


Vintage Knitting Pattern

KEY TO CHARTS


□ = м с

DIRECTIONS ON USE OF CHART C

Start at A and work to B, repeat between A and B.

CHART A



DIRECTIONS ON USE OF CHART A

For Size 6 months: Start at A and work to C, repeat between D and C, ending as between C and E. For Size 1: Start at B and work to C, repeat between D and C, ending as between C and F.



These directions are for Size 6 months. Changes for Size 1 are in parentheses.

MATERIALS

BERNAT BERELLA BABY BULKY


- (1 oz. pull skeins)
- 10 for blanket
- 5 for sacque
- 3 for bonnet and booties
- 1 pair each BERNAT-Aero straight knitting needles Nos. 3 and 5

(Canadian Needles Nos. 11 and 9) OR ANY SIZE NEEDLES THAT WILL GIVE

THE STITCH GAUGE GIVEN BELOW

- 1 BERNAT-Aero crochet hook Size 2:50 mm (C)
- 1 yd. 1 inch satin ribbon for bonnet
- 1 yd. ¼ inch satin ribbøn for booties

GAUGE: 11 sts = 2 inches 7 rows = 1 inch

PATTERN STITCH

Row 1: P 2, * throw yarn to BACK of work and sl 1 as if to P, K 2, psso 2 K sts just worked, P 4, repeat from *, ending last repeat P 2 instead of P 4.

Row 2: K 2, * P 1, y o, P 1, K 4, repeat from *, ending last repeat K 2 instead of K 4.

Row 3: P 2, * K 3, P 4, repeat from *, ending last repeat P 2 instead of P 4

ing last repeat P 2 instead of P 4.

Row 4: K 2, * P 3, K 4, repeat from *, ending last repeat K 2 instead of K 4.

Repeat these 4 rows for pattern stitch.

BLANKET

Size: Approximately 27 x 34 inches

Using larger needles, cast on 154 sts. Work even in pattern st for 23 rows, ending with Row 3. Continuing in pattern st, work 23 sts, put a marker on needle, work next 108 sts, put a marker on needle, work last 23 sts. Keeping the 108 sts between markers in K 3, P 4 ribbing as established, work remaining sts in pattern st until piece measures 30 inches, ending with Row 4. Then work even in pattern st on all 154 sts for 23 rows. Bind off in pattern st.

FINISHING: With right side facing you, join yarn in any st and work 1 round s c around blanket; working 3 s c in corner sts, join.
FRINGE: Work 1 s c in next s c and draw up a loop ½ inch long, * remove hook from long loop, draw up a loop in next s c, y o and pull through this loop, drawing yarn tightly, pull up the same length as last long loop, repeat from * around, join. Fasten off. Steam lightly.

SACQUE

BACK: Using larger needles, cast on 70(77) sts. Row 1: P 2, * K 3, P 4, repeat from *, ending last repeat P 2 instead of P 4. Row 2: K 2, * P 3, K 4, repeat from *, ending last repeat K 2 instead of K 4. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 6½(7) inches, ending with Row 2. SI sts onto a holder.

LEFT FRONT: Using larger needles, cast on 35(42) sts. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 of back until piece measures 6½(7) inches, ending with Row 2. SI sts onto a holder.


RIGHT FRONT: Work to correspond to left front.

SLEEVES: Using smaller needles, cast on 28 sts. K 1, P 1 in ribbing for 8 rows. Row 9:

* P 1, inc 1 st in next st, repeat from * across row - 42 sts. Change to larger needles and repeat Rows 1 and 2 of back until piece measures 6½(7½) inches, ending with Row 2.

SI sts onto a holder.

YOKE: With wrong side facing you, sl onto larger needles 35(42) sts of left front, 42 sts of one sleeve, 70(77) sts of back, 42 sts of other sleeve and 35(42) sts of right front - 224(245) sts. Work even in pattern st for 7 rows, ending with Row 3. FIRST DEC ROW: Continuing in pattern st, dec 1 st in centre of each K 4 rib - 31(34) sts dec. Work even in new pattern st for 1 inch, ending with Row 3. SECOND DEC ROW: Continuing in pattern st, dec 1 st in each K 3 rib - 31(34) sts dec. Work even in new pattern st for 1 inch, ending with Row 3. THIRD DEC ROW: Continuing in pattern st, dec 1 st in each K 2 rib - 33(36) sts dec. Work even in pattern st as established on 129 (141) sts until yoke measures 3½ inches, ending with Row 1. On the next row, dec 32(34) sts at even intervals -97(107) sts. NECKBAND: Change to smaller needles and work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 8 rows. Bind off loosely in ribbing.



FINISHING: Sew underarm and sleeve seams. Starting with right side facing you, work 2 rows s c on front and neck edges, holding neck edge in to desired size and forming 4 buttonloops, evenly spaced on right yoke edge on 2nd row. BUTTONLOOP: 1 s c in next s c, ch 2, skip next 2 s c, 1 s c in next s c. Fasten off. Sew on buttons

BONNET

Using larger needles, starting at front edge, cast on 77(84) sts. Work even in pattern st for 11 rows, ending with Row 3. Continue in ribbing as established until piece measures 5(5½) inches, ending with a right side row. SHAPE BACK: Row 1: Continuing in ribbing, dec 1 st in centre of each K 4 rib - 10(11) sts dec. Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8: Work in new rib pattern. 3: Dec 1 st in each K 3 rib - 10(11) sts dec. Row 5: Dec 1 st in each P 3 rib — 11(12) sts dec. Row 7: Dec 1 st in each P 2 rib — 11(12) sts dec. Row 9: Dec 1 st in each K 2 rib - 12(13) sts dec. Row 10: K 23(25) sts. Row 11: P 1, then P 2 tog across row. Row **12**: K 12(13) sts. **Row 13**: P 0(1), then P 2 tog across row — 6(7) sts. Break off yarn, leaving a 12 inch end. Draw end through all sts and pull up tightly. Fasten off. Sew back seam for 2(2½) inches. NECKBAND: Using smaller needles, with right side facing you, pick up and K 63(67) sts around neck edge. P 1, K 1 in ribbing for 3 rows. BEADING: Work 3 sts in ribbing, * work next 2 sts tog, y o, work next 2 sts in ribbing, repeat from * across row. Work 3 rows more in ribbing. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Run 1 inch ribbon through beading.

BOOTIES

Using larger needles, cast on 35 sts. Work even in pattern st for 25 rows, ending with Row 1 - 30 sts. P 1 row. SHAPE INSTEP: K 10 sts and sl these sts onto a holder, K centre 10 sts, sl last 10 sts onto another holder. Work even in stockinette st on 10 centre sts for instep for 2(2½) inches, ending with a P row. Break off yarn and sl sts onto a holder. SHAPE SOLE: With right side facing you, sl 10 sts from holder onto needle, pick up and K 9 sts along one side of instep, K 10 sts of instep from holder onto same needle, pick up and K 9 sts along other side of instep, K 10 sts from remaining holder onto same needle. Continue in stockinette st on 48 sts until piece measures 1 inch above picked up sts, ending with a K row. On the next row, P 23, put a marker on needle, P 2, put a marker on needle, P 23. SHAPE TOE AND HEEL: Row 1: K 2 tog, K to 2 sts before next marker, K 2 tog, K 2, K 2 tog, K to last 2 sts, K 2 tog — 4 sts dec. Row 2: Purl. Repeat these 2 rows twice more - 36 sts. Fold in half and weave sole sts tog. Seam back. Run $\frac{1}{4}$ inch ribbon through last row of y o's of pattern st at ankle.

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
