## LADIES' PULLOVER No. 300

(Illustration on Front Cover)

### Monarch Dove

5 Balls Cherry Rose, 1 Ball Black, 3 Balls White  
1 Pair each No 10 and No. 8 Needles  
1 Fine Crochet Hook

**FRONT**—Cast on Cherry, No. 10 needles, 96 sts. K. 2, P. 2, until work measures 3 inches. Change to No. 8 needles, increase 1 st. every 16th st. to make 101 sts. on needle. **1st Pattern row**—\*K. 6, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over\*, repeat from \* to \* 5 times. K. 5, K. 2 tog., M. 1, \*K. 6, K. 2 tog., M. 1, \* repeat from \* to \* to end of needle, ending needle with K. 6. Purl back. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 3 inches from ribbing. **Next Pattern row**—\*K. 6, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, \* repeat from \* to \* 4 times. Join Black, K. 21. Join Cherry, \*K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6,\* repeat from \* to \* 4 times. Purl back, using same colors as sts. **Next Pattern row**—Pattern in Cherry as before. K. 3, in Black. Join White, K. 15 in White, K. 3 in Black. Pattern in Cherry to end of needle. Purl back, using colors same as sts. and twisting wool as each color is used. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 6 inches from ribbing. **Next Pattern row**—Pattern 3 times. Join Black, K. 19 in Black, 15 in White, 19 in Black, and continue pattern in Cherry to end of needle. Purl back and repeat next pattern row. On next purl row Cherry 24, Black 3, White 48, Black 3, Cherry 24. **Next Pattern row**—Pattern 3 times. Black 3, White 48, Black 3, Cherry pattern to end of row. Purl back, using colors as sts. Repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 9 inches from rib. On next purl row, Cherry 8, Black 19, White 48, Black 19, Cherry 8. Pattern row same colors as sts. and purl same as last purl row. Next purl row, Cherry 8, Black 3, White to within 11 sts. of end of needle, Black 3, Cherry 8. Pattern row same colors as sts., and repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 10½ inches from ribbing. Cast off 3 sts. beginning of each needle 6 times. Decrease 1 st. beginning and end of each purl row, 3 times. Knit 25 sts. Cast off for neck, leaving 25 sts. for other shoulder. Continue knitting without decreasing until armhole measures 8 inches, then cast off on armhole side 5 sts., beginning of row 5 times. Second shoulder same as 1st.

**BACK**—Same as Front until the armhole decreasing then do not decrease after the 9 are off each side. But continue work in White until armhole measures 7½ inches, K. 25. Cast off for neck and cast off from armhole side 5 at beginning of each needle 5 times. Other shoulder same.

Sew Front and Back together neatly before filling in neck with single crochet: 2 rows Black, 1 row Cherry.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 48 sts. in Cherry Rose. K. 2, P. 2, until work measures 3 inches. Join White and increase 1 every 4th st. to make 62 sts., continue one row plain, one purl, until there are 3 inches of White. Join Black K. 11, White 40, Black 11. Purl back same. **Next row**—Black 11, White 40, Black 11. On next purl row, join Cherry wool and purl 8, Black 3, White 40, Black 3, Cherry 8. **Next plain row**, in Cherry K. 6, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, Black K. 3, White K. 40, Black K. 3. Cherry K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6. Purl back, using same color as sts. Continue these last 2 rows until work measures 5 inches from ribbing. **Next Pattern row**—In Cherry, K. 6, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over. In Black K. 19, in White K. 8, Black 19, Cherry K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6. Purl back, using same color as sts. **Next pattern row** same as last pattern row. On next purl row—Cherry 24, Black 3, White 8, Black 3, Cherry 24. **Next Pattern row**—In Cherry \*K. 6 and M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, \* repeat from \* to \* twice, Black 3, White 8, Black 3, Cherry \*K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6, \* repeat from \* to \* twice. Purl back same colors as sts. On every 6th row increase 1 st. beginning and end of needle. Continue last 2 rows until work measures 7 inches from ribbing. Of course the increasing every 6th row

will make 1 st. more to knit beginning and end of needle, but when there are 9 sts. each end start new holes by K. 1, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, then continuing pattern as before. When work measures the 7 inches from ribbing, knit all White sts. in Black, making the 3 rows to match lower Black edge, after the 3 rows of Black, knit Black sts. in Cherry, therefore continuing rest of sleeve in Cherry. When work measures 14 inches from ribbing cast off 3 sts. beginning of each needle 6 times, then decrease 1 st. beginning and end of each purl row until work measures 7 inches from underarm. If more than 16 sts. remain decrease 1 st. beginning and end of every needful. When 16 sts. remain cast off.

before. 3rd stripe of Paprika. Next colored stripe cast off 7 sts., and on last row of Paprika and second row of Barbados, K. 2 last sts. tog. Next Camel stripe knit 2 first sts. tog. of each knit row. On next Colored and Camel stripe knit 2 tog. at beginning and make 1 at end of each knit row. The next colored stripe **start Shoulder**. Decrease 1 st. on every row at shoulder end and 1 at beginning of each knit row at neck end until only 2 sts. are left on needle. Cast off 2 sts. Finish buttonholes with darning stitch.

**LEFT FRONT**—With Camel wool cast on 42 sts. and work same as right front until you come to the 9th row of the second stripe of Camel. At beginning of each knit row make 1 st. and at the end of each knit row knit last two sts. tog. Continue this way with Camel stripes and Colored stripes alternately until you reach underarm. There are no buttonholes to be made on left side. On 9th and 11th rows of Camel stripe knit 2 together at each end of needle. On 10th row knit 2 tog. at end of row only. On 12th row at end only. On next Colored and next Camel stripe knit 2 tog. on end of each knit row only. Start next Colored stripe and on first purl row of Paprika cast off 7 sts. On rest of Colored and next Camel stripe knit 2 last sts. tog. every knit row. For the next Colored and next Camel stripes make 1 st. at beginning and knit 2 last sts. together on every knit row. **Start Shoulder** by knitting 2 sts. tog. on beginning and end of every knit row and on end of every purl row until there are only 2 sts. left on needles. Cast off these 2 sts.

**BACK**—With Camel wool cast on 2 sts. K. 1 row, P. 1 row, adding 1 st. at each end of knit rows and 1 st. at beginning of each purl row for 12 rows. Make Colored stripe as on front of garment. Also one Camel stripe of 12 rows and another Colored stripe with the same increasings as on first Camel stripe and at 5th row omit increasing at end of knit rows and beginning of purl rows but continue to make the 1 st. at beginning of every knit row as this forms the bottom of back of the garment. For the next 2 Colored stripes and 2 Camel stripes make 1 st. at end of each knit row. This forms armhole. The next 2 Colored stripes and 2 Camel stripes form shoulder, therefore omit making the st. at end of knit until 8th Camel row. **Start Neck**—There should be 7 Camel and 6 Colored stripes. On 9th and 11th Camel rows knit last 2 sts. tog. and on 10th and 12th rows knit first 2 sts. tog. Same decreasings on first four rows of Colored stripe. Finish Colored stripe, next Camel stripe, and another Colored decreasing at neck end on knit rows only. The next Camel stripe and Colored stripe has no decreasing at neck end. This brings work up to other shoulder. With Camel wool cast off 20 sts. to form underarm and knit 2 tog. on every row at neck end until back is finished. This forms shoulder. On 3rd row of Camel cast off 8 sts. On 5th row 5 sts., and on each other knit row 1 st. The back is finished with a small Colored stripe knitting 2 sts. tog. on every row. Cast off 3 last sts. on needles.

Finish neck and armholes, Barbados wool, with 2 rows double crochet.





## LADIES' SPORT VEST No. 303

Size 36

### Monarch Dove

3 Balls Camel 2 Balls Paprika Red 2 Balls Barbados  
1 Pair No. 10 Needles

(The entire garment is knit on the bias)

With Camel wool and No. 10 needles cast on 42 sts. K. 1, row, P. 1 row. K. 1 row, making one extra st. at each end of needle. Continue until 12 rows of Camel. With Barbados wool knit 2 rows making the extra st. at each end of the 1st row. With Paprika wool K. 1 row, P. 1 row. K. 1 row, P. 1 row, still making the extra st. on each end of the needles of knit rows. Make another ridge by knitting 2 rows with Barbados. With Camel wool start another stripe of 10 rows. On 11th row of Camel knit first 2 sts. together but continue to make a st. at end of every knit row. Purl back 12th row of Camel. With Barbados K. 2 together, knit to end of row. Knit back. With Paprika K. 1 row, P. 1 row, K. 1 row, P. 1 row. Another ridge of Barbados. Now start another stripe of Camel. On the 5th row—K. 2 together, K. 2, cast off 4, knit to end. Purl back, casting on 4 sts. over the four cast off on last row. Purl to end. This forms the first buttonhole. Finish the rest of Camel stripe. Next, make another stripe of Barbados and Paprika. Start Camel stripe, making buttonhole in 5th and 6th row as before. On 7th row, K. 2 last sts. tog. This starts underarm. On 9th and 11th rows of Camel, knit 2 last sts. tog. The next Colored and Camel stripes have no decreasings at underarm. The third buttonhole is made in the 5th and 6th rows of Camel stripe as

## LADIES' PULLOVER No. 302

Size 36

### Monarch Dove

3 Balls Flesh Beige 2 Balls Pearl 2 Balls Black  
1 Ball Paprika Red 1 Ball Banana  
1 Pair No. 8 and No. 10 Needles

**BACK**—On No. 8 needles, Beige wool, cast on 92 stitches. Knit 2, purl 2, ribbing for 6 inches, \* 4 rows Garter stitch in Paprika,  $\frac{1}{4}$  in Banana, 2 Black, 2 Pearl, 2 Beige in Stocking stitch 5 times\*. Repeat from \* to \*. 4 rows Paprika, 4 Banana in Garter stitch, change to Black and cast off 5 sts. at each end. K. 2 sts. tog. each end of knitted rows for 3 times (in stripes). Continue until stripes measure 7 inches. Cast off 22 in centre for neck. (Cast off on Black). Knit in Stocking stitch 2 Pearl, 2 Beige. 2 Black for each Shoulder. Cast off.

**FRONT**—Cast on 92 sts. K. 2, P. 2, for 6 inches. Repeat same as on Back, decreasing in same manner as back, at same time shape as follows:—For neck knit 2 tog., every other row for 3 times, then 2 tog. every full stripe until there are 27 sts. left for shoulder. Make other shoulder to correspond. Cast off and join the Shoulders with Black.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 48 sts. Beige wool, Knit 2, purl 2, for 6 inches. Increase in every 6th row at both ends till the ribbing measures 9 inches (56). Then change to Paprika wool, increase to 70 sts. on needle, make one complete pattern of stripes. Start to decrease Sleeve on the 3rd Pearl of next stripe. Knit 2 tog. at each end of needle every other row for 3 times then

every 6th row until 3 small stripes, then 2 tog. each end of every other row until there are 33 sts. left, 3 full stripes in sleeve. Cast off.

**TIE**—Cast on 2 sts. on No. 10 needles. Knit 1 row, increasing in both sts. (4). Knit in Stocking stitch, increasing both ends every plain row until 20 sts. on needle. Continue until 36 in plain stocking stitch until work measures 36 inches, decreasing same manner as increasing. (Slot for tie)—Cast on 12 sts., 4 rows Paprika, 4 rows in Garter stitch. Cast off in Banana color.

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## LADIES' SET No. 301

(Illustration Back Cover)

Size 36

### Monarch Dove

8 Balls Paprika Red      3 Balls Barbados  
1 Pair No. 10 Needles

### PULLOVER

**BACK**—Cast on 96 sts. in Paprika. K. 2, P. 2, until work measures 5 inches, increase 1 st. in every 12th st., continue in Stocking st. until work measures 12½ inches from bottom. Join Barbados, put wool around needles twice and have it to form drop st. Continue to end of needle. Knit next row. Join Paprika and repeat these last two rows same in Barbados. With Paprika wool continue in stocking st. until work measures 14 inches. Cast off 3 sts. beginning of each row 6 times to form armhole. Then decrease 1 st. at each end of purl row twice. Continue without decreasing until there are 14 rows from Barbados stripe, work in stripes as before, then continue knitting in Paprika for 12 rows, work in stripes as before, continue Stocking st. in Paprika until armhole measures 8 inches. Cast off 5 sts. on right side, K. 30, cast off 8 sts. and knit to end of needle. Cast off 5 sts. beginning purl row and purl to end. Cast off 10 sts. at beginning of knit row and knit to end. Keep casting off 5 sts. at armhole side until 5 remain. Cast off. Work other side to correspond.

**FRONT**—Work exactly same as back until the armhole decreasing. Decrease the sts. in 3's, same as Back then decrease 1 st. beginning and end of every purl row, 4 times, continue same as Back until last Barbados stripe, then in Paprika K. 1 row, P. 1 row, and then divide for neck by casting off 8 sts. in centre of needle. Cast off 4 sts. every knit row until 25 sts. remain. Then on beginning of knit row cast off 5 sts. each needleful until no sts. remain. Work other shoulder to correspond. Join neck, pick up 100 sts., K. 1, P. 1, for 18 rows. 3 rows in stocking st. Join Barbados wool and K. 1 row of the drop st. K. 1 row. Join Paprika wool, K. 1 row drop st. K. 1 row. Join Barbados and do same. Join Paprika wool, K. 1, P. 1, for 1 row, then P. 1, K. 1, for 1 row. K. 1, P. 1, for 1 row. Cast off loosely and sew seam.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 50 sts. K. 2, P. 1, to end of row. K. 1, P. 2, to end of row. Continue these two rows until work measures 9 inches, increasing 1 st. beginning of every 7th row, bringing sts. up to 88. Knit 12 rows of stocking stitch. 3 rows of drop stitch pattern to correspond with front. K. 12 rows stocking stitch, then pattern as before. Knit 12 rows stocking stitch, decreasing every 2nd row to make 77 sts. On next plain row, K. 6, P. 1, to end of needle. On purl row, P. 6, K. 1, to end of needle, increasing every 7th row till sleeve measures 17½ inches.

Cast off 3 sts. beginning of each needleful 4 times, then decrease 1 st. beginning and end of every purl row until 14 sts. remain. Cast off loosely and sew seams together.

## HAT (Set No. 301)

### Monarch Dove

2 Balls Paprika Red      1 Ball Barbados  
1 Pair No. 10 Needles      7 Needles No. 12  
1 Fine Crochet Hook

On No. 10 needles cast on 126 sts. 1st row—Knit entire row. 2nd row—K. 1, P. 1, to end of row. 3rd row—P. 1, K. 1, to end of row. 4th row—Same as 2nd row. Join Barbados wool. 5th row—Put wool twice around needle and knit to form drop stitch, continue same to end of needle. 6th row—Knit entire row. 7th row—With Paprika wool K. 1, put wool twice around needle as in 5th row and continue to end. 8th row—With Barbados wool same as 7th row. 9th row—Knit entire row. 10th row—Paprika wool, knit entire row. 11th row—Purl entire row. 12th row—Knit entire row. Change to No. 12 needles dividing the sts. 21 on each needle (6 needles). K. 1, P. 1, for 14 rows. Continue work by knitting in stockinette st. for 3 inches. Then at beginning of each needle slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, every 2nd round, until only 3 sts. remain on each needle. Cast off and sew neatly.

**For trimming**—Cast on 100 sts. in Barbados wool on No. 10 needles. 1st row—Knit entire row. 2nd row—Purl entire row. 3rd row—Put wool twice around needle and knit, continue to end of needle. 4th row—Knit entire row. Join Paprika wool. 5th row—On Paprika wool, same as 3rd row. 6th and 7th rows—Knit. 8th row—Purl. 9th row—Knit. Cast off, taking 2 sts. together. Join by bringing work together with darning needle. Cross stitch to cover mould. Cast on 3 sts. on No. 10 needles with Paprika wool. Stocking st. for 5 rows increasing 1 st. at end of every row. Join Barbados wool, knit stocking stitch for 4 rows still increasing, 2 rows of Paprika without increasing, 4 rows of Barbados decreasing 1 st. at end of every row. 5 rows Paprika still decreasing until 3 sts. remain. Cast off.

Turn up rim of Hat sewing with loose stitch. Place ornament on desired position. **Knob on top of hat**—Crochet 14 chain, turn and single crochet 1 on every chain to end, join and sew on Hat.

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## BOYS' TWO-PIECE SUIT No. 313

**BACK**—Cast on 80 sts. Work exactly same as front but make one more cable stitch pattern before casting off sts at neck, thus making neck a little higher at back.

**NECK**—With Everglade wool and No. 10 needles pick up stitches from left shoulder across front up to right shoulder. K. 1 row, 3 rows Seed stitch. K. 1 row, cast off. Repeat on back of neck. Sew Seacrest part of shoulder seams neatly together. Make small loop on Everglade part of front shoulders for button-hole and sew small button on Everglade band of back shoulders.

**SLEEVES**—With No. 8 needles and Seacrest wool, with right side of work towards you pick up and knit 60 sts. around armhole. Continue in Stocking stitch until sleeve measures 9½ inches, knitting 2 together on each 8th row. With Everglade wool and No. 10 needles knit 2 inches of ribbing for cuff like band at bottom of Sweater. Cast off.

### PANTS

With Seacrest wool and No. 10 needles cast on 90 sts. Knit 6 rows of ribbing (knit 2, purl 2). Next \* knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from \* to end of row. 6 more rows of ribbing. With No. 8 needles knit 1 row, purl 1 row. Next knit 14, turn, purl back 14. Next knit 18, turn, purl back 18. Next knit 24, turn, purl back 24. Next knit 30, turn, purl back 30. Next knit 36, turn, purl back 36. Next knit 42, turn, purl back 42. Next knit 48, turn, purl back 48. Next knit entire row. Continue until work measures 10 inches. Knit 2 together at each end of needle, purl 1 row, knit 2 together at each end of needle. Purl 1 row. Continue until there are 7 decreasing. Make 4 more rows. Now with No. 10 needles and Everglade wool knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 5 rows of Seed stitch, knit 1 row. Cast off loosely. Other leg same, being careful to start short rows on purl end so that seams join evenly. Sew all seams evenly.





## LADIES' PULLOVER No. 304

Size 36

**Monarch Andalusian**

**5 Balls Praline Pink    2 Balls French Plum**  
**1 Pair No. 10 Bone Needles**

**FRONT**—Cast on 100 sts. Praline Pink. 1st row—Purl to end of needle. 2nd row—K. 1, P. 1 to end of row. Repeat the 2nd row until work measures 3 inches. Increase 1 st. every 10th st., bringing sts. to 109. **1st Pattern row**—\* K. 1, M. 1, K. 2, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1, \* repeat from \* to \* to end of row, ending with M. 1, K. 1. 2nd row—Purl to end of needle. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 4 inches from ribbing.

**To start Point**—On pattern row K. 36, M. 1, K. 1, \* M. 1, K. 2, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2, repeat from \* to \* 3 times, M. 1, K. 1, M. 1, K. 36. Purl back. Now continue to make point by knitting one more st. on each side of pattern and one less st. of pattern bringing the work up to all plain knitting, then continue to knit the one row plain and next purl until work measures about 10½ inches from ribbing. Cast off 3 sts. beginning of each needleful for 6 needlefuls. Cast off 1 st. each end of next plain row. On purl row divide for neck. **Right side of Neck**—Decrease 1 st. beginning of each plain row, and decrease 1 st. beginning of each 3rd purl row, until only 25 sts. remain. Continue work until armhole measures 8½ inches. Then cast off 5 sts. beginning every purl row 5 times. Left side of neck make same as right side, only, decrease 1 st.

Size 36

**Monarch Dove**

**7 Balls Seacrest    4 Balls Everglade**  
**1 Pair No. 10 Needles    1 Fine Crochet Hook**

**BACK**—Cast on 90 sts., Seacrest, K. 1, P. 1, for 3 inches. Increase 1 st. in every 10 sts., bringing the sts. to 99. Knit 11 rows Stocking stitch. Join Everglade wool, and K. 1 row. 2nd row—Everglade, K. 1, P. 1, to end of row. 3rd row—P. 1, K. 1, to end of row. Repeat these 2 rows 8 times. Join Seacrest wool. K. 6 rows Stocking stitch. **1st row of Diamonds**—K. 13, join Everglade wool, K. 1 on Everglade wool, K. 23 on Seacrest wool, join Everglade K. 1, K. 23 in Seacrest wool, Everglade K. 1, K. 23 in Seacrest, Everglade K. 1, K. 13 in Seacrest. 2nd row of Diamonds—P. 12 on Seacrest. \*P. 1, K. 1, P. 1 on Everglade wool, P. 21 on Seacrest\*, repeat from \* to \*, ending row with P. 12 in Seacrest wool. Continue to make diamonds by knitting one less Seacrest each side of Everglade and knit one more st. each side of Everglade until there are 19 Everglade sts. and 5 Seacrest between each, then reverse by knitting one less on each side of Everglade and one more of Seacrest until all Seacrest on needle, continue on Seacrest Stockinette stitch for 6 rows and on 7th row start diamonds as shown in pattern. When work measures 13½ inches cast off 3 sts. at beginning of each needleful for 8 rows. Continue in Stockinette stitch until armhole measures 8½ inches. Cast off 5 sts. beginning each needleful until 35 sts. remain. Cast off 35 loosely.

4 Balls each Monarch Rainbow No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

15 Balls Black Monarch Dove

1 Steel Crochet Needle No. 5

With Rainbow No. 1, ch. 4, 2 d.c. into 1st st., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same st., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same st., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same st., ch. 2 and fasten to 3rd ch. at beginning of row. Now catch wool in space of 2 ch. at corner, ch. 3, 2 d.c. into same space, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same space, \* ch. 1, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into next space of 2 ch. at corner. Repeat from \* around row. Fasten in 3rd st. of ch. 3 at beginning of row to join. Now catch with a slip st. into space of 2 ch. of previous row at corner. Ch. 3, 2 d.c. into same space, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same space, \*, ch. 1, 3 d.c. into space (between 2 groups of 3 d.c. of previous row), ch. 1, 3 d.c. into 2 ch. of previous row at corner. Ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same st. Repeat from \* around row. Fasten into 3rd ch. at beginning of row. Now catch with a slip st. into space of 2 ch. of previous row at corner. Ch. 3, 2 d.c. into same st., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same st., \*, ch. 1, 3 d.c. into space between 2 groups of d.c. in previous row. Ch. 1, 3 d.c. into next space between groups. Ch. 1, 3 d.c. 2 ch., 3 d.c. into space of 2 ch. of previous row at corner. Repeat from \* around row. Fasten into 3rd st. of 3 ch. at beginning of row. Break off. Tie on Black wool and catch with a slip st. into space of 2 ch. of previous row at corner. Ch. 3, 2 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into same st., \*, ch. 1, 3 d.c. into next space. Ch. 1, 3 d.c. into next space. Ch. 1, 3 d.c. into next space. Ch. 1, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into space of 2 ch. of previous row at corner. Repeat from \* around row. Fasten into third ch. at beginning of row. Break off. Make 34 squares of each color. Arrange squares so that colors run in diagonal lines as illustrated. Sew squares together with Black wool.

**Edging.**—1st round—With Black wool, work into corner st., 3 d.c., 2 ch., 3 d.c. Then 1 ch., 3 d.c. into each space. Repeat this around entire Afghan.

2nd round—Work 3 d.c. on top of 3 d.c. of previous row, 1 ch. in place of 1 ch. of previous row. Repeat around Afghan.

3rd round—2 d.c. into corner space, 6 treble crochet into same space, 2 d.c. into same space, \*, 1 ch., 2 s.c. into next space, 1 ch., 2 d.c., 4 t.c., 2 d.c. into next space. Repeat from \* around entire Afghan.

4th round—Star Stitch—Chain 4, draw a loop through each of 4 ch. Wool over needle, draw through all 5 loops on needle. Make 1 ch. to bind st. Draw a loop through loop of st. just made, a loop through back thread of st., a loop through same st. as previous st., a loop through each of next 2 sts., 6 loops on needle now. Wool over needle, draw through all sts. Make 1 chain to bind. Continue around entire Afghan.

## AFGHAN No. 320

(Illustration Inside Back Cover)

Monarch Dove

2 Balls each Banana, Buttercup, Orange, Marigold

12 Balls each Barbados, Copper Rust, Oak Rose

6 Balls each Camel, Buff

1 Medium Sized Crochet Hook

(Work in s.c. picking up back thread only throughout entire work)

With Barbados ch. 330 sts., work 1 s.c. into first 2 sts. \*3 s.c. into next st., 1 s.c. into next 11 sts., skip 2 sts. 1 s.c. into next 11 sts., repeat from \* across row, ending with 1 s.c. into last 2 sts. (Repeat this row throughout entire work). Repeat 3 more rows as first row, then tie on Copper Rust and work 4 rows, then Oak Rose 4 rows. Buff 2 rows, Camel 2 rows, Banana 1 row, Buttercup 1 row, Orange 1 row, Marigold 1 row. Then Barbados 2 rows, Copper Rust 2 rows, Buff 2 rows, Camel 2 rows, Buff 2 rows, Oak Rose 2 rows, Copper Rust 2 rows, Barbados 2 rows. Then Marigold 3 rows, Orange 3 rows, Buttercup 3 rows, Banana 3 rows. Then Camel 5 rows, Buff 5 rows, Oak Rose 5 rows, Copper Rust 5 rows, Camel 5 rows. Then Marigold 1 row, Orange 1 row, Buttercup 1 row, Banana 1 row. Then \*Camel 2 rows, Buff 2 rows, Oak Rose 4 rows, Copper Rust 4 rows, Barbados 4 rows. Repeat from \* two more times. This brings you to centre of Afghan. Continue working, but reverse the arrangement of colors; working colors given above backwards.

**Border.**—On straight sides, with Banana work 1 s.c. into each ridge and 1 ch. between for 1 row, Buttercup 1 row, Orange 1 row, Marigold 1 row, Copper Rust 1 row.

Size 62 x 42 inches

Monarch Dove

21 Balls Barbados

6 Balls Marigold

9 Balls Buttercup

4 Balls Banana

1 No. 5 Bone Crochet Hook

**FOR WHEEL.**—Ch. 3, join with slip st. to 1st st. of chain. 1st round—Ch. 3, work 17 d.c. in ring. 2nd round—Ch. 3, 1 d.c. in space between 3 ch. and 1st d.c. of last round, wrap around needle, insert into next space, bring out to front of work in next space, wrap around hook, draw loop up  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, repeat over this st. (this is called a raised double). Then work 2 d.c. between next 2 d.c. Repeat these two until there are 6 raised doubles in the round. Complete by pulling last st. through 3 ch. with slip st. 3rd round—Ch. 3, work 3 d.c. in same space, making 4 in space (as ch. 3 counts as 1 at start of each round). Work 1 pair doubles over each raised double 4 d.c. between 2 d.c. Repeat to end of round. 4th round—Ch. 3, work 1 d.c. in same space. 2 d.c. in next 2 spaces, making 6 d.c. in 1st group, then 1 pair doubles over each raised double. Work 6 d.c. in next (2 in each space) continue these 2 around. 5th round—Ch. 3, repeat as before only have 8 d.c. between each pair of raised doubles. 6th round—Continue same as last row only have 9 d.c. between the raised doubles. 7th round—Continue as before with 10 d.c. between. 8th round—Continue as before with 12 d.c. between raised doubles. This completes wheel. Keep threads for raised doubles loose.

**HALF WHEELS.**—Make the same st. as wheel. Ch. 3, join with slip st., to form ring. 1st row—Work 10 d.c. in ring, do not join, turn. 2nd row—Ch. 3, work 1 d.c. in same st., 2 d.c. in next space, a raised double in next space, 2 d.c. between next 2 d.c. (this should be centre of half wheel). Continue to end of row, with 1 pair raised doubles equal distance from centre. 3rd row—Work raised double by inserting hook from back to front and out to back, draw up  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch. Repeat to end of row (insert hook in back of st. every other row in order to complete raised doubles). Ch. 3, work 5 d.c., spacing between to next double, continue as explained with 4 d.c. in centre between raised doubles. 4th row—Ch. 3, 7 d.c. spaced to next raised double. 2 raised doubles, then 6 d.c. in next space, divided 2 between each d.c. Repeat to end. 5th row—Ch. 3, 9 d.c. spaced to next raised doubles, 8 d.c. between this and next raised double, 10 d.c. to end. Continue this same as wheel within. 6th row—12 d.c. on sides, 9 d.c. in centre. 7th row—13 d.c. on sides, 10 d.c. in centre. 8th row—14 d.c. on sides, 12 d.c. in centre. Make 45 wheels Barbados, 14 wheels Marigold, 18 wheels Buttercup, 8 wheels Banana, 12 half-wheels Barbados. Sew together as illustrated and press.

## PILLOW No. 321

Monarch Dove

1 Ball each Banana, Buttercup, Orange, Marigold

4 Balls each Barbados, Copper Rust, Oak Rose

2 Balls each Buff, Camel

1 Medium Sized Crochet Hook

With Banana, chain 441 sts. (Work in s.c., picking up back thread only throughout entire work). Work 1 s.c. into each of first 7 sts., 3 s.c. into next st., 1 s.c. into next 7 sts. Then skip 2 sts. Repeat across row but join last st. with a slip st. to beginning of work. Then turn and crochet back. Tie on Buttercup, work 2 rows, Orange 2 rows and Marigold 2 rows, then Barbados 4 rows, Copper Rust 4 rows, Oak Rose 4 rows, then Buff 2 rows, Camel 2 rows. Repeat this entire pattern two more times.

**To make Centre Buttons.**—With Banana, chain 2, work 8 s.c. into first chain. 2nd row—Insert needle into first s.c. of previous row, place work in left hand. Now wind wool 3 times around needle and forefinger together, then wool over needle, draw through, wool over needle and draw through all sts. Repeat this loop st. around row. Next row—2 s.c. into each st. of previous row. Next row—1 loop st. in each st. of previous row. Increase in this manner until 40 loops sts. around row, working a few rows in Banana, Buttercup and Orange. With a darning needle, draw each point on side of pillow to edge of looped button and sew firmly. Make another looped button for other side with Copper Rust and Oak Rose. Sew to other side of pillow.





## RAGLAN SLEEVE SWEATER No. 306

Size 36

Monarch Andalusian

9 Balls Banana, 2 Balls Seacrest Green, 2 Balls White  
1 Pair each No. 9 and No. 11 Needles

**BACK**—In White, cast on 100 sts. on No. 9 needles. K. 1, P. 1, ribbed knitting for 3 rows. Change to Seacrest, K. 4 rows, then 2 rows White, 6 rows Banana, and repeat these stripes for 6 inches. Change to No. 11 needles and increase 1 st. every 5th st. across row (now 120 sts. on needles). Now knit in Stocking stitch (K. 1 row, P. 1 row) till work measures 9 inches from ribbing up to beginning of armhole. Bind off 3 sts. at beginning of next 4 rows. Then bind off 1 st. at beginning of next 2 rows. From now on begin every knitted row with K. 1, slip 1, K. 1, and pass slip st. over knitted st. and end rows with K. 2 tog., K. 1, when there are 42 sts. left at neck, bind off.

**FRONT**—Cast on 100 sts. on No. 9 needles and work K. 1, P. 1, ribbing in stripes for 6 inches same as back. Then change to No. 11 needles and increase to 120 sts. Knit in Stocking stitch for 9 inches. Then divide sts. in half for shoulders. On one side bind off 3 sts. at beginning of 4 rows at armhole side and decrease 1st. every 2nd row at neck side. Then continue to decrease 1 st. at armhole as in the back of Sweater. At the neck end decrease 1 st. every knit row till 16 sts. remain. Then continue decreasing on armhole side only until no sts. remain.

**SLEEVES**—On No. 9 needles, cast on 52 sts. (wrist). K. 1, P. 1, ribbed knitting for 2 inches. Change to No. 11 needles and increase 1 st. every 10th st. (57 sts.). Knit in Stocking

Change to Lugano Blue wool. 1st row—K. 2, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 2nd row, and every other row hereafter, purl back. 3rd row—K. 3, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 5th row—K. 4, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 7th row—K. 5, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 9th row—K. 6, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 11th row—K. 7, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 13th row—K. 6, \* K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6, repeat from \* across row. 15th row—Knit 1 st. less at beginning of each row till pattern returns to K. 2 at beginning of row. Repeat this pattern till work measures 10 inches from top of ribbing. Cast off 3 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. Cast off 2 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. From now on begin every knitted row with K. 1, slip 1, K. 1, and pass slip st. over knit st. and end rows with K. 2 tog., K. 1. When there are 32 sts. left at neck, cast off for back of neck.

**FRONTS**—With Belmont wool cast on 96 sts. K. 1, P. 1, ribbed knitting for  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches same as back. On next row—change to Lugano wool. 1st row—K. 3, interlock Belmont and continue ribbed knitting to within 3 sts. of end and interlock Lugano and knit 3 remaining sts. 2nd row—P. 3 Lugano,

Start pattern and continue until work measures 4 inches from ribbing. On next pattern row—Knit entire row, and purl back, and continue in stockinette st. until work measures 10½ inches from ribbing. Cast off 3 sts. beginning of each needleful for 6 needlefuls. Cast off 1 st. beginning and end of next plain row. Continue without decreasing until armhole measures 8½ inches. Cast off 5 sts. beginning of each needleful for 10 needlefuls thus forming shoulders. Cast off remaining sts. for back of neck.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 50 sts. Knit 1 row plain and 1 row purl until work measures 3 inches, then increase 1 st. beginning and end of each 8th row, until work measures 8 inches. Continue without decreasing until work measures 11 inches. Then increase 1 st. beginning and end of every 6th row, until work measures 17 inches. Cast off 3 sts. at beginning of every needle 6 times. Decrease 1 st. beginning and end of every purl row 9 times. Continue without decreasing until work measures 7½ inches from armholes. Decrease 1 st. beginning and end of each needle until 16 sts. remain. Cast off.

**CUFFS**—Cast on 92 sts. French Plum. 1st Pattern row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 4, K. 1, slip 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 4, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times, ending needle with M. 1, K. 1. 2nd row—Purl entire row. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 2 inches. Next Pattern row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 2, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times, ending needle with M. 1, K. 1. Purl back. Next pattern row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 3, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 3, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times ending with M. 1, K. 1. Purl back. Repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 4 inches. Next Pattern row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 1, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times, end needle with M. 1, K. 1. Purl back. Next Pattern row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 2, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 6 times, end needle with M. 1, K. 1. Purl back. Repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 6 inches. Decrease 1 st. beginning and end of each pattern row, until 54 sts. remain. \*K. 1, P. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of needle. Repeat this last row for 1½ inches. Cast off.

**COLLAR**—Cast on 196 sts. French Plum. 1st row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 4, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 4, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 14 times, ending needle with K. 1. 2nd row—Purl entire row. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 1½ inches. On next Pattern row—\*K. 1, M. 1, K. 2, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 14 times, ending needle with K. 1. Purl back. Repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 2½ inches. Cast off 6 sts. beginning of next pattern row, also 6 sts. off beginning of purl row. Next Pattern row—Cast off 4 sts. and on pattern \*K. 1, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 1, M. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of needle. Cast off 4 beginning of purl row. Next Pattern row—Cast off 4 sts. Continue pattern, K. 1, M. 1, K. 2, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1. Continue this pattern row and purl row, but cast off 4 sts. at beginning of every needleful until 60 sts. remain. Cast off loosely.

**TIES**—Cast on 20 sts. K. 2, M. 1, K. 6, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 6, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Continue these 2 rows until work measures 1½ inches. Next Pattern row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 4, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 4, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Next Pattern row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 5, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 5, M. 1, K. 2, repeat these 2 rows until work measures 3 inches.

Purl back. Next Pattern row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 3, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 3, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Next Pattern row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 4, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 4, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 4½ inches. Next Pattern row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 2, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 6 inches. Next Pattern row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 1, K. 2 tog., slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 1, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Next row—K. 2, K. 1, K. 2, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 2 tog., K. 2, M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 8 inches. Cast off.

Make other piece the same and sew together at narrow ends.

**FRONT**—Cast on 96 sts., Seacrest, K. 1, P. 1, for 3 inches. Increase same as back until 125 sts. on needle. Knit 11 rows in Stocking stitch. Join Everglade wool, K. 1 row. 16 rows of K. 1, P. 1, alternately. Join Seacrest wool, divide sts., placing 63 on holder to form front. **Right Front**—1st row—In Everglade wool K. 1, P. 1, 5 times. Join Seacrest wool, K. 53. 2nd row—P. 53 in Seacrest wool and K. 1, P. 1, in Everglade wool to end of needle. Repeat these two rows twice. 7th row—10 sts. in Everglade and in Seacrest knit 14, join Everglade wool K. 1, in Seacrest K. 23, join Everglade wool K. 1, in Seacrest K. 14. This starts the diamonds as in back, continue making same, always doing the 10 sts. in Everglade wool at beginning of plain row and end of purl row. When work measures 13½ inches, cast off 3 sts. at beginning of every purl row 4 times, then decrease 1 st. beginning of purl row every 6th row. When Everglade band measures 10 inches place sts. on holder and continue the neck in Seacrest wool, decreasing 1 st. every knit row until armhole measures 8½ inches. Then cast off 5 sts. at beginning of every purl row 4 times. Take the 10 Everglade sts. off holder and continue with band for 9 inches, then cast off.

Make left front same as right except when casting off for armhole and shoulder cast off on plain row instead of purl. Join shoulders, and neck band and sew band to neck.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 60 sts. with Seacrest wool, K. 1, P. 1, for 3 inches. Increase 1 st. in every 9th st. to make 67 sts. on needle, 12 rows Stockinette stitch. Join Everglade, K. 1 row. 16 rows K. 1, P. 1 alternately. Join Seacrest wool, 6 rows Stockinette stitch. Next row—K. 21, join Everglade K. 1, K. 23 in Seacrest, join Everglade K. 1, K. 21 in Seacrest. Continue making diamonds same as in Back. Increase 1 st. each end of needle every 8th row until 84 sts. on needle. When work measures 18 inches, cast off 3 sts. at beginning of each needle for 8 rows. Then decrease 1 st. beginning and end of each purl row 9 times, decrease 1 st. beginning and end of every needleful until 16 sts. remain. Cast off 16 sts. loosely.

**THREE TIES** (2 Seacrest, 1 Everglade)—Cast on 2 sts. 1st row—K. 2, cast on 2. 2nd row—P. 1, K. 1, P. 2, cast on 2. 3rd row—P. 1, K. 1, P. 4, cast on 2. 4th row—P. 1, K. 7, cast on 2. 5th row—P. 1, K. 1, P. 6, K. 1, P. 1. 6th row—P. 1, K. 8, P. 1. 7th row—P. 1, K. 1, P. 6, K. 1, P. 1. Continue these last 2 rows until work measures 9 inches, K. 2 tog. each end of needle every row until 2 sts. remain. Cast off.

To make loops on Fronts for ties, join wool and make 8 chain and join to Front. 3 loops each side of Fronts. Then from bottom of opening crochet 1 single crochet all around the Fronts and Neck working 8 single crochet over loops.

**BUCKLE**—Cast on 25 sts. Knit 1 row of K. 1, P. 1. 2nd row—P. 1, K. 1 for 3 more rows making 5 rows. 6th row—P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1. Cast off 15 sts. \*P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1\*, repeat from \* to \* 4 times. Join wool, K. 5 rows to correspond with other side. Cast on 15 sts. other side for 5 rows. Cast on 15 sts., then K. 3 rows. 5 rows, K. 1, P. 1, alternately, then cast off.

Monarch Fairy  
3 Balls Pink  
1 Pair No. 6 Needles

Cast on 60 sts. Work 1 row plain knitting.

1st row—W.O., K. 3\*, (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 6, repeat from \* to last 9 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 3.

2nd, 3rd and 4th rows—Knit plain.

5th row—W.O., K. 2, K. 2 tog. three times \* (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 14 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. three times, K. 2. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

9th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 1, K. 2 tog. twice, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 16 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. twice, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

13th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 2 tog. four times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 19 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. four times, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

17th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 2 tog. five times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 22 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. five times, (W.O., K. 1) 3 times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row 3 times.

21st row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 7 sts., (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

Monarch Silvertwist and Monarch Brush

7 Balls Pink Monarch Silvertwist  
2 Balls White Monarch Brush  
1 Pair No. 10 and No. 4 Needles

With No. 10 needles cast on 40 sts. Pink Silvertwist, K.  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Then put work on No. 4 needles, K. 1 row. Next row put wool over needle twice on every stitch, repeat across row. Knit back drawing a long stitch, repeat twice. Increase every 5th st. across work, knit back, then every 6th st. until you have 96 sts. on needles. Knit ridges for 9 inches, increase 1st and last st. across work. Knit back. Repeat this until you have 132 sts. on needles. Knit 56 sts., cast off 20 sts. at centre to allow neck, knit 56 sts. K. 28 ridges. Then knit 28 ridges on other 56 sts. to form front. K. 56, cast on 20 and knit other 56 sts. (132 sts.) Continue work, decreasing instead of increasing.

**CROCHET EDGE**—Catch Pink Silvertwist wool in stitch along edge, make double crochet three times in same stitch, ch. 3, put hook through stitch, draw through two loops, repeat around work. Next row ch. 7, catch in centre of the double crochet, repeat around work three times. Then ch. 2 and catch Brush wool in every st. at centre double crochet, ch. 2 into same stitch to form a point.

Use one Brush and two Silvertwist wool chain stitch for sash, finish with tassels.

stitch increasing 1 st. every 12th row till there are 4 increasings on each side. After 4th increase every 8th row until 88 sts. on needles. Work should measure  $17\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Bind off 2 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. Knit 1 row. Purl 1 row. Repeat these two rows until 25 sts. are left on needle, then narrow at each end in both the purled and knitted rows till 11 sts. are left. Bind off.

**SCARF COLLAR**—With Banana wool cast on 24 sts. K. 1, P. 1, for 1 row. P. 1, K. 1, for 1 row. Repeat these 2 rows for 48 rows. Now with White wool, 1st row:—K. 24 sts. Pick up and K. 24 sts. down one side of square. 2nd row—Turn and knit plain. 3rd row—Knit 23 sts. wool over needle, K. 2 sts., wool over needle, K. 23 sts. 4th row—Knit. 5th row—With Seacrest K. 2 sts. tog., K. 22, K. 2 sts. tog. 6th row—Knit. Repeat these last 2 rows for entire Scarf in colors as follows: 3 ridges Seacrest, 2 ridges White, \*8 rows Banana (knit in Seed st. as centre square), 2 ridges White, 3 ridges Seacrest, 2 ridges White, repeat from \* till end of Scarf. Measurements 20 inches from square. Cast off. Now with square in White, pick up and knit 24 sts. on each side of centre. Knit in pattern same as first half of scarf. Bind off.

**CUFFS**—Pick up 52 sts. of ribbed cuff. Knit 1 in Seed st. (same as centre square), then decrease at both sides till no sts remain. Then on 2 needles pick up 44 sts. on each side of point. With White K. 2 ridges, 3 ridges Seacrest, 2 White, 8 rows Seed stitch in Banana, 2 ridges White, 3 Seacrest, 2 White. Bind off. The flare on the cuff comes by knitting within one of centre, wool over knit 2, wool over.

change to Belmont, K. 1, P. 1, Belmont, repeat across row to within 3 of end, P. 3 Lugano. 3rd row—With Lugano K. 5, change to Belmont, K. 1, P. 1, to within 5 of end, change to Lugano, K. 5. 4th row—Purl back same way. 5th row—K. 8, change to Belmont, K. 1, P. 1, to within 8 of end, change to Lugano, K. 8. 6th row—Purl back across row. 7th row—Begin pattern, with Lugano, K. 2, M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, change to Belmont and rib to within 10 sts. of end, change wool, K. 2, M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6. 8th row—With Belmont P. 13, change to Lugano, K. 1, P. 1, to within 13 of end and purl across row. 9th row—With Lugano K. 3. \* M. 1. K. 2 tog., K. 6, and repeat pattern once adding 3 more Lugano sts., K. 1, P. 1, ribbed knitting to within 16 of end and change to Lugano, K. 3, \* M. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 6, and repeat from \* to end of row. 10th row—Purl back across row. 11th row—Continue Pattern same as back, knitting 1 more st. at beginning of each row to make pattern and adding 3 more Lugano sts. each knitted row till no Belmont sts. left.

**LEFT SIDE**—From point upwards knit both sides separately. Knit in pattern till work measures 8 inches from top of ribbing to underarm. At underarm side cast off 3 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows and 2 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. At neck side cast off 1 st. at beginning of each row up to shoulder at underarm side. From now on begin every knitted row with K. 1, slip 1, knit and pass slip st. over knit st. and end rows with K. 2 tog., K. 1. When there are 8 sts. left at shoulder, cast off.

**RIGHT SIDE**—Add on 1 st. at beginning of each knitted row at centre front to form point, when there are 8 sts. start a new pattern. Continue adding patterns until point measures 4 inches out from centre front. Then decrease 1 st. at centre to form neckline, same as left front, up to shoulder. When underarm measures 8 inches decrease same as other side till 8 sts. remain. Cast these off.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 54 sts. With Belmont wool K. 1, P. 1, for 5 inches. With Lugano wool, K. 3, change wool K. 1, P. 1 across row to within 3 of end. Change and knit in Lugano. Purl across, knitting same number of sts. as knitted row before.

Knit 1 more st. of Belmont color each row till all stitches are Lugano. Begin pattern when there are 10 Belmont sts. at either side and continue adding a pattern with each 6 sts. Increase 1 st. each side till 66 sts. at elbow then decrease 1 st. every 4th row till sleeve measures 18 inches at underarm from beginning. Cast off 3 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. Next knitted row K. 1, K. 2 tog., knit to within 3 of end, K. 2 tog., K. 1. Purl 1 row. Repeat these 2 rows till there are 12 sts. at top of shoulder. Cast off.

**COLLAR**—Begin at centre back. 120 sts. from centre back to point. Pick up 24 sts. across back, 12 each shoulder, and remaining number down the neck and around point. With Lugano K. 1, P. 1, ribbed knitting for 3 rows. Cast off sts. around point. Knit 1 more row, casting off 6 sts. at beginning of each row to shape collar in front. When there are 52 sts. left on needle, cast these off. Repeat the same for the other side. Sew up collar at centre back.

**BUTTONS**—Crochet 1 s.c. and increase 1 s.c. every other singlecrochet for 4 rows, narrow every other s.c. to draw in for back.

**BELT**—Cast on 6 sts. and knit desired length allowing for stretch. Finishing each edge with chain stitch.

**FRONT**—With Pink wool, cast on 108 sts. Make Blush Pink band same as on back. Knit in stockinette stitch 15 rows. On 16th row start decreasing. Knit 1, knit 2 together, knit 30, knit 2 together, knit 38, knit 2 together, knit 30, knit 2 together, knit 1. Make 10 more rows and continue decreasing same as on back. (8 decreasing). This leaves 76 sts. on needle. Work to underarm. Make Blush Pink band with same decreasing as on back for underarm. After Blush Pink band is finished make 5 more rows. There should now be 62 sts. on needle. Next row—K. 2 tog. at beginning, K. 29 sts., turn, purl back to underarm. K. 1 row (30 sts.), turn, P. 1 row. This starts opening down front. On next row start smocking.

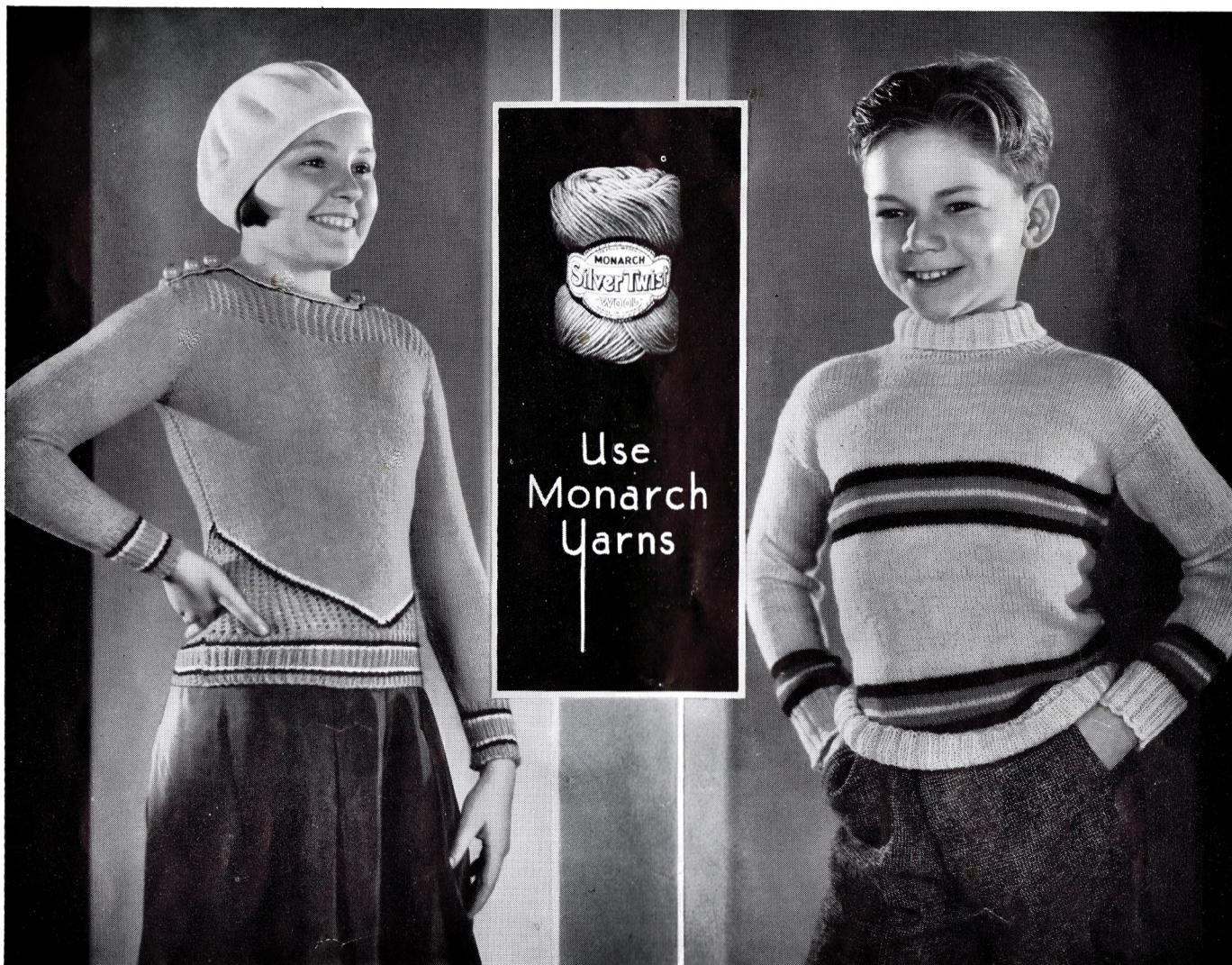
**LEFT FRONT**—1st row—K. 8, with Blush Pink K. 1, \* with Pink K. 3, Blush Pink K. 1, repeat from \* 4 times, K. 5. 2nd row—P. 4, with Blush Pink P. 1, \* Pink P. 1, Blush Pink P. 1, repeat from \* 9 times, P. 7. 3rd row—K. 6, Blush Pink K. 1, \* Pink K. 3, Blush Pink K. 1, repeat from \* 5 times. 4th row—Same as 2nd. Repeat these 4 rows until pattern is complete (13 rows) 13th row same as first row. This completes smocking. Knit 8 more rows. Next cast off 10 sts. for neck. Purl to end of row. Knit back the 20 sts., K. 2 tog., P. the 19 sts., K. the 19, K. 2 tog., P. 18, K. 18, K. 2, tog., P. 17, K. 17. Cast off. This completes left shoulder.

**RIGHT FRONT**—Same as left to smocking. **1st row smocking** K. 5, with Blush Pink K. 1, \* with Pink K. 3, Blush Pink K. 1, repeat from \* 4 times, K. 8. 2nd row—Purl 7, with Blush Pink P. 1, \* Pink P. 1, Blush Pink P. 1, repeat from \* 9 times, P. 4. 3rd row—K. 3, Blush Pink K. 1, \* Pink K. 3, Blush Pink K. 1, repeat from \* 5 times, K. 6. 4th row—Same as 2nd. Finish right front and shoulder same as left. Sew shoulders together. **Pieces for buttons and buttonholes for front opening.** On left front crochet 4 rows of d.c. 15 in each row. On right front crochet 5 rows of 15 d.c. making 2 buttonholes, on 3rd and 4th rows of d.c. by making 2 chain and missing 2 d.c. at equal spaces on 3rd row and by making 2 d.c. over chain on 4th row.

**NECK**—With Pink wool make 1 row of 50 d.c. around neck, 3 rows of Blush Pink d.c., picking up the back stitch of the Pink row to form ridge same as band at yoke. Make 1 row of d.c. with Pink starting at top of buttonhole piece to form corner.

**SLEEVES**—With right side of work towards you pick up and knit 55 sts. round armhole. Make 10 rows. Knit 2 tog. at each end of 11th row. Knit 10 more rows. Knit 2 tog. at each end of next row. Repeat decreasing 5 times leaving 45 sts. on needle. Continue till sleeve measures 10 inches. Make band with 8 rows of Blush Pink to correspond with bottom of skirt. Cast off. Sew up all seams neatly.

Size 10 Years

### Monarch Dove

6 Balls Cherry Rose, 1 Ball White, 1 Ball Black  
1 Pair No. 10 Needles

**FRONT**—Cast on 80 sts. with Cherry Rose wool. K. 1, P. 1, for 4 rows. Black wool, K. 1 row plain and 1 row K. 1, P. 1. White wool, knit 1 row plain, 1 row K. 1, P. 1. Then take Cherry Rose wool and knit 1 row plain and 7 rows K. 1, P. 1. White wool, knit 1 row plain, 1 row K. 1, P. 1. Black wool, knit 1 row plain, 1 row K. 1, P. 1. Cherry Rose wool, knit 1 row plain and 3 rows K. 1, P. 1. Knit 1 row plain Cherry Rose. Then start the body of the Sweater. 1st row—P. 38 and with Black wool P. 4. With Cherry Rose, purl to end of row. 2nd row—P. 1\*, wool over needle, P. 2 tog. (\*repeat till 1 st. before the Black), K. 2 Black and with White wool K. 2. K. 2 Black and then start with a new ball of Cherry Rose wool. P. 2 tog., wool over needle, repeat to end of row. 3rd row—K. 36 Cherry, K. 2 Black, K. 4 White, K. 2 Black, K. 36 Cherry. 4th row—P. 1, \*wool over needle, P. 2 tog. (\*repeat till 1st. before Black). K. 2 Black, K. 2 White (join another ball of Cherry), K. 2 Cherry, K. 2 White, K. 2 Black, Purl 2 tog., wool over needle, to end of needle. Repeat till all stitches are Cherry. Knit 1 row plain, 1 row purl, till work measures 14 inches. Cast off 4 on each end of needle. K. 2 tog. each end of needle for 4 rows, leaving 64 stitches. Knit 12 rows. **Start pattern for Yoke**—1st row—K. 30, wool over needle, purl 2 tog., wool over needle, P. 2 tog., K. 30. 2nd row—P. 30,

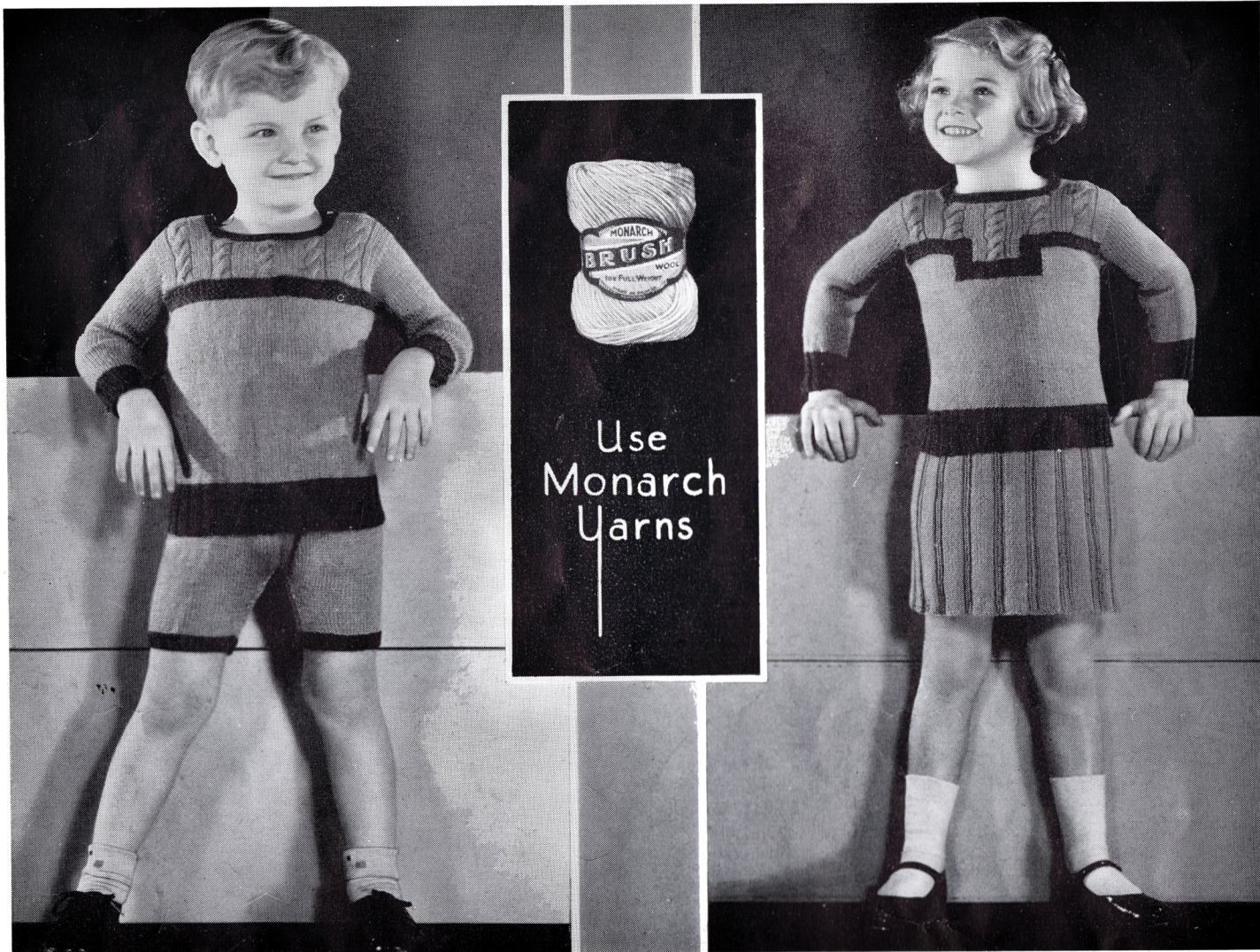

Cast on 92 sts. on No. 8 needles, White wool. Knit in the back of cast on sts. to give a firm foundation. K. 2, P. 2 for 3 inches. Change to Blue wool, 4 rows of Stocking st. Change to Cardinal, 4 rows of Stocking st. Change to White. 2 rows of Stocking st., then reverse the stripe. Continue Stocking st. in White for  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches, then make another stripe. Change to White. Knit 1 row, purl 1 row. Decrease at the beginning and end of each knit row for 6 times (80). Continue in stocking st. until the work measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches from the decreasing. Cast off 28 in centre for neck. Knit in Stocking stitch 2 inches for each shoulder. Knit shoulder, cast on 32, knit other shoulder. Increase instead of decrease same as back making stripes in front to match back.

Pick up 60 sts. around armhole. Knit in Stocking stitch for 3 inches, then decrease every 4th row till 54 sts. left. Work Stocking stitch 10 inches. Make stripe. Change to No. 10 needles and knit 2, purl 2, for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

**COLLAR**—No. 10 needles. Pick up sts. all round neck (90). Knit 1, purl 1, for 1 inch, then knit 2, purl 2 for 3 inches. Cast off loosely. Sew seams and press.

**FRONT**—With No. 10 needles and Everglade Green wool cast on 84 sts. Knit in ribbing (knit 2, purl 2) for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches (about 22 rows). Next with No. 8 needles and Seacrest Green wool in stocking stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) until work measures 8 inches. Next cast off 5 sts. at each end of needle for underarm. Next \* knit 2 sts. together at each end of needle of knit row. Repeat from \* 3 times. With Everglade K. 1 row, P. 1 row, K. 5 rows of Seed stitch, K. 1 row. Next with Seacrest wool K. 1 row, P. 1 row. Next start Cable stitch pattern. 1st row—K. 5, \* P. 1, K. 6, P. 1, K. 4, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with K. 5. 2nd row—P. 5, \* K. 1, P. 6, K. 1, P. 4, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with P. 5. 3rd row—Same as 1st row. 4th row—Same as 2nd row. 5th row—Same as 1st row. 6th row—P. 5, \* K. 1, slip 3 next sts. on to spare needle, P. 3, then P. 3 sts. on spare needle, K. 1, P. 4, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with P. 5. 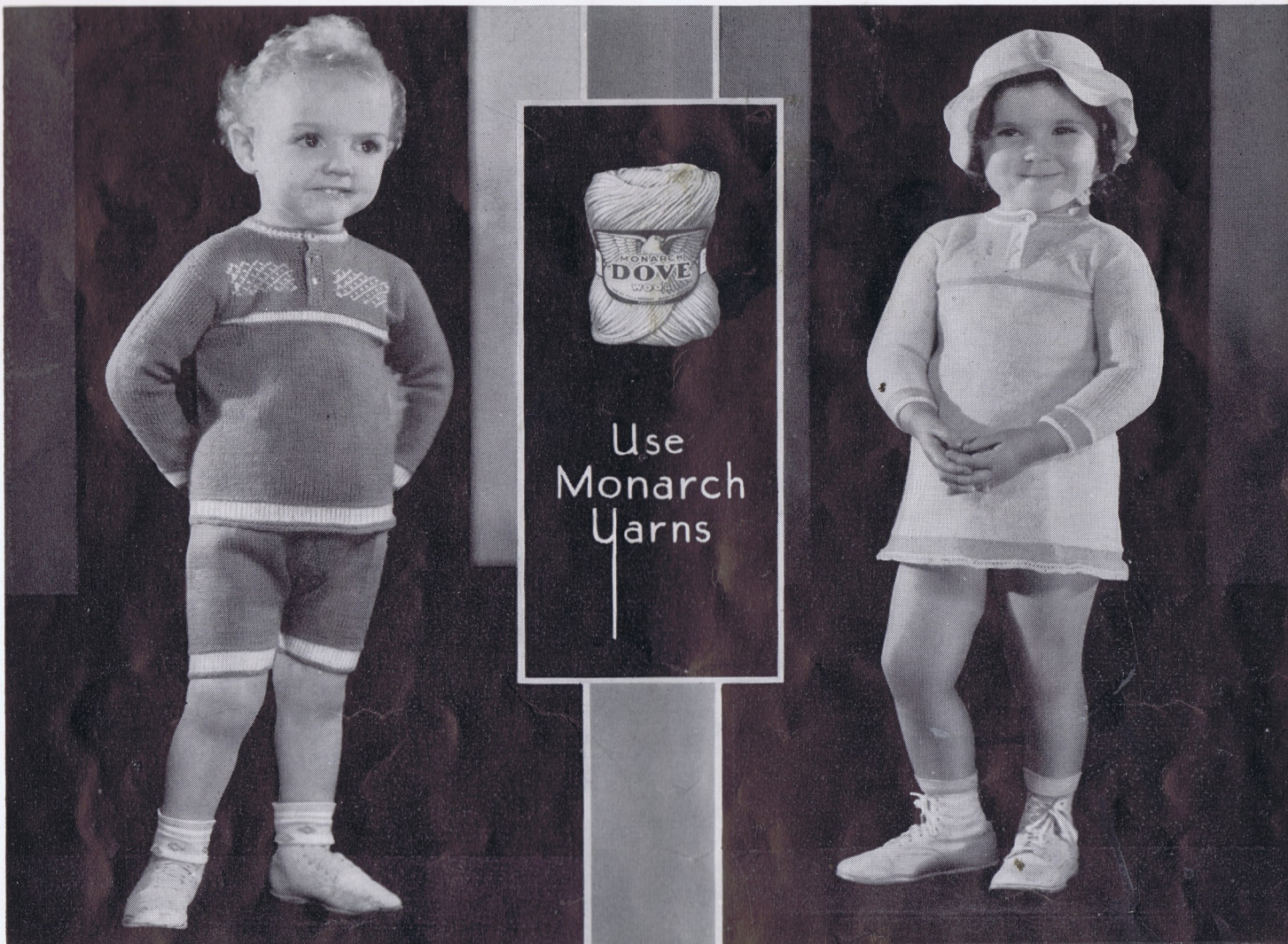

The rest of the back is in stocking stitch as far as yoke. Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row to form ridge. With Banana cast off 5 stitches at each end for underarm. Make Banana band of 4 rows and another ridge by knitting 2 rows of Lugano, decreasing 1 stitch at each end. Continue until there are 28 rows, making 2 more decreaseings at underarm. Cast off 14 sts. in centre for neck. **Knit shoulder** by knitting 2 together at beginning of each knit row, 3 times. Knit up other shoulder. Cast off.

**FRONT**—Cast on 76 sts. Work same as back until Banana yoke ridge is complete with decrease for underarm same as back. K. 1 row, P. 1 row for 4 rows. There should now be 60 sts. on needle. Knit 30 sts. Purl back to underarm. K. 1 row, purl on these 30 sts. for 8 rows. **Now start Smocking left Front.** On 9th row K. 8 sts., then with Banana K. 1, \* with Lugano K. 3, with Banana K. 1, repeat from \* 4 times. K. 5, turn. 2nd row—P. 4, with Banana P. 1, \* Lugano P. 1, Banana P. 1, repeat from \* 9 times. P. 7. 3rd row—K. 6. Banana K. 1, \* Lugano K. 3, Banana K. 1, repeat from \* 5 times. 4th row—

**BACK**—With Pink wool cast on 100 sts. Knit 1 row. With Blush Pink wool K. 1 row, P. 1 row for 10 rows. With Pink wool K. 2 rows. This forms a Blush Pink band with a ridge of Pink top and bottom. Next with Pink wool in Stocking stitch (K. 1 row, P. 1 row) make 15 rows. Next row K. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 30, K. 2 tog., K. 38, K. 2 tog., K. 30, K. 2 tog., K. 1. Knit 10 rows in stockinette st. On 11th row—Knit 1, knit 2 together, knit 30, knit 2 together, knit 34, knit 2 together, knit 30, knit 2 together, knit 1. Now 10 more rows. Decrease as before. Repeat 3 times more and 3 more decreaseings with 5 rows between, being careful to keep 30 sts. on each end of needle, making the 4 sts. less on each decreased row come to centre front. This forms slight flare in skirt. Make 35 more rows. This brings work to underarm. Form Pink ridge. Now with Blush Pink wool cast off 5 sts. on each end of 1st Blush Pink row. K. 2 tog. at each end of 3rd Blush Pink row. Make 4 Blush Pink rows altogether. With Pink wool make ridge. This forms Blush Pink Band as on bottom of skirt. K. 2 tog. on each end of next Pink row. This finishes decreaseings for underarm. Make 27 more rows. On next row cast off 16 sts. in centre for neck. Purl back to neck. K. 2 sts. tog. on neck row. Purl back. K. 2 sts. tog. on next row. Repeat once more. This forms one shoulder. Make other shoulder the same. Cast off.

### JACKET

**BACK**—Cast on 81 sts. with Blue. 1st row—K. 1, wool over, K. 2 tog., wool over, repeat across row. 2nd row and every other row hereafter purl—Pink, K. 2 tog., wool over, K. 2 tog., repeat across row. 3rd row—Same as 1st. 4th row—Same as 2nd. 5th row—Blue, same as 1st. 6th row—Pink, K. 1, \* wool over, K. 2 tog., K. 8\*, and repeat \* to \* across row, leaving 8 plain at end. 7th row—K. 2\*, wool over, K. 2 tog., K. 8\*, and repeat \* to \* across row, leaving 7 plain at end. Increase 1 st. at beginning until there are 9 sts. before hole shows. Next row—K. 7 sts., \* K. 2 tog., wool over, K. 8\*, and repeat \* to \* across row. Decrease a stitch each row until hole comes at edge and then start holes going opposite direction. Carry pattern up to 3 points. Then when carrying pattern through, keep 3 sts. at each end of needle plain. Narrow at each side every row by knit 2nd and 3rd sts. together (from both ends). Knit up to next point and join with rest of Sweater.

**FRONT**—Cast on 61 sts. Knit same as back until the 3rd row of points is reached. Then narrow on one side by taking 2nd and 3rd sts. together each row until 4th point in pattern is reached. Join with other parts of Sweater.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 41 sts. in Blue. K. 1, P. 1, across and back—Pink, K. 1 row, K. 1 and P. 1, Blue; K. 1 row, K. 1 and P. 1, Pink; K. 3 rows, K. 1 and P. 1, Blue—K. 1 row, K. 1 and P. 1, Pink; K. 1 row, K. 1 and P. 1, Blue; K. 1 row, K. 1 and P. 1, Pink; Increase 20 sts., 1 every other st. until there are 61 sts. **Start Pattern**—Same as back until 4th point is reached, join with rest of Sweater. When Sweater is all on one needle there will be approximately 266 sts. Decrease by half by knitting 2 together all way round (making approximately 133 sts.). With Blue—K. 1, \* wool over, K. 2 tog., repeat from \* across row. Purl back. With Pink—K. 2 tog., \* wool over, K. 2 tog., repeat from \* across row. Purl back. With Blue—Repeat row. With Pink—Repeat for 3 rows. With Blue, repeat 1 row, narrowing across every 4th st. With Pink—Repeat 1 row, narrowing across every 4th st. With Blue—Repeat 1 row, and cast off, narrowing every 4th st. Sew up

### BONNET (Set No. 318)

#### Monarch Fairy

1 Ball Pink 1 Ball Sky Blue

1 Pair No. 10 Needles

Cast on 61 sts. with Blue, and No. 10 needles. 1st row—K. 1, wool over, K. 2 tog., wool over, repeat across row. Purl back. 2nd row—Pink, Knit 1st and 2nd st. tog., wool over, K. 2 tog., wool over and repeat to end of row. Purl back. 3rd row—Repeat same as 1st. Purl back. 4th row—Repeat same as 2nd. Purl back. 5th row—Blue, repeat same as 1st. Purl back. 6th row—Pink, K. 1, \* wool over, K. 2 tog., K. 8 plain, \* and repeat \* to \* across row, having 8 sts. left. Purl back. 7th row—K. 2, \* wool over, K. 2 tog., K. 8 plain \* and repeat \* to \* across row, having 7 sts. left. Purl back. At beginning of each row, increase one st. at beginning until there are 9 sts. at beginning before hole shows. Next row—K. 7 sts., next 5 tog., wool over, K. 8, K. 2 tog., wool over, repeat across row. Purl back. Next row—K. 6 sts., \* K. 2 tog., wool over, K. 8\* and repeat \* to \* across row. Carry pattern on until there are 3 points in pattern. Cast off 20 sts. on each end of needle and carry, leaving 21 in centre—carrying out pattern. Repeat until centre piece extends the length of the sides. Pick up 20 sts. on each side. Knit plain across row. K. 3, wool over, K. 3 and repeat across row. Making row of holes for ribbon. Knit plain 1 more row. Finish off with Blue. One row extending Blue up to meet front at each end.



## SHETLAND SHAWL (Set No. 318)

60 x 60 inches

Monarch Fairy—5 Balls Pink

1 Pair No. 6 Needles

Work at a tension to produce  $5\frac{1}{2}$  sts. to the inch,  
measured over the plain knitting.

THE CENTRE—Cast on 3 sts.

1st row—Wool over needle, knit plain to the end of row. Repeat this row until there are sixty loops up each side of the work. In the following row decrease as follows: W.O., K. 3 tog., knit plain to the end of the row. Repeat the last row until only 3 sts. remain. Cast off.

**Note.**—This shawl can be made in larger sizes by repeating the first row as given for the centre until extra loops, divisible by twelve, are obtained at each side. Then for every extra twelve loops there will be one more pattern in the border at each side of the shawl.

THE BORDER—With the right side of the work facing, pick up and knit the loops from one side. Work one row in plain knitting. Proceed as follows:

1st row—W.O., K. 3, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 6, repeat from \* to the last 9 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 3.

2nd row—W.O., knit plain to the end of the row. Repeat this row twice.

5th row—W.O., K. 2, K. 2 tog. three times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 14 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. three times, K. 2. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

9th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 1, K. 2 tog. twice, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 16 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. twice, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

13th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 2 tog. four times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 19 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. four times, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

17th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 2 tog. five times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 22 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. five times, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

21st row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 7 sts. (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

25th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 10 sts., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

29th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog. twice, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 13 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

33rd row—W.O., K. 3, W.O., K. 1, K. 2 tog. three times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 16 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. three times, K. 1, W.O., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

37th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 2 tog. four times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 19 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. four times, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

41st row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 2 tog. five times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 22 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. five times, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

45th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 7 sts., (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

49th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog. (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 10 sts., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

53rd row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog. twice, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 13 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

57th row—W.O., K. 3, W.O., K. 1, K. 2 tog. three times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 16 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. three times, K. 1, W.O., K. 3.

58th row—W.O., knit plain to the end of the row.

59th row—Like the 58th row.

60th row—W.O., knit plain to end of row, at end of which cast on 17 sts. (these 17 sts. form commencement of Peak).

THE PEAK—Knit plain 16 sts., K. 2 tog., turn.

1st row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 3, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

2nd row—K. 15, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

3rd row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 2, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 3, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

4th row—K. 16, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

5th row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 5, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

6th row—K. 17, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

7th row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 3, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 4, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

8th row—K. 18, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

9th row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 4, W.O., S. 1, K. 2 tog., pass the slip stitch over, W.O., K. 6, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

10th row—Cast off loosely 5 sts., K. 14, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice.

This completes one peak, repeat from the 1st to the 10th row until all the stitches from the border have been worked up. Then slip these stitches on to a stitch-holder to be carried forward for the next side.

With the right side of the work facing, commence again from the beginning of the border. After working each border pick up the sts. of the last row of peaks and continue in the pattern.

When the two sides are completed, cast off the peak sts. Sew together the cast on and the cast off edges of the peak. Join together the corners of the border by sewing through the loops, very loosely, in herringbone stitch.

**To Press the Shawl**—Roll in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each peak out separately and leave until dry.

### TO CHANGE COLORS IN KNITTING

**On a Purl Row**—Purl required number of stitches of a color, drop 1st color on side of work next to you; pick up 2nd color with right hand, bring it under 1st color, then purl required number of stitches of 2nd color.

**On a Knit Row**—Knit required number of stitches of 2nd color, drop 2nd color on side of work away from you; pick up 1st color, bring it under 2nd color, and knit required number of stitches of 1st color. Alternate these 2 rows. This twists the strands of yarn around each other so the colors are joined in a continuous piece of work.

### WASHING KNITTED AND CROCHETED WOOLENS

In order to keep knitted and crocheted garments as soft and as beautiful as new, and to obtain lasting and satisfactory service, it is very important to wash them carefully. Dissolve some pure white soap, such as Ivory Soap, in warm water and soak the soiled piece for fifteen minutes. Gently dip the garment up and down, removing the stains by squeezing (not wringing) between the hands. Repeat the process in new suds, if the garment is very soiled. Rinse twice in clear water. To dry, lay the garment on a thick Turkish towel, arranging the pattern in the original form and drawing the garment into shape from time to time, or pinning it in shape. When it is almost dry, put it (still stretched on the towel) in a warm place (such as near a radiator) and let it dry thoroughly, not forgetting to stretch it frequently, or to draw the pattern into its natural shape.

### TO STRAIGHTEN, OR PRESS, A KNITTED OR CROCHETED WOOLEN ARTICLE

Wring out a white cotton cloth in cold water. Spread cloth on table, then place article on cloth, with right side up, and pin in desired shape. Cover with a dry cloth, and let it remain until entirely dry.

If pressing with an iron is preferred, lay the article on a padded board or table, with wrong side up; spread a damp cloth over article and go over it lightly with a warm iron; lift cloth from time to time to let steam escape.





## MEN'S GOLF COAT No. 312

Size 36

Monarch Down

9 Balls Camel

1 Pair each No. 8 and No. 10 Needles

**BACK**—With No. 8 needles cast on 110 sts. K. 2, P. 2, ribbed knitting for 3 inches. Knit 4 rows in Stocking stitch. **1st row Pattern**—K. 6, P. 3, K. 3, P. 3, across row, ending with K. 6. 2nd row—P. 5, K. 5, P. 11, K. 5 across row, ending with P. 5. 3rd row—K. 4, P. 7, K. 9, P. 7 across row ending with K. 4. 4th row—Same as 3rd row with stitches reversed. 5th row—K. 5, P. 5, K. 10, P. 5 across row. 6th row—P. 7, K. 3, P. 13, K. 3 across row. Knit 4 rows stocking stitch. K. 14, P. 3, K. 13, P. 3, repeat same as first row of pattern, changing stitches to make design as described above, with 4 rows of Stocking stitch between pattern. When work measures 18 inches, cast off 5 sts. beginning of next 2 rows. Knit 2 sts. tog. both ends of needle every 2nd row 10 times. Knit until work measures 7½ inches from cast off stitches. Cast off 24 sts. on centre of needle for neck. Knit 8 rows for shoulder, increase 1 st. every 3rd row at neck end of work for 15 times. Increase same as decreased for underarm. Continue to knit down front following pattern as the back with 3 inches of ribbing on bottom. **Band**—On No. 10 needles cast on 18 sts. Knit in Stocking stitch until long enough to go around coat. Making 6 buttonholes 3 inches apart. 1st buttonhole—On 18th row K. 2, cast off 4, K. 6, cast off 4, K. 2.

Next row—P. 2, cast on 4, P. 6, cast on 4, P. 2. Sew on band.

**SLEEVES**—Pick up sts. around armhole (about 70). Knit 4 rows Stocking stitch. Knit in pattern 5 inches. Decreasing every 4 rows 6 times. Continue to knit in pattern until work measures 14 inches. K. 2, P. 2, for 3 inches.

Next P. 22, Everglade P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, Seacrest P. 3, K. 1, P. 6, K. 1, P. 3, Everglade P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, Seacrest P. 22. With Everglade K. 24, P. 1, K. 2. With Seacrest K. 2, P. 1, K. 6, P. 1, K. 3, Everglade K. 2, P. 1, K. 24. Next Everglade K. 23, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, Seacrest P. 3, K. 1, take 3 sts. off on to extra needle, purl next 3 sts., now purl 3 sts. on extra needle, K. 1, P. 3, Everglade P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, K. 23. The Everglade part of the next 5 rows is done in Seed stitch with centre panel of Cable stitch as in Boys' Sweater yoke No. 313, page 14. Next Everglade 1 row as far as centre panel plain knit. Seacrest P. 3, K. 1, take 3 sts. off on to extra needle, purl next 3, now purl 3 sts. on extra needle, K. 1, P. 3, Everglade plain knit to end of row. This completes Everglade band and 2 patterns of Cable stitch in centre panel. **Now with Seacrest wool continue Yoke.** 1st row—K. 2 tog., K. 4, \* P. 1, K. 6, P. 1, K. 4, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with K. 4, K. 2 tog. 2nd row—P. 5, \* K. 1, P. 6, K. 1, P. 4, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with P. 5. 3rd row—K. 5, \* P. 1, K. 6, P. 1, K. 4, repeat from \* to end of row. 4th row—Same as 2nd row. 5th row—Same as 3rd row. 6th row—P. 5, \* K. 1, slip 3 sts. on spare needle, P. 3, then P. 3 sts. on spare needle, K. 1, P. 4, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with P. 5. Repeat these 6 rows 3 times. Next K. 5, P. 1, K. 6, P. 1, K. 4, P. 1, cast off 30 sts. for neck. K. 4, P. 1, K. 6, P. 1, K. 5. Work up shoulder in pattern for 2 more patterns. Work other shoulder same. This completes front.

**BACK**—Cast on 80 sts. Make ribbed band same as front and continue in stocking stitch straight up to underarm. Decrease for underarm same as front. Then with Everglade wool K. 1, row, P. 1 row, K. 5 rows of Seed stitch, K. 1 row. Next with Seacrest wool work Cable stitch pattern for 4 patterns, casting off sts. for neck as on front. Finish back same as front.

**NECK**—With Everglade wool and No. 10 needles pick up stitches from left shoulder across front up to right shoulder. Knit 1 row. 3 rows of Seed stitch. Knit 1 row. Cast off. Repeat on back of neck. Sew Seacrest part of shoulder seams neatly together. Make small loop on Everglade part of front shoulders for buttonhole and sew small button on Everglade band of back shoulders.

**SLEEVES**—With No. 8 needles and Seacrest wool, with right side of work towards you, pick up and knit 60 sts. around armhole. Continue in stocking stitch until sleeve measures 9½ inches, knitting 2 tog. on each 8th row. With Everglade wool and No. 10 needles knit 2 inches of ribbing for cuff like band at bottom of Sweater. Cast off.

## SKIRT

**BACK**—With No. 8 needles and Seacrest cast on 98 sts. Purl 1 row. Next P. 2, \* K. 6, P. 2, K. 1, P. 2, K. 6, repeat from \* to end of row finishing with P. 2. Next K. 2, \* P. 6, K. 2, P. 1, K. 2, repeat from \* to end of row finishing with K. 2. Continue with these 2 rows until work measures 10 inches. Next with No. 10 needles K. 1 row, P. 1 row. Next K. 2 tog. at each end of knit row. Purl 1 row, knit until there are 5 decreases of K. 2 tog. at each end of knit rows. Next knit 6 rows of ribbing. Next row K. 2, M. 1, K. 2 tog. to end of row. Next 6 more rows of ribbing. Cast off.

**FRONT**—Cast on 106 sts. P. 1 row. Next P. 3, \* K. 6, P. 2, K. 1, P. 2, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with P. 3. Next K. 3, \* P. 6, K. 2, P. 1, K. 2, repeat from \* to end of row, finishing with K. 3. Repeat these 8 rows until work measures 10 inches and continue with work same as back. Join all seams neatly.



## LADIES' 4-PIECE KNIT SKI SET 317

Size 38

### Monarch Down

24 Balls Copen. Blue, 2 Balls White, 2 Balls Black  
4 No. 7 Needles, 4 No. 10 Needles, 4 No. 14 Steel Needles

**RIGHT LEG**—Using two No. 7 needles, cast on 100 sts. Stocking stitch throughout. Increase each end on every 20th row until 22 inches worked (112 sts.). On next knit row increase each end and on every 10th st. (124). **Count rows from here.** 1st—Purl. 2nd—Increase each end. 3rd—Purl. 4th—Increase each end and every 12th st. 5th—Purl. 6th—Increase each end. 7th—Purl. 8th—Cast off 4, knit to end. 9th—Purl 2 tog. and purl to end. 10th—Cast off 4, knit to end. 11th—Knit 2 tog. each end. 12th—K. 2 tog. each end. 13th—Purl. 14th to 19th—Repeat last 2 rows. 20th—Increase every 10th st. 21st—Purl. 22nd—Same as 12th. 23rd—Purl. 24th—Same as 20th. 25th—Purl. Knit left leg to correspond, taking care to start casting off for shaping on opposite side. **At bottom of leg** with No. 10 needles pick up 66 sts. and K. 1, P. 1, for  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Cast off. **N.B.**—If preferred 66 sts. may be cast on in first place and knitted with No. 10 needles and then increase to 100 and carry on as above.

Neatly press as far as knitted and sew up to two needles, carefully matching knitted rows. From now on use four No. 7 needles. There will be about 120 sts. on front needle. Make seam centre front and put piece of White wool to remind you that it is centre front. 60 sts. each side of wool. Arrange other sts. comfortably on other two needles and knit as follows: Knit 2 rounds, finishing so that front needle is next to be worked. 1st—K. 58, K. 2 tog., K. 2 tog., K. 58, finish round. 2nd—Knit across front needle, K. 2 tog. at beginning of next needle and end of next needle (this begins shaping for hips). 3rd—Front needle, K. 2 tog., knit to 2 before seam and knit these tog., K. 2 tog. again and 2 tog. at end of front needle. Finish round. 4th—As 2nd. 5th—Decrease each side of seam and finish round. 6th—K. 2 tog. at beginning and end of all needles. 7th—Knit round. 8th—As 5th. 9th—As 6th. Repeat last four rows once. 14th—Knit every 11th and 12th sts. tog. on the round. There will be about 212 sts. now, a few more or less is not important, and of course more stitches will be needed for a stouter build. We are now as far as front trouser pocket. Knit across front needle until 34 sts. past seam stitch then: turn and purl back until you have 68 sts. (34 each side of seam). Turn, K. 2 tog. each end (66). Turn and purl back. **It would now be better to slip** all stitches except the front needle 66 on to other needles and slip an elastic band over each end to keep stitches in place. Continue decreasing on knit side and purling back until you have 46 sts. left. Slip on to spare needle and break wool. Tie wool at end of needle so that you will start with a knit row (not purl). 1st—Increase in first stitch by knitting in first stitch and before taking wool from left hand needle knit again in to back. K. 2 tog. each side of middle back, knit to end and increase in last stitch. 2nd—Purl. 3rd—Increase in first and last st. 4th—Purl. Repeat last four rows 6 times more making in all 28 rows of Stocking stitch.

**TO SHAPE FOR BACK OF TROUSER**—Knit until 12 sts. past middle back seam and turn. Purl 24, turn, K. 24th and 25th tog., K. 12 more and turn, purl, and P. 36th and 37th tog., P. 12 more and turn. Continue these two rows always knitting the last before turn and 1st of new twelve until all stitches have been taken up. This makes a very nice shaped back line. On first knit row after when continuing round knit last of shaped row and first st. of front needle tog. and the same at other end. This avoids making a slight hole in work. Now arrange stitches on three needles so that middle front is in middle of one needle and middle back at the end and beginning of other needles. There should be 200 stitches left on needles now, if you have more or less increase and decrease carefully until 200. Knit in Stocking stitch 1 inch from pocket slit, then change to No. 10 needles and K. 1 row, P. 1 row for  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Knit one round,



increasing on every 10th st. by knitting in back of st. as previously explained. You have now 220 sts. and knit these on to No. 7 needles. Find centre front and slip in White wool. Prepare now for Zipper opening. Knit round until 16 sts. before centre front: Turn and purl back until you reach 16 beyond centre front. This is where opening commences. Turn, knit back to 16 beyond; turn again continuing in this way for 3 inches.

**UPPER POCKET OPENINGS**—Arrange stitches as follows: 64 sts. on 1 needle (left front with right side of work facing you) 44 on right front and 106 on back needle (slip White wool through garment 53 sts. each side of middle back, this will show you side seam). On needle with 44 sts., work along 34 and slip other sts. on to side needle. With right side of work facing K. 2 tog. and knit to end and purl back (on the 34 sts.) until only 24 sts. are left, finish with purl row and break wool. Slip on spare needle or safety pin. Join wool at opening of other side (left with right side of garment facing you) and knit along 48 and slip other sts. on to side needle. Purl back 48. Knit to within 2 sts. of end and knit these tog. Purl back and continue these two rows until you have 38 sts. left and finish with a knit row. Put these on safety pin as before. Now arrange the 106 sts. on one needle for back and the others on their respective needles and work as follows: As the work is now divided on account of the pocket slits, we will call them rows instead of rounds. At the beginning of the next 10 rows increase in the 1st st. This brings you to armholes.

**WORK ON BACK NEEDLE ONLY NOW.** On every knit row begin with K. 1, S. 1, K. 1, and put slip st. over and end with

K. 2 tog., K. 1. Purl back. Continue until 64 rows are completed. Cast off. This is top back of neck.

Continue on left hand needle now and increase (as before on the 10 rows already done) each pocket end and decrease armhole end until you have the same number of rows to correspond with pocket edge (safety pin stitches). This completes to pocket slit and you continue right across to zipper opening. Continue in stocking stitch for 34 rows taking care to decrease every other row at armhole end. 35th row—Knit from opening 15 sts. (this is centre front), turn and purl back, K. 13, and turn and purl back, K. 11, turn, purl back, K. 9, turn and purl back. K. 7, 6, 5, 4, and 3 turning back and purling each time after. Knit 2 tog., knit 1 and cast off breaking wool. (This is the part that zipper is sewn to later and fits up left side of front). Tie wool at centre neck front again and knit across to armhole decreasing as usual. Purl back. On every knit row at neck end knit 2 tog., (decreasing armhole as well). Continue until 2 sts. remain and cast off.

Work other side of front to correspond increasing at pocket end and decreasing every other row at armhole end. When pocket slit is finished, work across to Zipper opening.

From now on at the beginning of every 4th purl row purl the first 2 sts. tog. Continue until 4 sts. remain and cast off.

**Care must be taken throughout at sleeve ends of Suit and the Sleeve edges themselves to keep every other row decreased as this Raglan sleeve must be evenly decreased.**

**SLEEVE**—Cast on 56 sts. on No. 10 needles and K. 1, P. 1, for 6½ inches, increasing each end at every inch. Now on No. 7 needles knit in Stocking stitch, increasing every 10th row at each end until 7½ inches are completed. On next knit row increase on first 2 and last 2 (four in all). Increase like this on every 8th row until another 4 inches. 18 inches now completed. Now on every knit row decrease at each end until you have the same number of decreasings as edge of suit. Cast off and this will be the neck part of raglan sleeve.

**POCKETS—Lower Pocket**—On No. 7 needles, cast on 45 sts. and work in stocking stitch throughout. At end of each knit row K. 2 tog., K. 1. Purl back. Repeat these 2 rows until 26 sts. left. On each knit row now increase 1 on the same side as you decreased until you again have 45 sts. on. Cast off. On **Upper Pockets** follow same directions, casting on 40 sts. and decreasing until you have 25 and increasing back on same side until you have the 40 again. Cast off. Sew neatly up the slanting side and bottom and up as far as pocket opening and press well before putting pockets in.

**COLLAR**—On No. 10 needles, pick up 90 sts. round neck, taking care to pick evenly across both sleeves and evenly all round. K. 1, P. 1, for 30 rows. 31st—With wrong side of Ski Suit facing, increase 1 each end. 32nd—Knit. 33rd—Purl. 34th—Knit. 35th—Tie on White and increase each end of row. 36th—Knit. 37th—Purl. 38th—Knit. 39th—Tie on Black and knit. 40th—Knit. 41st—Purl. 42nd—Tie on Blue and repeat from 31st row. Cast off.

**BANDS OVER POCKETS—Lower Pocket Flaps**—On No. 10 needles, with right side of suit facing, pick up 30 sts. with Blue wool, knitting them as picked up. 1st—Knit. 2nd—Purl. 3rd—Tie on White and purl. 4th—Purl. 5th—Knit. 6th—Tie on Black and knit. 7th—Knit. 8th—Purl. 9th—Cast off. **Upper Pocket Flaps**—Pick up 26 sts. only and continue as above.

**Gauntlet Part of Mitt**—On No. 7 needles, cast on 32 sts. with Black wool. 1st—Knit. 2nd—Purl. 3rd—Knit. Tie on White wool. 4th—Knit. 5th—Knit. 6th—Purl. 7th—Knit. Tie on Blue wool. 8th—Knit. 9th—Knit. 10th—Purl. 11th—Knit. Bring forward Black wool, knit and repeat from 1st row, seven times, making 24 ridges of color. Along the neatest edge pick up 72 sts. (three in each ridge). Knit five rows with Black wool and cast off.

**Hand Part**. With thumb knitted with No. 10 needles. Blue wool. Pick up along edge where wool has been carried along 48 sts. (2 in each ridge). K. 1, P. 1, five rows. 6th—K. 4, K. 2 tog. along (40). 7th—Purl. 8th—Knit. 9th—Increase each end of purl row. 10th—Knit. 11th—Purl. 12th—Knit and in-

crease each end. 13th—Purl. 14th—K. 21, increasing in next 2 sts., K. 21. 15th—Purl. 16th—K. 21, increasing in next. K. 2, increasing in next. K. 21. 17th—Purl. Continue these two rows, increasing on 22nd st. and 22nd st. from end until you have 18 sts. between 2 st. increasings on row 14. You will now have 60 sts. on needle. Continue as follows: 1st—K. 39 and turn. 2nd—Purl back 18. 3rd—Knit on 18. 4th—Purl 18. 5th—Knit, K. 2 tog. each end of 18. 6th—Purl. 7th—Knit. 8th—Purl. 9th—Same as row 5. (14 on needle). Continue on 14 for 6 rows. On next knit row K. 2 tog., K. 2, K. 2 tog., K. 1, K. 2 tog., K. 2, K. 2 tog. (10 sts). Next row—Purl. Next—K. 1, K. 2 tog. along and break wool. Run wool through stitches and carefully sew up thumb, matching rows. Commence with needle with 21 knit sts. and pick up 3 at base of thumb. Continue stocking stitch until 44 rows are completed from the wrist, K. 1, P. 1 (45 on needle). 1st—K. 8th and 9th tog. 2nd—Purl. 3rd—K. 7th and 8th tog. 4th—Purl. Continue as above taking 6/7 tog., 5/6 tog., etc., with purl between until K. 1, K. 2 tog., when break wool, run darning needle along and carefully sew up side. Press carefully.

**SOCK**—No. 14 steel needles. 24 on each needle and K. 1, P. 1, 30 rows. Change to K. 3, P. 1, 28 rows. Divide for heel, 36 on one needle and keep these K. 3, P. 1, right up to toe. Put other 36 sts. on one needle and K. 1 row and P. 1 row for 32 rows. **To Shape Heel**—P. 18, P. 2 tog., P. 1. Turn. K. 4, slip 1, K. 1, put slip st. over, K. 1. Turn. P. 5, P. 2 tog., P. 1. Turn. K. 6, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 1, and repeat in this manner until you have all stitches worked off. Pick up 18 sts. at side of heel, knitting them as picked up, K. 3, P. 1, across instep needle and pick up 18 other side to correspond. Now divide heel stitches on 2 needles, keeping 36 on front needle all the time. **To Shape the Foot**—Knit in pattern across instep (front) on 1st side needle, K. 1, slip 1, K. 1, put slip st. over, knit to end of needle. Knit to within three sts. from end of 2nd side needle, K. 2 tog., K. 1. Knit one round without decreasing. Repeat these two rows until 18 on each side needle. Now knit for 6½ inches, keeping instep needle in pattern. **To work Toe**—On 1st round knit every 6th and 7th tog. Next 6 rounds plain. Knit every 5th and 6th tog., K. 5 rounds plain. Knit every 4th and 5th tog., K. 4 rounds plain. Continue until you knit every 2nd and 3rd tog., K. 2 rounds plain. K. 2 tog. all round and break wool. Bring needle through stitches and sew carefully, taking care that sewn part is flat with foot shape.

**Top of Ski**—With Blue wool cast on 11. 1st—Knit. 2nd—Purl. 3rd—Knit. 4th—Tie on Black wool, knit. 5th—Knit. 6th—Purl. 7th—Knit. 8th—Tie on White and knit. 9th—Knit. 10th—Purl. 11th—Knit. 12th—Bring up Blue and knit. 13th—Knit. Continue from row 2 until you have 24 ridges. Cast off. Along both edges with No. 10 needles, pick up 48 sts. with Black wool and K. 5 rows. Cast off with No. 7 needle. Sew carefully at ends and along top of sock.

**HAT**—No. 10 needles, cast on 10 sts. and knit in colored ribs in exactly same manner as for sock tops until you have 51 ridges. Along neatest edge pick up 102 sts. with No. 10 needles (2 per ridge) and knit 5 rows and cast off with No. 7 needle. **Upper part of Hat Blue**—On other edge pick up with No. 7 needles 90 sts. and knit as you pick up, having right side of work facing you. Purl back. Knit and increase in every 9th st. Purl back. (100). Continue in Stocking stitch until 12 rows are completed. Tie on Black and knit along. Knit back with Black. Tie on White and knit along. Knit back in White. With Blue knit along, knitting every 9th and 10th sts. tog. Continue five rows and on next knit row knit 8th and 9th tog. At the beginning of 10th Blue tie on Black. Knit 2 rows. Tie on White. Knit 7th and 8th tog. on 1st White row and knit back with White. With Blue continue and on the 2nd, 6th and 8th decrease over previous decreasings. 9th—Purl. 10th—Tie on Black and knit 2 rows decreasing the 3rd and 4th stitch on 1st Black row. Tie on White and decrease every 2nd and 3rd on first White row. Knit White back. Tie on Black and knit 2 tog. across and knit back. Break wool and bring darning needle through stitches and carefully sew up seam of hat.

Sew zipper in opening, carrying it half way up the neck line and sew two snaps to keep wrap over of collar fastened.

Press all parts well and sew garment together and give another good press to all seams.

## Monarch Dove

8 Balls Antibes Blue 3 Balls Lugano Blue

1 Pair each No. 12 and No. 10 Needles

1 Fine Crochet Hook

## JACKET

**SLEEVES**—Cast on in Antibes Blue 56 sts. on No. 10 needles. K. 1, P. 1, until work measures 4 inches. Join Lugano wool and increase 1 st. every 6th st. to make 65 sts. on needle, P. 1 row. **1st Pattern Row**—K. 2, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 6 \*, repeat from \* to \* twice. K. 17, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6, repeat from \* to \* 3 times, K. 2. **2nd row**—Purl back. **3rd row**—K. 3 \*, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 6 \*, repeat from \* to \* twice, K. 15 \*, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6 \*, repeat from \* to \* 3 times, K. 3. **4th row**—Purl, and every other row hereafter continue pattern knitting one st. more each end and 2 less in centre until point meets. Continue the pattern working holes straight, increasing 1 st. beginning and end of every 10th row. When sleeve measures 17½ inches, cast off 3 sts. beginning of each needleful 4 times, then decrease every plain row by slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over at beginning of needle and K. 2 tog., K. 1 end of needle, when armhole measures 5 inches join Antibes wool, continue in Antibes wool decreasing as before until 18 sts. remain. Place sts. on holder.

**WAIST BAND**—On No. 10 needles in Lugano wool, cast on 200 sts. **1st row**—Purl 1 row. **2nd row**—K. 1, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 8, K. 2 tog., M. 1, \* K. 5, P. 2, K. 1, P. 2 \*, repeat from \* to \* 16 times. K. 5, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 8, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 1. **3rd row**—P. 12, \* P. 5, K. 2, P. 1, K. 2 \*, repeat from \* to \* to within 12 sts., P. 12. Repeat these last 2 rows until work measures 1½ inches on front of work in centre of the K. 8. Cast off 5 sts. to form buttonhole and continue pattern. On purl row back cast on 5 sts. to complete buttonhole, and every 3½ inches hereafter make buttonhole same.

**BACK**—Place 59 sts. on holder for right front, increase 1 st. every 12th st. until there are 92 sts. on needle, place remaining sts. on holder for left front. Continue knitting back of Sweater. Purl entire row. **1st row of Pattern**—K. 8 \* M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 6, \* repeat from \* to \* twice. M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 24, K. 2 tog., M. 1, \* K. 6, K. 2 tog., M. 1 \*, repeat from \* to \* twice, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 8. Purl back. Repeat these last 2 rows, knitting 1 more st. at beginning and end of pattern row and 2 less in centre until there are only 10 sts. in centre instead of 24. Then run holes up straight, until work measures 10 inches from ribbed band. Cast off 3 sts. beginning each needleful 4 times. Continue work, decreasing on Pattern row by K. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over at beginning of needle and K. 2 tog., K. 1 at end of needle until armhole measures 5 inches. Join Antibes wool and in Antibes wool K. 1, P. 1, continuing decreasing until Antibes work measures 4 inches. Place sts. on holder.

**RIGHT FRONT**—Take sts. off holder increasing to make 63 sts. 1 purl row to match back. Start pattern from buttonhole side. Make buttonhole same as before. (Pattern) \* K. 14, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6 \*, repeat from \* to \* 3 times. K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 2. Purl back. Continue pattern knitting one less after buttonhole band each pattern row until there are 9 holes same as back, then run holes straight up until work measures 10 inches from band. Decrease for armhole same as back on end of pattern row only, leaving band as usual, joining Antibes when armhole measures 5 inches, but leaving buttonhole band in Lugano wool. Continue decreasing on armhole side until Antibes wool measures 4 inches near button side. Now discontinue knitting Lugano band. In Antibes wool knit as usual 1 row, turn and knit to within 4 sts., turn and knit to end of decreasing as usual, then knit to within 8 sts. and continue doing

this knitting 4 sts. less each back row, until there are none left to knit. Slip unknitted sts. on holder.

**LEFT FRONT**—Purl row as right front, starting pattern from underarm side instead of button side reversing pattern instead of K. 2 to M. 1, \* K. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over. \* Take all sts. off holder 1st right front, then sleeve, then back, then sleeve and left front, change to No. 12 needles and continue Lugano band same as before, but knitting Antibes wool, K. 1, P. 1, for 1 row, and P. 1, K. 1 next row, working these 2 rows 3 times. Cast off tight. Sew together, press, and sew on buttons.

## PULLOVER (Set No. 308)

Size 36

## Monarch Dove

7 Balls Lugano Blue 2 Balls Antibes Blue

1 Pair No. 10 Needles

**FRONT**—Cast on 96 sts. Lugano wool. K. 1, P. 1, for 3 inches. P. 24, K. 1, P. 1 (48), P. 24. Then **start pattern**—K. 6, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, then with Antibes wool K. 16. Use Lugano wool, K. 1, P. 1, till 24 sts. on needle. K. 16 with Antibes wool, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6. Next row, P. 9 with Lugano wool, P. 16 Antibes. Continue ribbing with Lugano wool, P. 16 with Antibes, P. 9 Lugano. Continue this way, taking one more stitch each row, but still keeping 16 Antibes between. Pattern is started every time there are 8 sts. from the last pattern. Continue till work measures 14 inches, then start armhole. Cast off 3 sts. at beginning of the next 4 rows then decrease 1 st. at each end of needle every knit row. When armhole is 4 inches long start Antibes wool. Knit to centre of work, then turn K. 1, P. 1, still decreasing one at armhole. Next row, continue ribbing till 6 sts. from centre and K. 1, P. 1, alternately. Do 18 rows and shape for neck K. 1, P. 1, to 3 sts. from centre, turn, K. 1, P. 1, to end. K. 1, P. 1, to 6 sts. from centre, turn, K. 1, P. 1, to end. K. 1, P. 1, to 9 sts. from centre, turn, K. 1, P. 1, to end. Put sts. on st. holder and work other shoulder same.

**BACK**—Same as front without dividing at centre, decreasing each end of needle till 35 sts. remain. Put these on holder.

**SLEEVES**—Cast on 56 sts. K. 1, P. 1, for 3 inches. P. 1, M. 1, for five times, P. 10, K. 1, P. 1, till 15 sts. on needle. P. 10, M. 1, P. 1, to end (67 sts.). K. 6, M. 1, slip 1, K. 1, pass slip st. over, K. 12 Antibes wool, K. 1, P. 1 Lugano wool till 20 sts. Knit 12 Antibes, K. 2 tog., M. 1, K. 6. Continue sleeve like the pattern in front. Increase 1 st. each end of 8th row till 2 sts. Knit till work measures 17½ inches. Cast off 3 at beginning of needle for the next 4 rows. Decrease each end of every knit row for 12 times. Start Antibes wool, decreasing till 24 rows of Antibes wool. Put sts. on holder. Both sleeves are alike. **To join**—press work with damp cloth and iron on wrong side. Sew seams and then take all sts. on one needle and K. 1, P. 1, alternately for 5 rows. Cast off on right side of work.

## GIRLS' PULLOVER No. 310

K. 4, P. 30. **3rd row**—K. 26, wool over, P. 2 tog. (6 times), K. 26. Continue with this taking 4 more stitches each side of pattern, till it runs across Sweater. Do 6 rows of pattern and **then start neck**. P. 1, wool over, P. 2 tog. (9 times). Cast off **24. Right Shoulder**—\*P. 2 tog., wool over (\* repeat 9 times). Cast off 4 sts. Repeat these two rows until all stitches are gone. Left shoulder work to match. **Sleeve**—Cast on 44 in Cherry Rose, make cuff to match band at bottom. K. 1 row plain, make 1 st. in every 6 (51). Every 8th row increase 1 st. each end of needle (making 65). Then every 4th row for 16 rows (73). Cast off 3 sts. at the beginning of each row for 6 rows. Decrease 1 st. at both ends of every knit row for 11 times. Cast off 2 at the beginning of each row till 10 sts. remain. Cast off.

Both sleeves are alike. Back same as front. Press and sew up.

Before joining sleeve do 1 row White, 1 row Black of double crochet, make 3 loops in Cherry on each shoulder.

25th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 10 sts., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

29th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog. twice, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 13 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

33rd row—W.O., K. 3, W.O., K. 1, K. 2 tog. three times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 16 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. three times, K. 1, W.O., K. 3. Repeat the second row three times.

37th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 2 tog. four times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to last 19 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. four times, (W.O., K. 1) twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

41st row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 2 tog. five times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 22 sts., W.O., K. 1 six times, K. 2 tog. five times, (W.O., K. 1) three times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row 3 times.

45th row—W.O., K. 3, (W.O., K. 1), four times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 7 sts., (W.O., K. 1) four times, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

49th row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog. six times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 10 sts., (W.O., K. 1) five times, K. 2 tog., K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

53rd row—W.O., K. 3, K. 2 tog. twice, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 13 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. twice, K. 3. Repeat the 2nd row three times.

57th row—W.O., K. 3, W.O., K. 1, K. 2 tog. three times, \*(W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. six times, repeat from \* to the last 16 sts., (W.O., K. 1) six times, K. 2 tog. three times, K. 1, W.O., K. 3.

58th row—W.O., K. plain to the end of the row.

59th row—Like the 58th row.

60th row—W.O., K. plain to the end of the row, at the end of which cast on 17 sts. (these 17 sts. form the commencement of the Peak).

THE PEAK—Knit plain 16 sts., K. 2 tog., turn.

1st row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 3, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

2nd row—K. 15, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

3rd row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 2, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 3, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

4th row—K. 16, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

5th row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 5, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

6th row—K. 17, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

7th row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 3, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 4, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

8th row—K. 18, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice, turn.

9th row—S. 1, K. 1, W.O., K. 2 tog., K. 4, W.O., S. 1, K. 2 tog., pass the slip st. over, W.O., K. 6, W.O., K. 2 tog., W.O., K. 2.

10th row—Cast off loosely 5 sts. K. 14, W.O., K. 2 tog. twice.

This completes one peak, repeat from the 1st to the 10th row until all the stitches from the border have been worked up. Then slip these stitches on to a stitch-holder to be carried forward for the next side.

With the right side of the work facing, commence again from the beginning of the body.

After working each body pick up the stitches of the last row of peaks and continue in the pattern.

When the two sides are completed, cast off the peak sts. Sew together the cast-on and the cast-off edges of the peak. Join together the corners of the body by sewing through the loops, very loosely, in herringbone stitch.

Same as 2nd row. Repeat these 4 rows 3 times. Complete pattern by knitting 13th row same as 1st. Continue front in Stocking stitch for 10 rows. Cast off 10 sts. at neck end and finish shoulder by decreasing 1 st. at neck end 3 times. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT—On remaining 30 sts. make smocking. 1st row—K. 5, K. 1 Banana, \* K. 3 Lugano, K. 1 Banana, repeat from \* 4 times, K. 8. 2nd row—Purl 7, P. 1 Banana, \*P. 1 Lugano, P. 1 Banana, repeat from \* 9 times, P. 4. 3rd row—K. 3, K. 1 Banana, \* K. 3 Lugano, K. 1 Banana, repeat from \* 5 times, K. 6. 4th row—Same as 2nd. Finish right shoulder same as left. Cast off. Join front and back neatly at shoulders. Pieces for button and buttonhole down left front. Crochet 4 rows of d.c. with 15 d.c. in each row. On right front crochet 5 rows of d.c., making 2 buttonholes on 3rd and 4th rows by making 2 chain and missing 2 d.c. on 3rd row twice and making 2 d.c. over each 2 chain on 4th row.

NECK—With Lugano 1 row of 50 d.c., 3 rows of Banana d.c. picking up back stitch only of Lugano row to form ridge same as rest of Banana bands. One more row of Lugano starting from corner.

SLEEVES—With right side of work towards you pick up and knit 55 sts. Knit 10 rows in stocking stitch. On 11th row decrease 1 st. at each end of needle. Repeat these decreases between each 10 rows 4 times. On these 45 sts. knit until sleeve measures 10 inches. Make Banana band same as bottom of Sweater. Cast off loosely. Sew up all seams neatly and finish off all ends of wool with darning needle.

## PANTS

With Lugano wool cast on 80 sts. Knit in rib of K. 2, P. 2 for 6 rows. 7th row—K. 2, M. 1, K. 2 sts. tog. to end of row. Next row knit plain. Then rib knitting for 6 rows. Next, K. 1 row, P. 1 row. Next, K. 10, turn, P. back 10; K. 14, turn, P. 14; K. 18, turn, P. 18; K. 24, turn, P. 24; K. 30, turn, P. 30; K. 36, turn, P. 36; knit entire row, P. 1 row. Continue K. 1 row, P. 1 row until work measures about 10 inches on straight edge. Then K. 2 sts. tog. each end of every knit row 7 times. K. 1 row, P. 1 row twice, then make band of Banana and Lugano same as bottom of Sweater. Cast off.

Repeat for other leg. Be careful to start increasing on purl side so that work will join evenly. Sew up all seams evenly.

## STITCHES USED IN KNITTING INSTRUCTIONS

**Seed Stitch:** 1st row—Knit 1 st., purl 1 st., repeat across row. 2nd row—Purl 1 st., knit 1 st., repeat across row. Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

**Stocking (Stockinette) Stitch:** 1st row—Knit plain across row. 2nd row—Purl across row. Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

**Ribbed Knitting:** Knit 2, purl 2. Always remember to put thread back after purling a stitch before knitting the stitches following.

**Plain Garterstitch Knitting:** Always slip first stitch in knitting unless otherwise stated. Insert needle in front of stitch. Wool over needle, draw through stitch, and repeat till all stitches have been knitted.
