off 6 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Bind off 3 sts. at the beg. of the next 4 rows. Bind off 2 sts. at the beg. of the next 4 rows. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. and end of every other row 5 times. Work even until armhole measures 8½ (8¾, 9) ins. from first bind off. Bind off 19 (20, 21) sts. at the beg. of the next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 38 (42, 46) sts.

**RIGHT FRONT:** With #3 needles and M. C., cast on 2 sts., (work starts at lower corner of side seam edge). P 1 row place a marker at seam edge. Inc. 2 sts. (k in front of st., in back of st., then in front of st.) on each side every 4th row until 78 (82, 86) rows have been worked. Dec. 2 sts. (K 3 tog.) at front edge and continue to inc. 2 sts. at seam edge every 4th row until seam edge measures 13 (13½, 14) ins. from start. Dec. 1 st. at seam edge every 3rd row 4 times. Continue to dec. at front edge as before until neck edge shaping. Work 1 in. then inc. 1 st. at seam edge every 3rd row 2 times. Start pattern with C. C. according to chart. Inc. 1 st. at seam edge every 3rd row 2 times. Inc. 1 st. at seam edge every k row for the next 3 ins. Inc. 2 sts. at seam edge every 4th row, continuing decreasing front edge as before until armhole measures 8½ (8¾, 9) ins. from first dec. Dec. 2 sts. at seam edge every 4th row for 24 rows. Neck shaping: K 12 sts. at front edge, turn. P back. K these 12 sts. again, continuing to dec. at front edge as before. P back. Bind off 4 sts. at front edge. Bind off 2 sts. at front edge 4 times. Bind off remaining sts. by dec. 2 sts. on each side every 4th row until all sts. are gone. Front band: With #1 needles and right side of work to you pick up 78 (82, 86) sts. along lower edge of front. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 3 ins. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Work left front to correspond, reversing shaping.

**SLEEVES:** With #1 needles and M. C., cast on 80 (88, 88) sts. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 3½ ins. Change to #3 needles and stockinette st. Inc. 1 st. on each side every 6th (8th, 8th) row until 136 sts. are on needle. Work even until sleeve measures 20 (20½, 21) ins. from start or desired sleeve length to underarm. Bind off 5 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Bind off 3 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Bind off 2 sts. at the beg. of the next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. on each side every row until 24 sts. remain. Bind off 8 sts. at the beg. of each row until all sts. are gone.

**FINISHING:** Weave side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in place. Neckband: With right side of work to you and #1 needles, pick up 130 sts. around neck. K 2, p 2 in ribbing for 1½ ins. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Crochet 2 rows s. c. along front edges. Sew zipper in place.
