Pattern Scale: 9 sts. to 1 inch

14 rows to 1 inch

Garter St. Scale: 9 sts. to 1 inch

18 rows to 1 inch

1 No. 2 Steel Crochet Hook

MINERVA VELVEEN

Pearl Grey No. 1155..... 12 Balls

Trim—Black No. 1136..... 1 Ball

Total 13 Balls

The entire suit is worked in pattern with Pearl Grey. The scarf and pocket tabs are worked in Garter St. with Black. The skirt is worked in two pieces.

PATTERN: Multiple of 8 sts.

Row 1—And all uneven rows, K.

Row 2—* K. 4, P. 4, repeat from * across row.

Row 4—* K. 3, P. 5, repeat from * across row.

Row 6—* K. 2, P. 6, repeat from * across row.

Row 8—* K. 1, P. 7, repeat from * across row.

Row 10—* P. 4, K. 4, repeat from * across row.

Row 12—P. 4, * K. 3, P. 5, repeat from * across row, ending K. 3, P. 1.

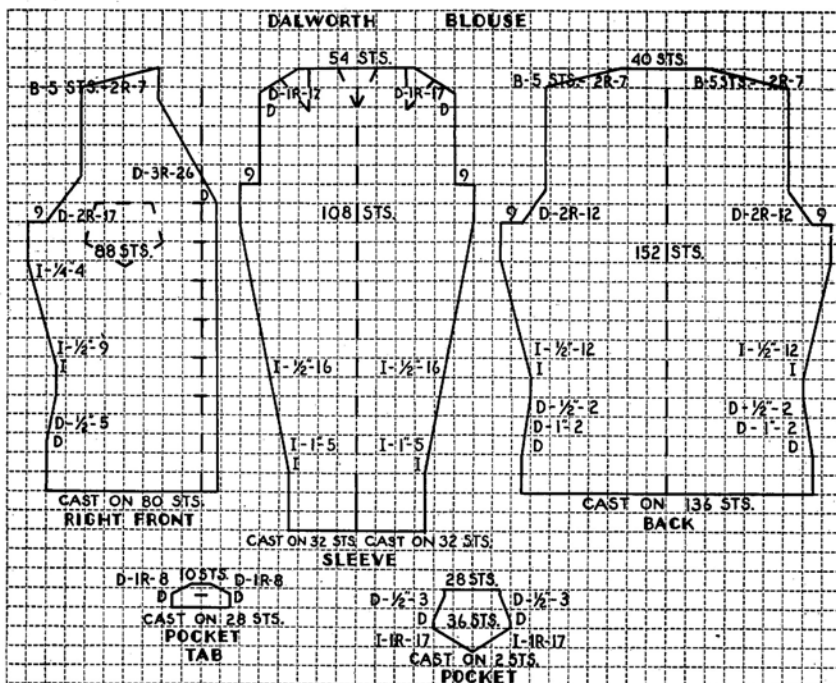
Row 14—P. 4, * K. 2, P. 6, repeat from * across row, ending K. 2, P. 2.

Row 16—P. 4, * K. 1, P. 7, repeat from * across row, ending K. 1, P. 3.

Repeat these 16 rows for pattern.

JACKET: Follow chart for Right Front. Buttonholes are 6 sts. wide and 4 sts. from edge. To work buttonholes, see page 45.

Work Left Front to correspond, omitting buttonholes.



Follow charts for Back, Sleeves (working first 3 inches separately), 2 Pockets and 2 Black Pocket Tabs. The buttonhole in the pocket tab is 6 sts. wide and 11 sts. from edges.

Finishing, see page 45. Work 2 rows S. C. around all edges. Sew darts in sleeves (as indicated on chart by dotted lines). Sew pockets in place as indicated on chart by dotted lines. Sew pocket tabs to jacket, 1/2 inch above pockets. Face fronts with 1 1/2 inch matching grosgrain ribbon.

SCARF: Cast on 91 sts. and work in Garter St. for entire scarf.

Row 1—And all uneven rows, K.

Row 2—Increase in first st., K. 43, K. 3 tog., K. 43, increase in last st.

Row 4—K. 44, K. 3 tog., K. 44.

Row 6—Increase in first st., K. 42, K. 3 tog., K. 42, increase in last st.

Continue to increase at the beginning and end of every 4th row and K. 3 center sts. together every other row, until there are 55 sts. on needle.

Now continuing to decrease every other row in the center, increase 1 st. at the beginning and end of

every other row. When scarf measures 14 inches, K. 2 tog. at the beginning and end of every other row, continuing decreases every row at center, until all sts. are worked off.

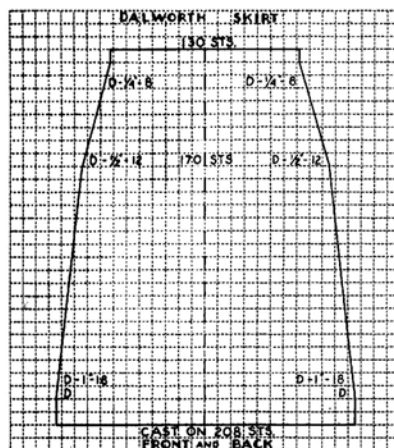
Work other half of scarf in same manner and join both sections.

Sew scarf to back of neck.

SKIRT: Follow chart for Front and Back. Finishing, see page 45.

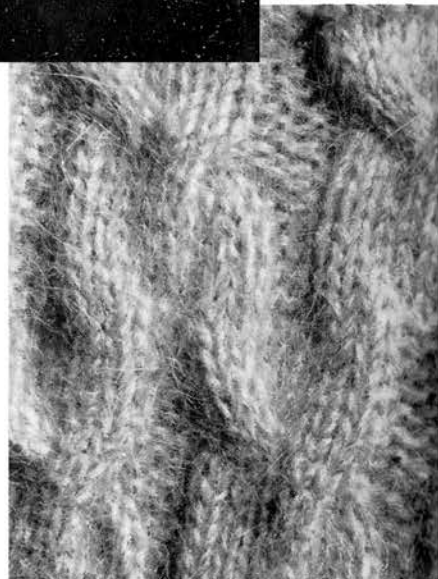
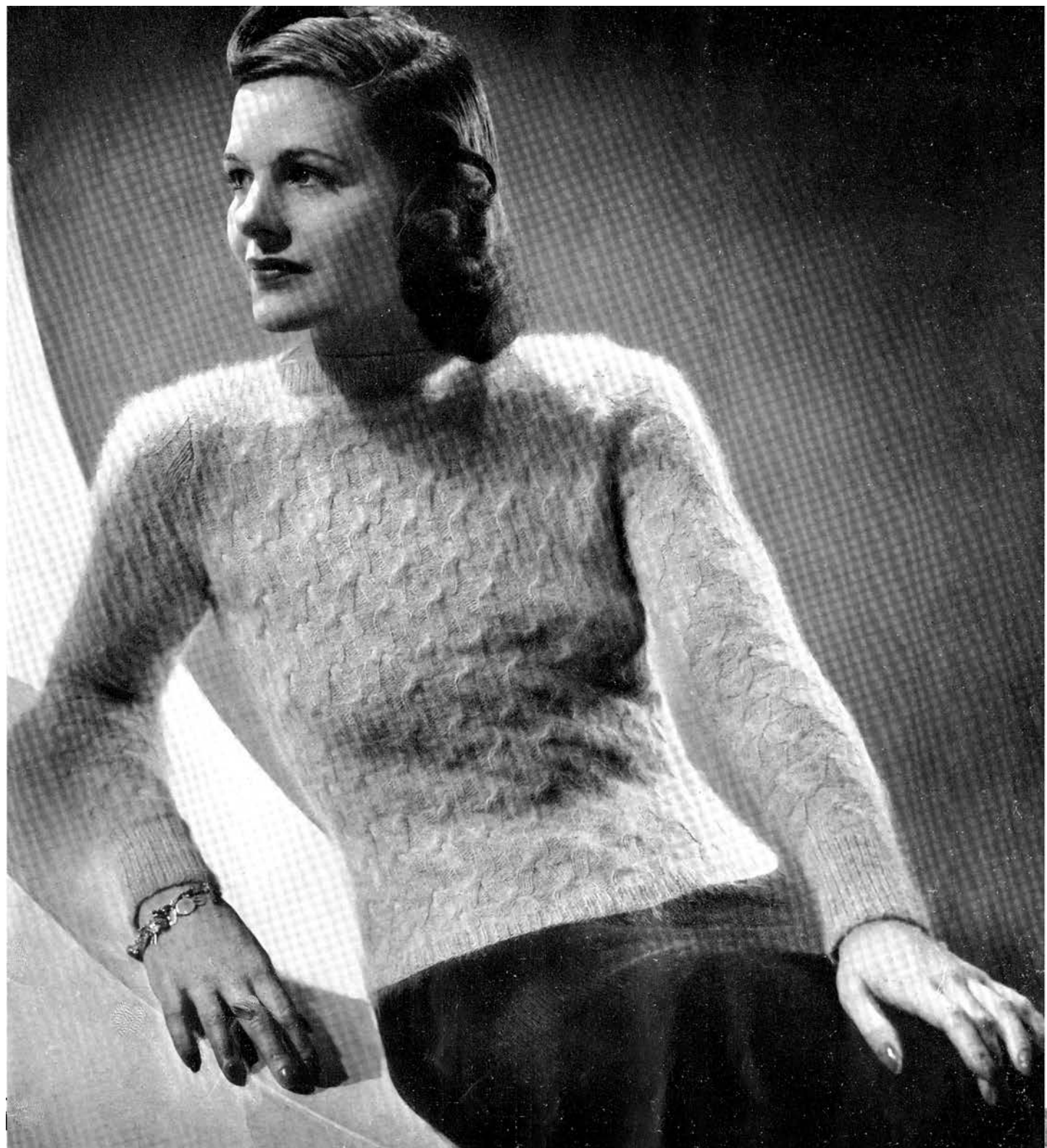

Slip-over—Natural No. 491.... 11 Balls
Blouse —Natural No. 491.... 11 Balls

Total 22 Balls

The same charts are used for the slip-over and blouse. The slip-over is worked in Stockinette St. with bands of ribbing (indicated on charts by dotted lines) worked as follows:

Row 1—* K. 1, P. 1, repeat from * across row, ending K. 1.

Row 2—* P. 1, K. 1, repeat from * across row, ending P. 1.

SLIP-OVER: Follow charts for Front, Back and Sleeves.

Finishing, see page 45. Sew shoulders with front overlapping back at dotted lines.

The blouse is worked in pattern with bands of ribbing (indicated on charts by dotted lines) worked in same manner as slip-over.

PATTERN: Multiple of 12 sts. plus 3.

Row 1—K. 3, * P. 3, K. 9, repeat from * across row.

Row 2—* P. 9, K. 3, repeat from * across row, ending P. 3.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2, two times more.

Row 7—K. 3, * P. 3, slip the next 3 sts. on double point needle, place

in front of work, K. next 3 sts., then K. the 3 sts. from double point needle, K. 3, repeat from * across row.

Row 8—Same as Row 2.

Row 9—K. 3, * P. 3, K. 3, slip next 3 sts. on double point needle, place in back of work, K. next 3 sts., then K. the 3 sts. from double point needle, repeat from * across row.

Row 10—Same as Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2, two times.

Row 15—* K. 9, P. 3, repeat from * across row, ending K. 3.

Row 16—P. 3, * K. 3, P. 9, repeat from * across row.

Repeat Rows 15 and 16, two times.

Row 21—* Slip 3 sts. on double

point needle, place in front of work, K. next 3 sts., then K. the 3 sts. from double point needle, K. 3, P. 3, repeat from * across row, ending K. 3.

Row 22—Same as Row 16.

Row 23—* K. 3, slip next 3 sts. on double point needle, place in back of work, K. next 3 sts., then K. the 3 sts. from double point needle, P. 3, repeat from * across row, ending K. 3.

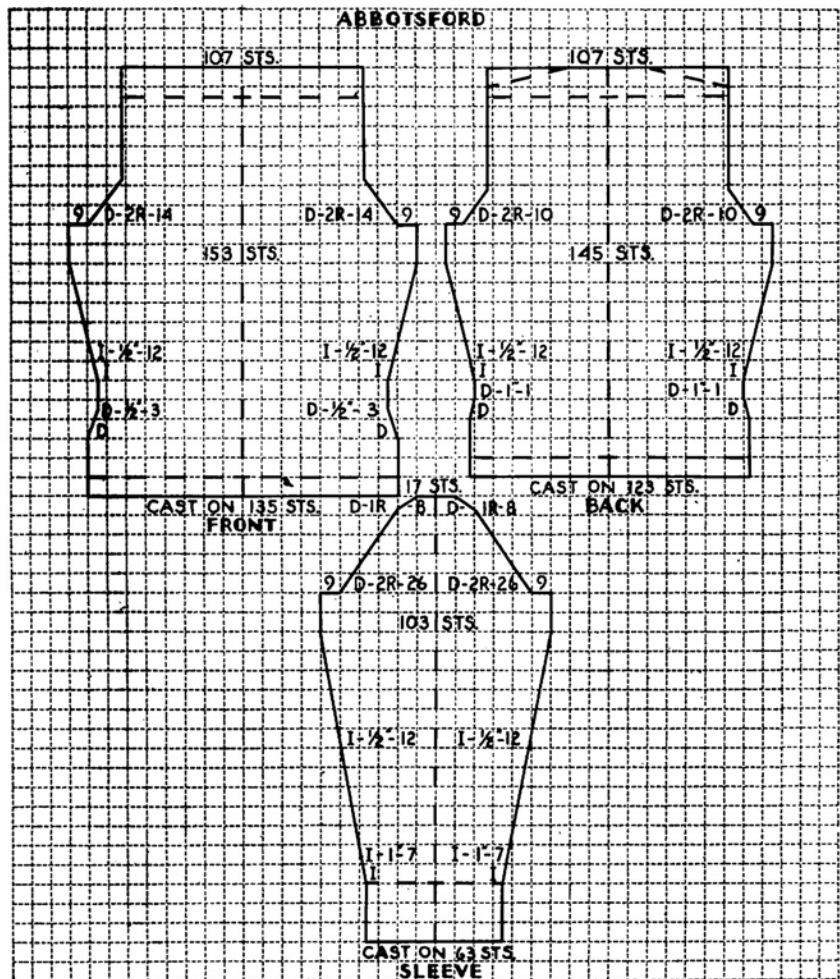
Row 24—Same as Row 16.

Repeat Rows 15 and 16, two times.

Repeat these 28 rows for pattern.

BLOUSE: Follow charts for Front, Back and Sleeves.

Finishing, see page 45. Sew shoulders with front overlapping back at dotted lines.

The blouse is worked in the ribbing pattern with yokes (indicated on charts by dotted lines) and sleeves, worked in Stockinette St. The 1 inch band around neck and the 1½ inch bands at bottom of sleeves are worked in K. 2, P. 2, ribbing. The skirt is worked in Stockinette St.

RIBBING PATTERN: Multiple of 6 sts. plus 4.

Row 1—* K. 4, P. 2, repeat from * across row, ending K. 4.

Row 2—* P. 4, K. 2, repeat from * across row, ending P. 4.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

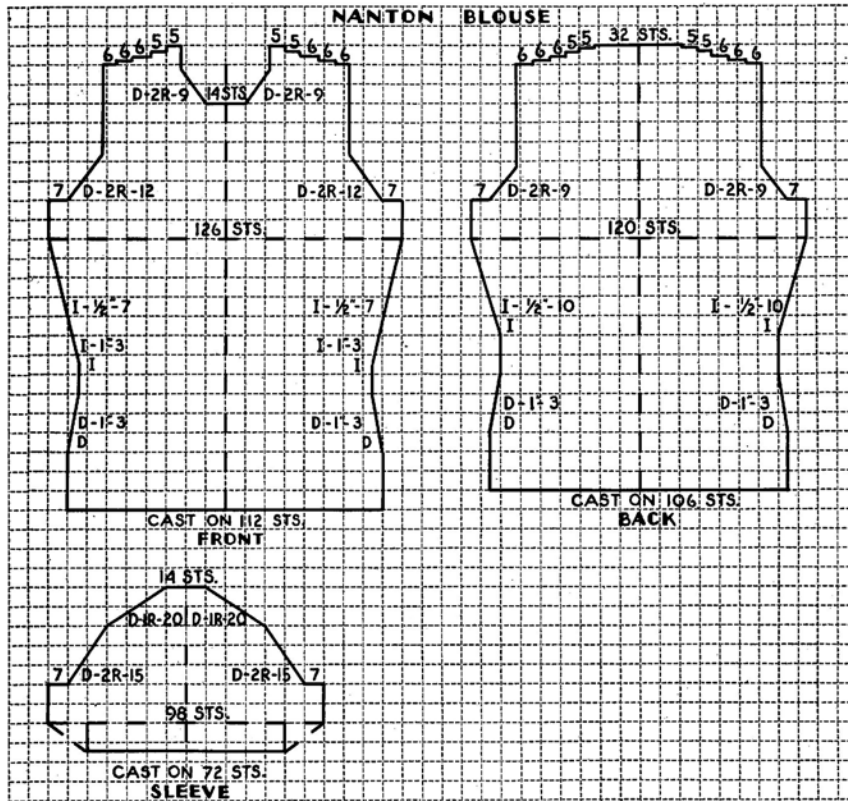
BLOUSE: Follow charts for Front, Back and Sleeves. After ribbing band on sleeves, increase 1 st. in the 11th st., then increase 1 st. in every other st. across row, 25 times more.

Pick up 108 sts. around neck and work in ribbing for 1 inch. Bind off loosely.

Finishing, see page 45.

SKIRT: Follow Standard Skirt Chart No. 2, on page 46. Finishing, see page 45.





Follow chart for Right Front. Buttonholes are 6 sts. wide and 6 sts. (ribbing) from front edge. Work buttonholes in the center of each Fawn stripe and in the center of each Lido Blue stripe. To work buttonholes, see page 45.

Work Left Front to correspond, omitting buttonholes.

Follow charts for Back, Sleeves and Collar. To decrease on collar, work the 8th and 9th sts. together at each side, always working first and last 6 sts. in ribbing.

Finishing, see page 45. Face fronts with 1 1/2 inch matching grosgrain ribbon.

STRIPES

- * Work 30 rows with Fawn
 - Work 6 rows with Rose Red
 - Work 4 rows with Natural
 - Work 6 rows with Lido Blue
 - Work 4 rows with Natural
 - Work 6 rows with Jade Green
- Repeat from * for entire cardigan.

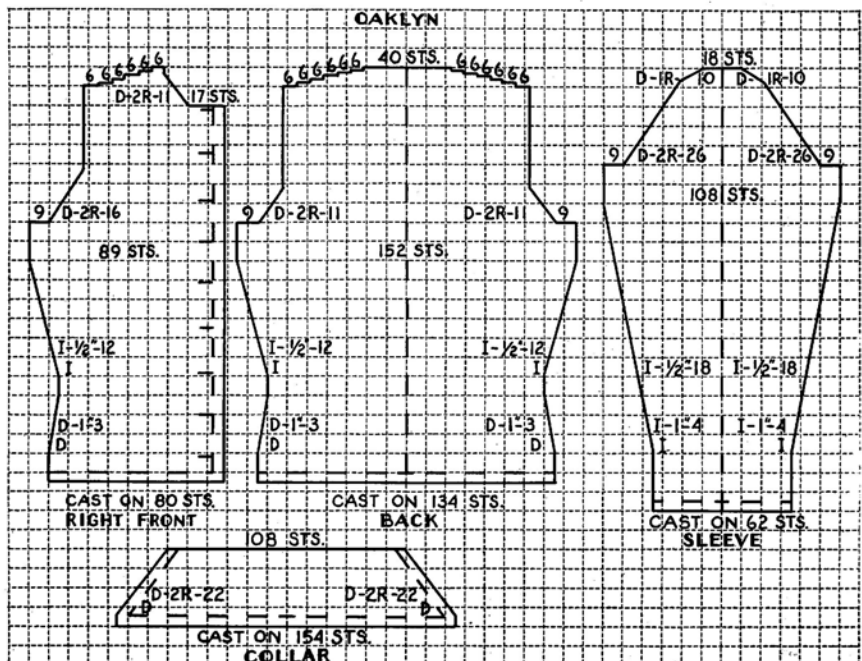

The yoke, collar, 2 inch bands at the bottom of blouse and 1½ inch bands at bottom of sleeves (indicated on charts by dotted lines) are worked in pattern. The remainder of blouse is worked in Stockinette St. The skirt is worked in pattern.

BLOUSE PATTERN: Multiple of 3 sts. plus 1.

Row 1—* K. 1, P. 2, repeat from * across row, ending K. 1. (Right side of work.)

Row 2—* P. 1, K. 2, repeat from * across row, ending P. 1.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

BLOUSE: Follow chart for Front. For front opening, work over 66 sts. of left front and place these sts. on a st. holder. On remaining 79 sts., work right front. Buttonholes are 6 sts. wide and 4 sts. from edge. To work buttonholes, see page 45. Slip sts. from st. holder, cast on 13 sts. at center for placket and work left front, omitting buttonholes and binding off 15 sts. at neck edge.

Follow charts for Back, Collar and Sleeves. After ribbing on sleeves, increase 1 st. in 8th st., then increase 1 st. in every other st. across row, 32 times more.

BELT: Cast on 24 sts. and work in Stockinette St. for 40 inches. Bind off. Fold belt and sew.

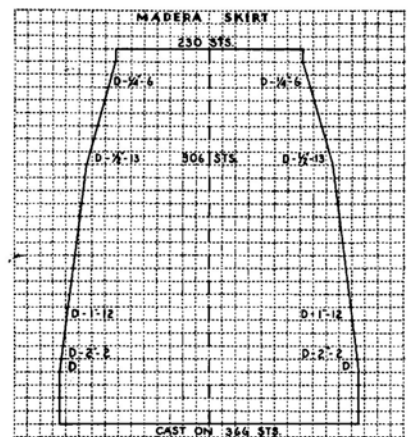
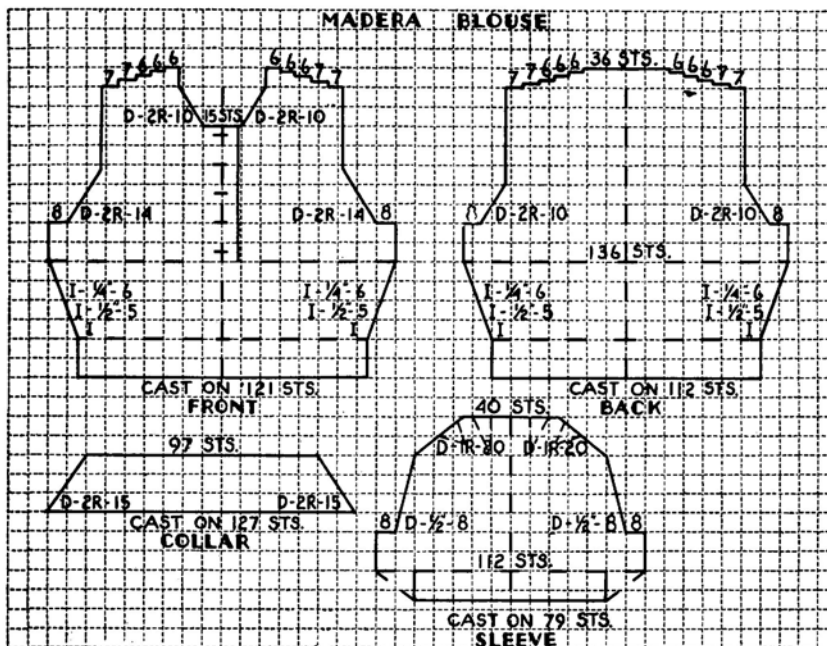
Finishing, see page 45. Fold pleats at top of sleeves as indicated on chart. Face front opening with 1½ inch matching grosgrain ribbon. Work 2 rows S. C. around collar.



SKIRT PATTERN: Multiple of 3 sts.

* K. 1, P. 2, repeat from * around row.

SKIRT: Follow chart, working in pattern. When work measures 4 inches from start, K. 1 (seam st.), P. 2 tog., work next 178 sts. in pattern, P. 2 tog., K. 1 (seam st.), P. 2 tog., work next 178 sts. in pattern, P. 2 tog. Decrease in this manner on each side of each of the seam sts. as indicated on chart (4 sts. decreased each decreasing round). Finishing, see page 45. Join blouse and skirt, working casing for elastic (see page 46).

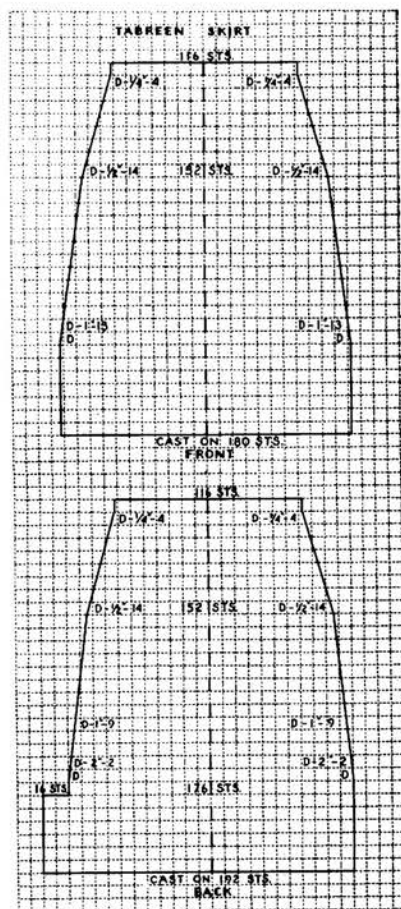

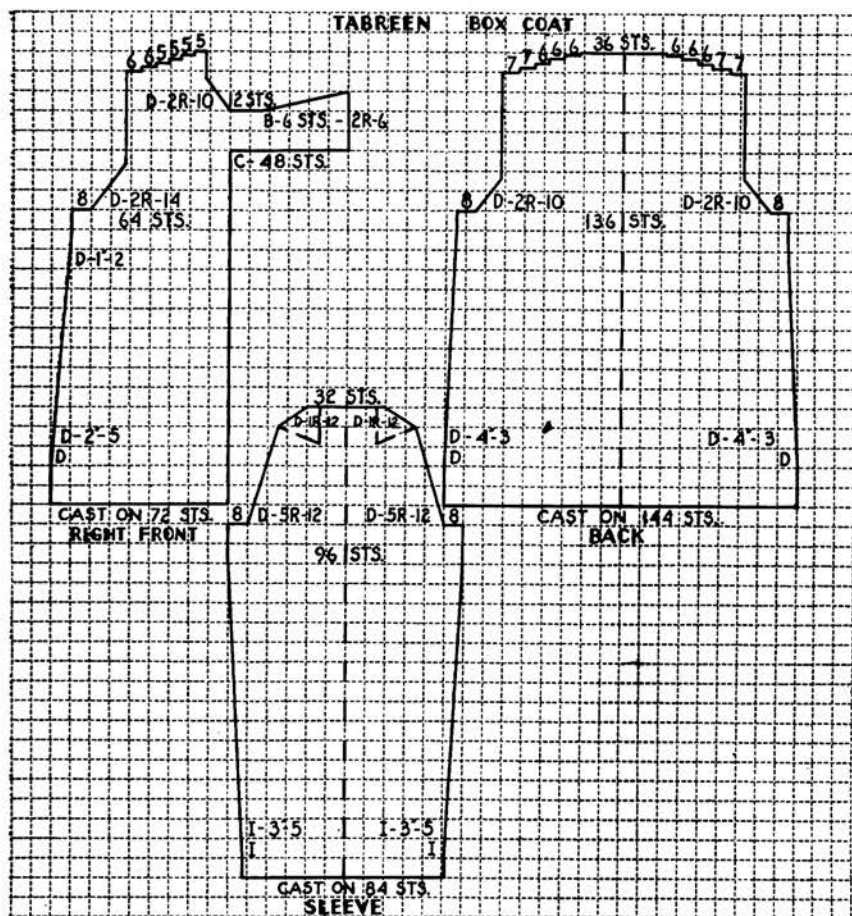

- Row 9—K. 1, * P. 5, K. 7, repeat from * across row, ending K. 6.
- Row 10—P. 7, * K. 3, P. 9, repeat from * across row, ending K. 3, P. 2.

- Row 12—P.
- Row 13—K.
- Repeat Rows 12 and 13.

JACKET: Follow chart for Right Front. Buttonholes are 8 sts. wide and 2 sts. from edge. To work buttonholes, see page 45.



Work Left Front to correspond, omitting buttonholes.

Follow charts for Back, Sleeves and Collar.

Finishing, see page 45. Work 2 rows S. C. around all edges, rounding edges of collar. Sew 96 cast on sts. of collar to neck edge. Face fronts with 1½ inch matching grosgrain ribbon.

Work a Stockinette St. strip (16 sts. wide and 12 inches long) for eight 7/8 inch buttons. Have buttons mounted or cover buttonmolds.

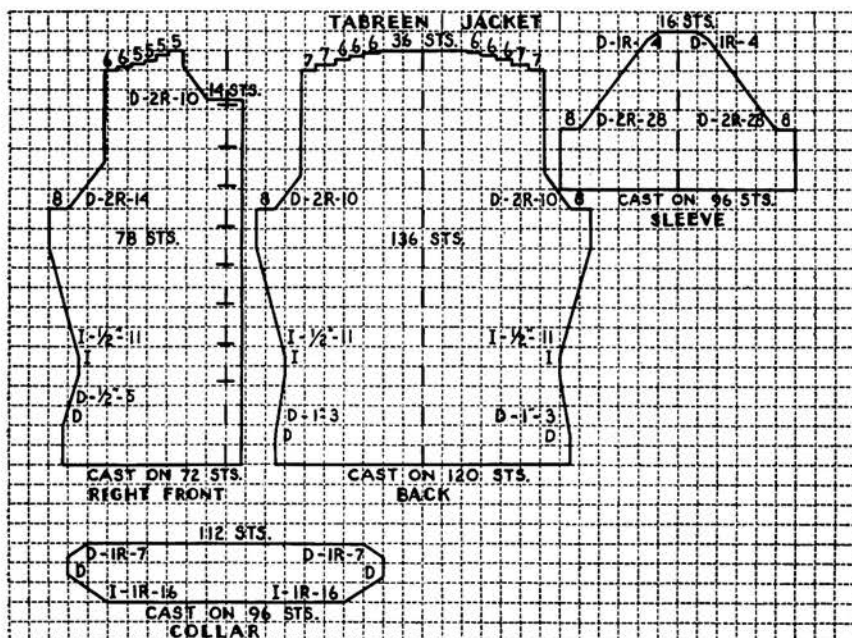
SKIRT: Follow charts for Front and Back. Finishing, see page 45. Face 6 inch opening of skirt with 1½ inch matching grosgrain ribbon.

BOX COAT: Follow chart for Right Front.

Work Left Front to correspond.

Follow charts for Back and Sleeves.

Finishing, see page 45. Work 2 rows S. C. around all edges. Sew darts in place at top of sleeves as indicated on chart by dotted lines. Work a loop on left tie ½ inch wide as illustrated. Face fronts with 1½ inch matching grosgrain ribbon.

The twin sweater set is worked in Stockinette St. with yokes and bands at bottom of slip-over and cardigan (indicated on charts by dotted lines), worked in ribbing pattern. The borders on front edges of cardigan are worked in K. 1, P. 1, ribbing.

RIBBING PATTERN: Multiple of 2 sts. plus 1.

Row 1—* K. 1, P. 1, repeat from * across row, ending K. 1.

Row 2—* P. 1, K. 1, repeat from * across row, ending P. 1.

SLIP-OVER: Follow chart for Front. 4½ inches from start, work as follows:

Row 1—K. 3, * P. 1, K. 1, repeat from * across row, ending K. 3.

Row 2—P. 5, * K. 1, P. 1, repeat from * across row, ending P. 5.

Row 3—K. 7, * P. 1, K. 1, repeat from * across row, ending K. 7.

Row 4—P. 9, * K. 1, P. 1, repeat from * across row, ending P. 9.

Continue to work 2 sts. more in Stockinette St. each side every row, until all sts. are worked in Stockinette St. To start yoke, K. across to 3 center sts., P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, on these sts. and K. across row. Work 2 sts. more in ribbing each side every 4th row.

Follow chart for Back. For 4 inch neck opening, at point indicated on chart, bind off center st. and put sts. of right shoulder on a st. holder. Finish left shoulder, working yoke by starting with 2 ribbed sts. and

working 2 sts. more in ribbing every other row. Work right shoulder in same manner.

Follow chart for Sleeves. After ribbing band, increase 1 st. in first st. then increase 1 st. in every 4th st. across row, 15 times more.

Finishing, see page 45. Work 2 rows S. C. on neck opening, working 4 loops for buttonholes. Sew pads in shoulders if desired.

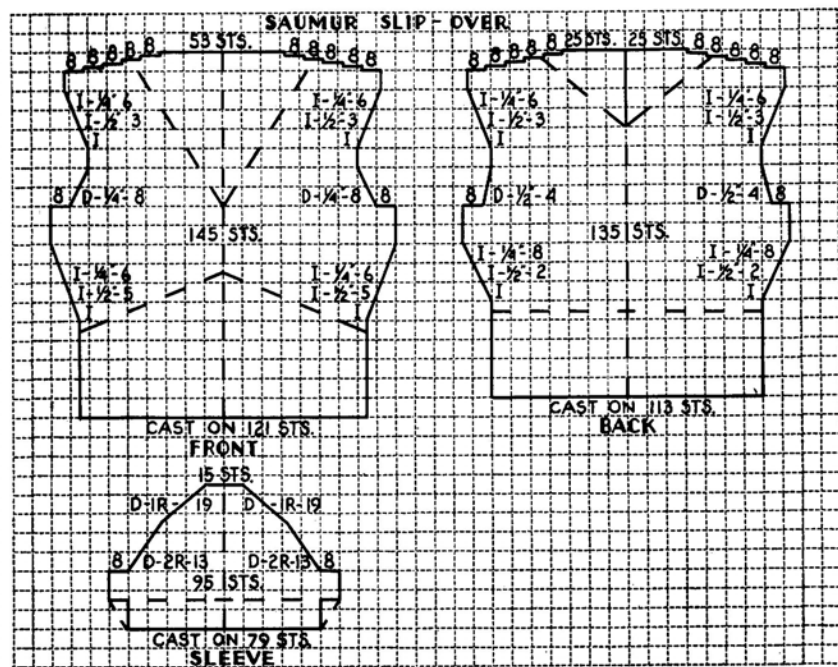
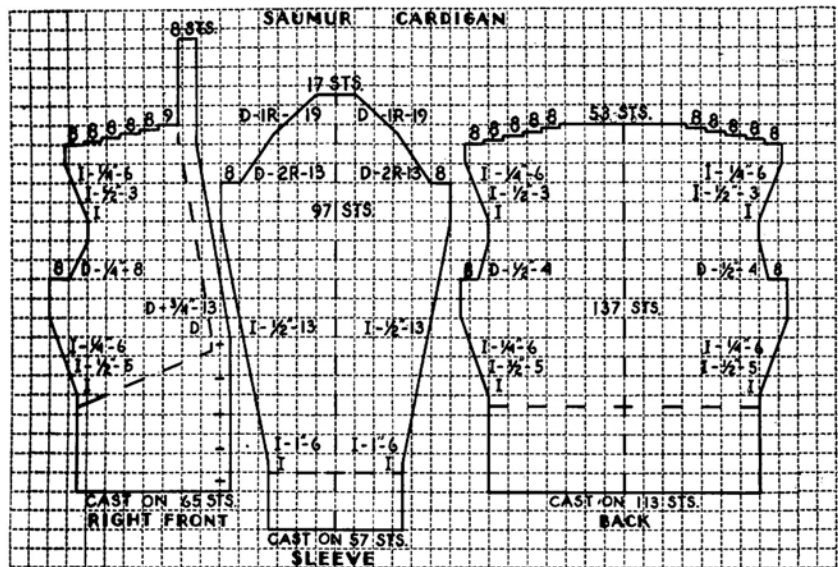
CARDIGAN: Follow chart for Right Front. Buttonholes are 5 sts. wide and 2 sts. from edge. To work buttonholes, see page 45. 4½ inches from start, with right side of work

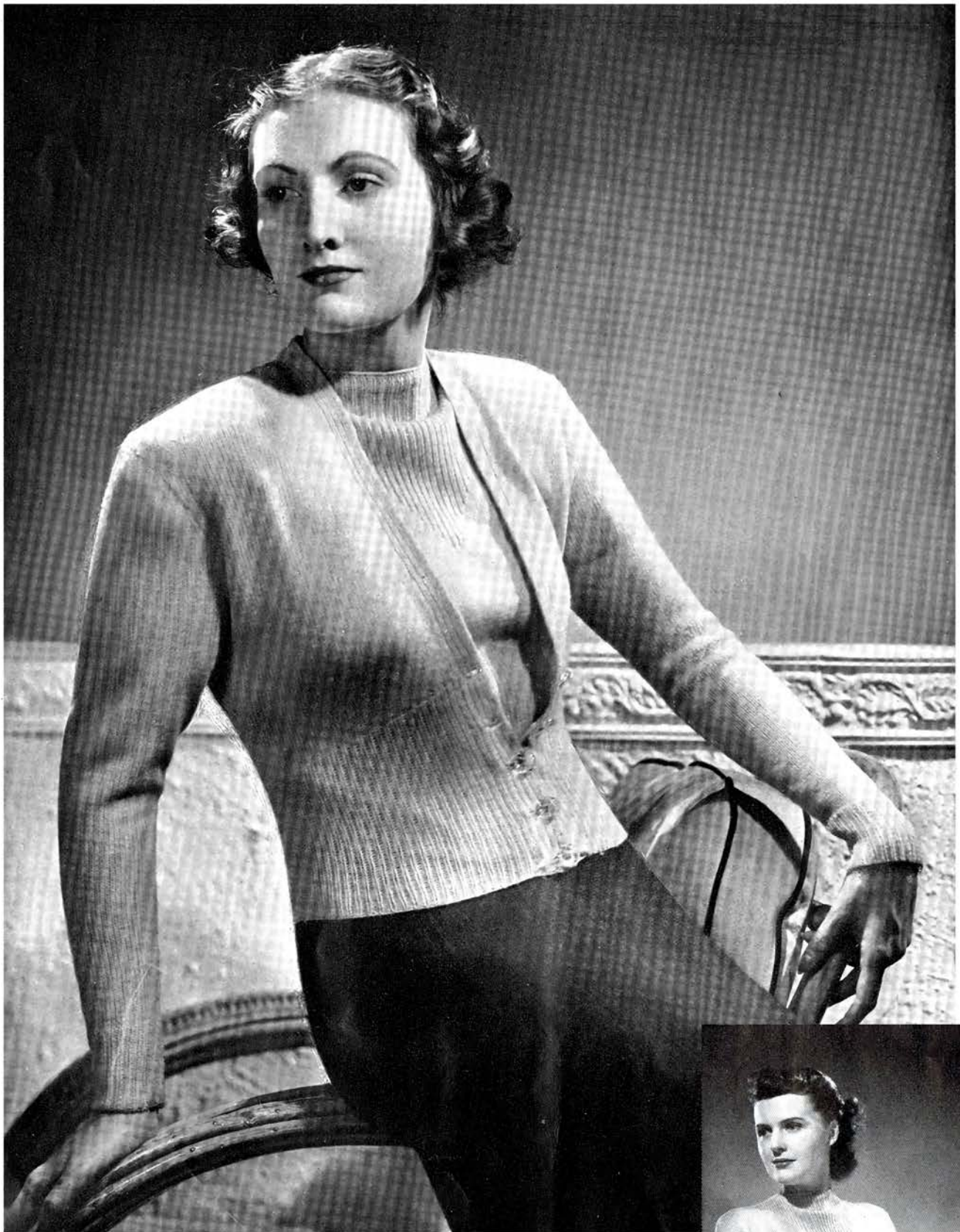
toward you, K. last 3 sts. at side edge. Work 2 sts. more in Stockinette St. every row, until all sts. except 8 border sts. are worked in Stockinette St. All decreases at front edge are worked inside the border sts.

Work Left Front to correspond, omitting buttonholes, and binding off the 8 border sts. at shoulder.

Follow charts for Back and Sleeves.

Finishing, see page 45. Sew shoulder seams and border to back of neck, joining on left shoulder. Face fronts with 1 inch matching grosgrain ribbon.

Total 3 Skeins

The blouse is worked in Stockinette St., with Cross St. bands (indicated on chart by dotted lines) worked with Needlepoint Yarn after the garment is completed. The sts. of front, back and sleeves are joined and worked together to make the ribbing yoke. The skirt is worked in Stockinette St. with panels of ribbing (66 sts.) in the front and back.

BLOUSE: Follow charts for Front, Back and Sleeves, but do not bind off remaining sts. of each section.

Divide sts. of front in half, slip the 294 sts. on the circular needle and work back and forth as follows:

Row 1—* K. 2, P. 2, repeat from * across row, ending K. 2.

Row 2—* P. 2, K. 2, repeat from * across row, ending P. 2.

Work in this manner for 1 inch, then decrease 1 st. in every other P. rib as follows: (all decreases are worked with the right side of work toward you) * K. 2, P. 2 tog., K. 2, P. 2, repeat from * across row, ending K. 2 (37 sts. decreased). Then work in K. 2, P. 1, K. 2, P. 2, ribbing, for 1 inch.

Now decrease 1 st. in every P. 2 rib (36 sts. decreased) and work for 1 inch in K. 2, P. 1, ribbing.

Decrease 1 st. in every other K. 2 rib as follows: * K. 2, P. 1, K. 2 tog., P. 1, repeat from * across row, ending K. 2, P. 1, K. 2 (36 sts. decreased).

Now work in K. 2, P. 1, K. 1, P. 1, ribbing, for 1 inch.

Decrease in every K. 2 rib except first and last (36 sts. decreased, 149 sts. on needle).

Work 1 inch even in K. 1, P. 1, ribbing. Bind off.

Cast on 160 sts. for Tie Band and work in Stockinette St. for 16 rows. Bind off. Work 1 row S. C. around all edges.

Using 2 ply Needlepoint Yarn, work Cross St. borders on front, back, sleeves and tie band by following st. chart.

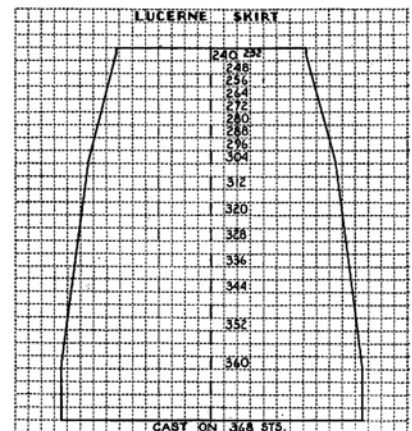
SKIRT: Cast on 368 sts. and work as follows: ** K. 14, * slip a marker on needle (see page 45), K. 30, repeat from * 2 times more, slip a marker on needle, K. 14, (P. 2, K. 2) across next 66 sts., ending P. 2, repeat from ** once more.

First decrease—** K. 12, K. 2 tog., * K. 28, K. 2 tog., repeat from * 2 times more, K. 14, rib 66, repeat from ** once more.

Second decrease—** K. 13, * K. 2 tog., K. 27, repeat from * 2 times more, K. 2 tog., K. 12, rib 66, repeat from ** once more.

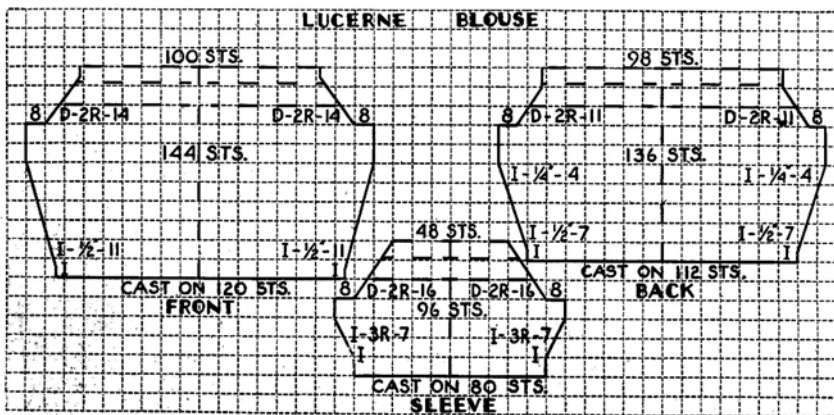
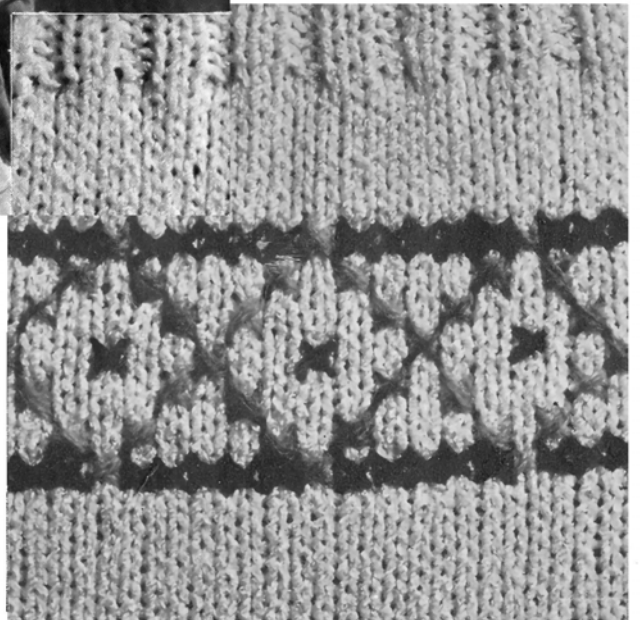
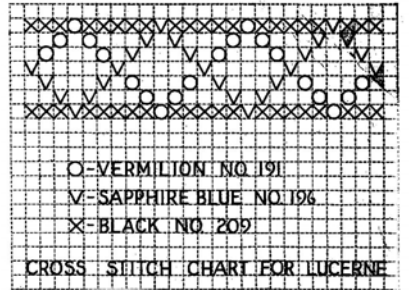
Continue to decrease in this manner on alternate sides of these markers at points indicated on chart by number of sts. remaining after each decreasing round (8 sts. decreased in each decreasing round).

Finishing, see page 45. Join blouse and skirt, working casing for elastic (see page 46). Sew tie band to back of neck, turn down front points of yoke and sew as illustrated. Draw tie through. Work five 1/2 inch loops for buttons on right front.

The entire set is worked in pattern with borders of K. 2, P. 2, ribbing, on sacque, cap and mittens (indicated on charts by dotted lines).

PATTERN: Multiple of 6 sts. plus 4.

Row 1—* K. 4, P. 2, repeat from * across row, ending K. 4.

Row 2—K.

Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.

SACQUE: Follow chart for Back. When work measures 8¾ inches from start, work 6 rows in Garter St. (plain knitting). Then finish right front. Work left front to correspond.

Follow chart for Sleeves, working first 1½ inches in ribbing. If desired the sleeves may be picked up around armholes and made by reversing sleeve chart.

Pick up 80 sts. around neck and work in Garter St. for 6 rows, work-

ing eyelets on 3rd row as follows: K. 2, * Y. O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, repeat from * across row. Draw ribbon through eyelets as illustrated.

CAP: Follow chart, working first inch in ribbing. Sew cap together and pick up 102 sts. around neck. Work eyelet row as follows: K. 1, * Y. O., K. 2 tog., K. 1, repeat from * across row, ending Y. O., K. 2 tog. Work in ribbing for one inch. Bind off. Draw ribbon through eyelets as illustrated.

MITTENS: Follow chart, working first 1½ inches in ribbing. Work thumb, 2 inches from start, as follows: (Work all thumb sts. in Garter St.) Work across 19 sts., increase in next 2 sts., work to end of row. Knit back. Next row, increase in 20th st., K. 2, increase in next st., work to end of row. Continue to increase in the 20th st. from each edge every other row until there are 14 sts. in the thumb. Work even on these sts. for 1 inch, placing first and last 20 sts. on a st. holder. Decrease 1 st. at the beginning and end of every row, 3 times. Bind off remaining 8 sts. of thumb. Slip sts. from st. holder and finish mitten by following chart

BOOTIE: (No chart shown.) Starting at bottom, cast on 64 sts. and work in pattern, increasing 1 st. each side every other row, 2 times (68 sts. on needle). When work measures 1¼ inches from start, work decreases at center as follows:

Row 1—K. 30, slip 1, K. 1, P.S.S.O., K. 4, K. 2 tog., K. 30.

Row 2—P. 29, P. 2 tog., K. 4, P. 2 tog., P. 29.

Row 3—K. 28, slip 1, K. 1, P.S.S.O., K. 4, K. 2 tog., K. 28.

Row 4—P. 27, P. 2 tog., K. 4, P. 2 tog., P. 27.

Continue to decrease in this manner, working 4 center sts. in Garter St. and sts. each side in Stockinette St., until 40 sts. remain on needle. Purl 1 row on right side of work, then work eyelets as follows: * K. 2 tog.,

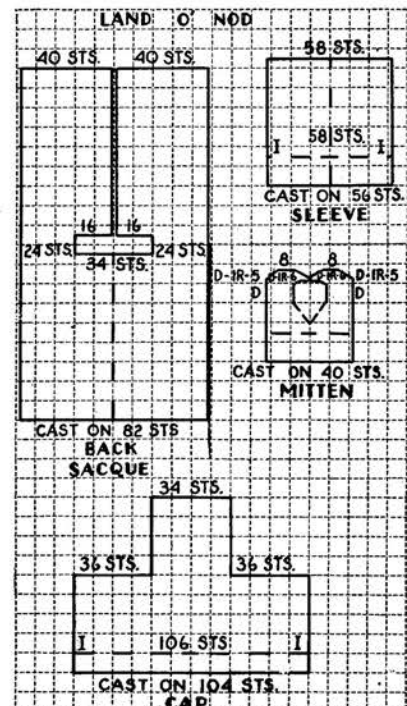
Y. O., repeat from * across row, ending K. 2. Work in pattern for 1½ inches. Bind off. Sew seams.

With a double strand of yarn make a Ch. 12 inches long, draw through beading and make a pompon (see page 45) for each end.

With the No. 5 Steel Crochet Hook, work a picot edge around all edges of sacque, cap, mittens and booties as follows: 1 S. C. in each of the first 3 sts., * Ch. 3, 1 S. C. in last S. C., 1 S. C. in each of the next 3 sts., repeat from *.

CARRIAGE ROBE: (No chart shown.) Cast on 142 sts. and work even in pattern for 30 inches.

With the No. 5 M. M. Crochet Hook, work a picot edge around edges of carriage robe as follows: 1 S. C. in first st., * Ch. 3, 1 S. C. in last S. C., 1 S. C. in next st., repeat from *.

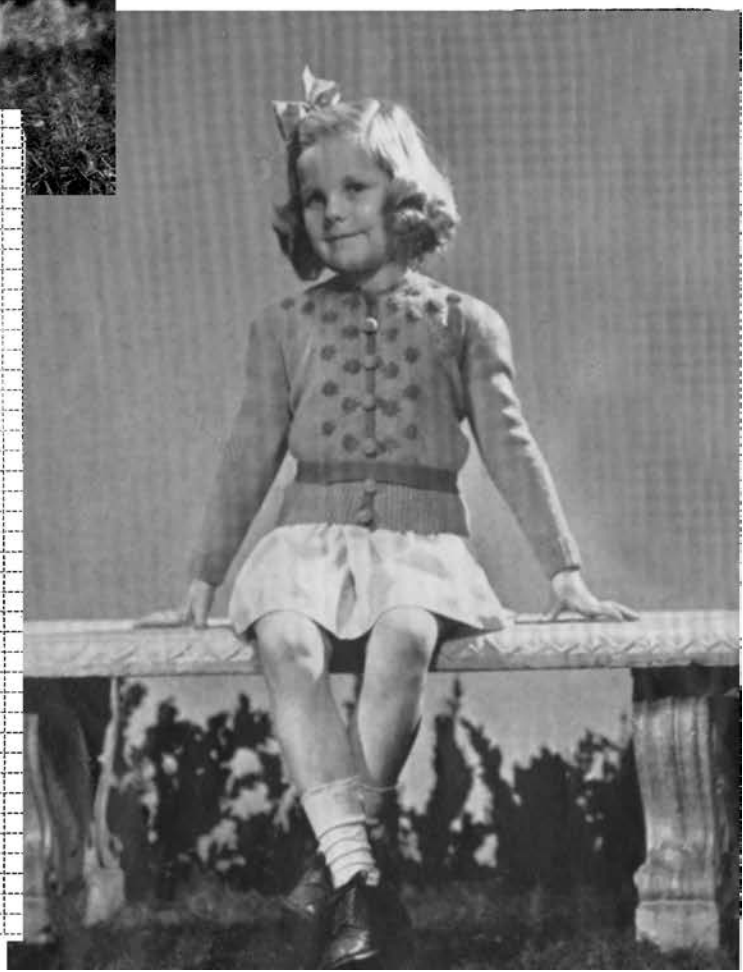
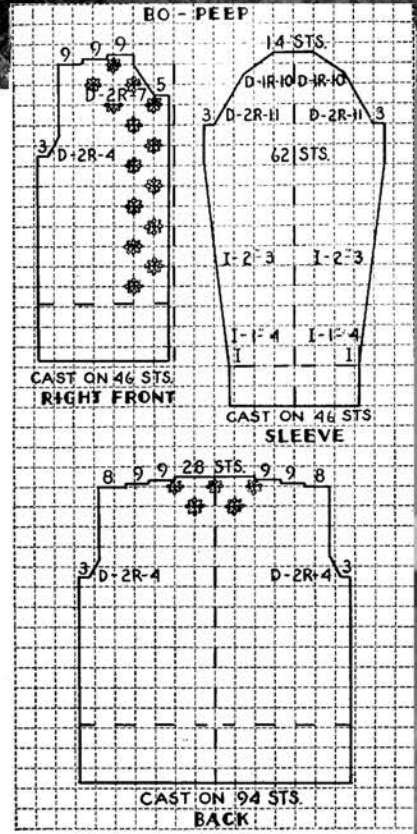

The entire cardigan is worked with Sun Orange in Stockinette St. with borders of K. 1, P. 1, ribbing, indicated on charts by dotted lines. The crocheting on the fronts, the belt and the flowers are worked with Spanish Tile. The 7 crocheted buttons are worked with Sun Orange.

Follow chart for Right Front.

Work Left Front to correspond.

Follow charts for Back and Sleeves.

Finishing, see page 45. * Starting at bottom of right front, work 1 row S. C. around front opening and neck, repeat from * 3 times more, always working in back loop of sts. and on 3rd row working 7 buttonholes, ½ inch wide and 1½ inches apart on right front, working first buttonhole ½ inch from bottom.

Embroider flowers as illustrated (see swatch on page 36), working the Spanish Tile petals in the Lazy Daisy St. and the French Knot centers with Sun Orange.

Crochet over seven ½ inch buttonmolds.

For 27 inch crocheted belt, see page 45, work in back loop of sts.



Goldilocks

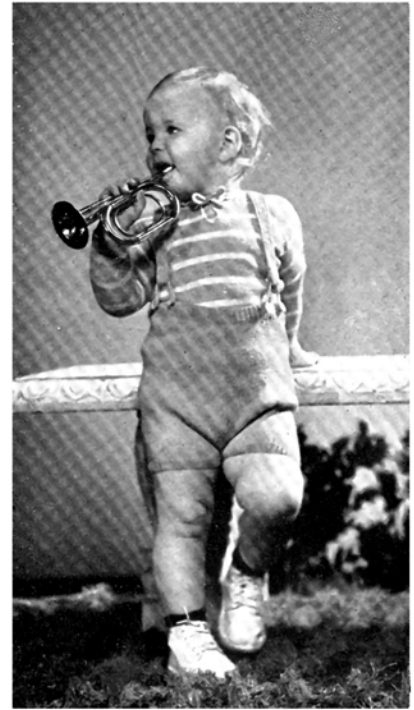

The entire suit is worked in Stockinette St. with borders of K. 1, P. 1, ribbing, on the sweater and pants (indicated on charts by dotted lines).

SWEATER: Follow chart, dividing sts. for 2 inch neck opening at point indicated on chart and alternating striping as follows:

12 rows with Blue, 4 rows with White, to shoulder, then work striping on back of sweater to correspond to front.

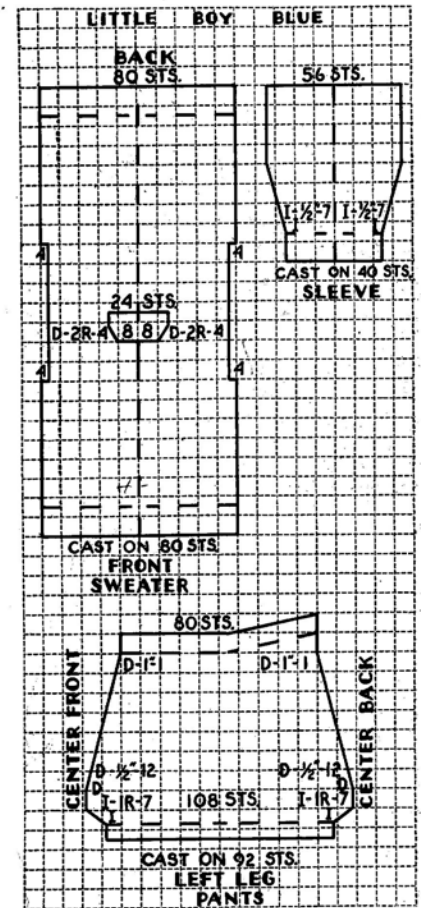
Follow chart for Sleeves, working ribbing and striping in same manner.

Finishing, see page 45. With Blue, work 1 row S. C. around neck opening. Using 4 strands of Blue, work a Ch. 24 inches long and sew to neck edge, leaving ends to tie.

PANTS: Using Blue, follow chart for Left Leg. To shape back of pants, work across 35 sts., work back, work across 28 sts., work back. Continue to work 7 sts. less every other row according to chart, then work across all sts. Finish with 1 inch of ribbing.

Work Right Leg to correspond.

Finishing, see page 45. Sew buttons for suspenders to front of pants as illustrated. Work 2 strips for suspenders as follows: Using a double strand of Blue, cast on 10 sts. and work in ribbing for 16 inches. Attach to back of pants, 4 inches apart, cross in back, turn back a 3/4 inch loop at each end and sew. Work slide ends of suspenders as follows: With 4 strands of Blue, make a Ch., 5 inches long, turn back a 3/4 inch loop at each end. Slide through ends of suspenders and button to pants.

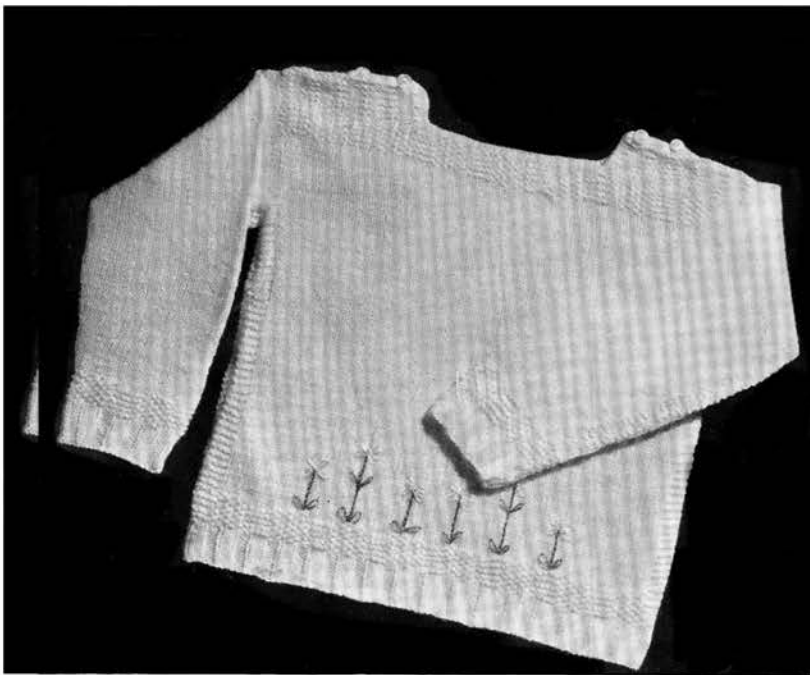

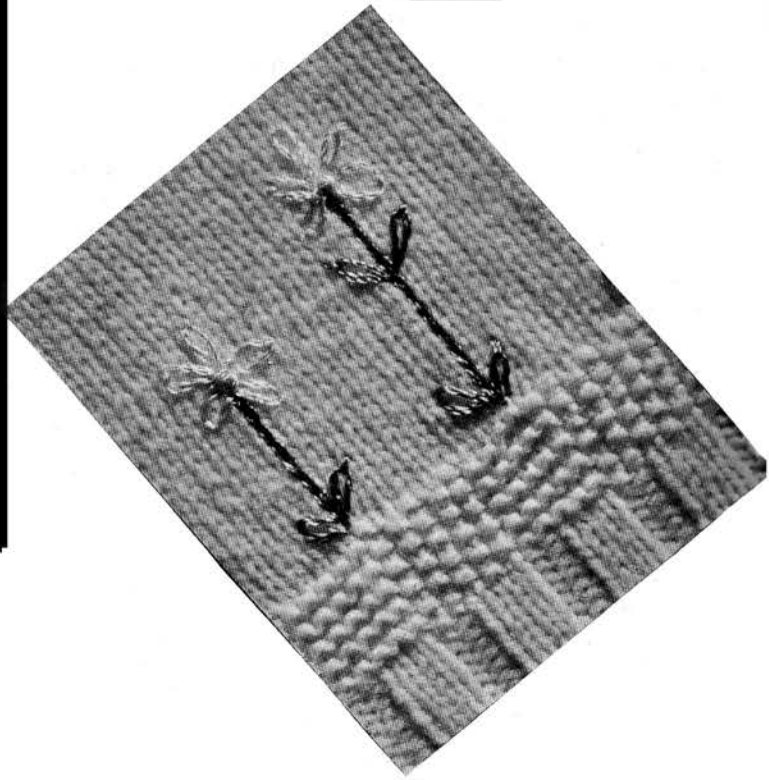

3 balls will be sufficient for entire set.
Separate pieces require the following quantities:

Sacque—Pink 1 No. 232..... 2 Balls
Cap —Pink 1 No. 232..... 1 Ball
Booties—Pink 1 No. 232..... 1 Ball

PATTERN: Multiple of 4 sts.

Row 1—* K. 2, P. 2, repeat from * across row.

Row 2—Same as Row 1.

Row 3—* P. 2, K. 2, repeat from * across row.

Row 4—Same as Row 3.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern.

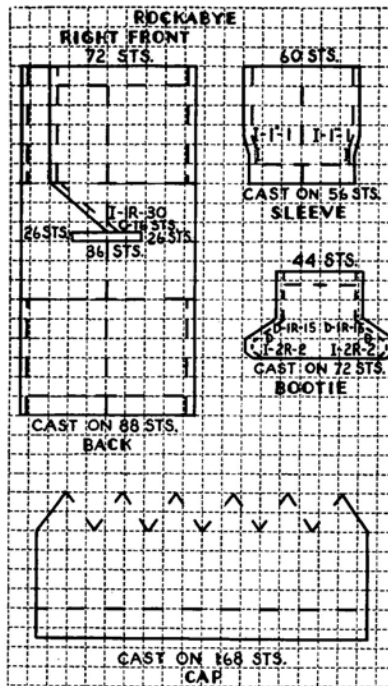
Always work 4 sts. from edges of sacque and booties in Garter St. and increase and decrease inside these border sts.

SACQUE: The sacque is worked in Stockinette St. with the yoke and 1 inch bands at the bottom of the sacque and sleeves worked in pattern.

Follow chart for Back and Right Front, working 4 border sts. (indicated on chart by dotted lines) in Garter St. For Left Front, cast on 20 sts. at neck edge and work even, working border sts. each side.

Follow chart for Sleeves, working 4 sts. from side edges in Garter St. If desired, the sts. may be picked up around armholes and made by reversing the sleeve chart.

Finishing, see page 45. Pick up 70 sts. around neck and work in Garter St. for 6 rows (3 ribs). Bind off.



CAP: The cap is worked in Stockinette St. with the 1½ inch turn-up worked in pattern.

Follow chart, working first 6 rows in Garter St. (3 ribs). Work decreases in crown as follows:

Row 1—* K. 2 tog., K. 24, K. 2 tog., repeat from * across row.

Row 2—P.

Continue decreasing in this manner every K. row, 12 times more. Bind off remaining 12 sts. and draw together. Finish with pompon (see page 45).

BOOTIE: The booties are worked in Stockinette St. with ¾ inch at top worked in pattern (indicated on chart by dotted line).

Follow chart, always working the 4 sts. each side in Garter St. 2 inches from start, work eyelets as follows: K. 2, * Y. O., K. 2 tog., K. 2, repeat from * across row. Work 1 inch, work another row of eyelets and continue according to chart. Trim with ribbon as illustrated.

Scale: 8 sts. to 1 inch

MINERVA CUDDLE YARN
Blue No. 287..... 3 Balls

The entire sweater is worked in pattern with 1½ inch bands of K. 2, P. 2, ribbing, at the bottom of the sweater and sleeves.

PATTERN: Multiple of 6 sts.

Rows 1 and 2—* K. 3, P. 3, repeat from * across row.

Rows 3 and 4—* P. 3, K. 3, repeat from * across row.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern.

Follow chart for Front and Back.

Follow chart for Sleeves. If desired the sleeves may be worked by picking up sts. around armholes and reversing sleeve chart.

Finishing, see page 45. Work 1 row S. C. at back opening and around neck, working 8 loops for ¼ inch buttons, 1 inch apart on left side of back. Trim with ribbon as illustrated.
