There are at least 8 different looks achieved with the Chanel type suit alone.

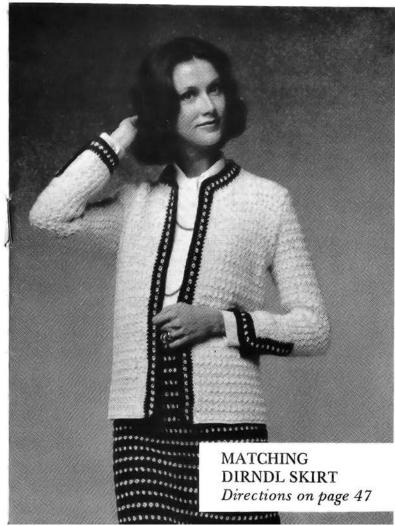

Sizes: 8-10, 12-14, 16

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz. skeins

skeins

8 skeins Fisherman (All

Sizes)

1 skein Raspberry (All

Sizes)

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 2 patterns = 1 inch 5 rows = 2 inches

Directions are given for size 8-10. Changes for sizes 12-14 and size 16 are given in parentheses.

BACK: With Fisherman ch 74 (76, 80), work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 2, turn.

ROW 2: Insert hook in 1st sc, pull up a loop, skip next sc, insert hook in next sc, pull loop up (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through 3 loops, * ch 1, insert hook in same space as before, pull up loop, skip 1 sc, insert hook in next sc, pull up loop, yarn over and pull through 3 loops, repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn.

ROW 3: (Right side) Insert hook in base of turning ch, pull up loop, insert hook in 1st st of previous row, pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through 3 loops, * ch 1, insert hook in same space as before, pull up loop, skip 1 st, insert hook in next st, pull up loop, yarn over and pull through 3 loops, (pattern) repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn. Repeat last row for pattern across 36 (37, 39) patterns until section measures 15½ inches or is desired length to underarm, ch 1, turn.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: SI st across 1st 2 patterns, work to within last 2 patterns; ch 1, turn. Then dec 1 pattern each side of next 2 rows. Work even on rem 28 (29, 31) patterns until armholes measure 7½ (7¾, 8) inches.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Sl st across 1st 4 patterns, work to within last 4 patterns.

NEXT ROW: Sl st across 1st 5 patterns, work to within last 5 patterns, cut yarn; 10 (11, 13) patterns remain for back of neck.

LEFT FRONT: Ch 40 (42, 44), work 39 (41, 43) sc across ch, ch 2, turn. Work even on 19 (20, 21) patterns until same as back to underarm.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: Working dec same as back, dec 2 patterns at side edge twice, then 1 pattern twice. Work even on rem 13 (14, 15) patterns until 5½ (5¾, 6) inches above armhole, end at front edge.

SHAPE NECK: Dec 2 (3, 4) patterns, then in following 2 rows dec 1 pattern each row. Work on remaining 9 patterns to match back to shoulder.

SHAPE SHOULDER: Starting at armhole edge, sl st across 4 patterns, complete row. Work back over 5 patterns, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT: Work to correspond to left front reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES: Ch 20 (all sizes). Work 19 sc across ch, then work 9 patterns across for 9 rows, cut yarn.

Work a 2nd section to correspond, do not cut yarn. Work 10th row, join to right side of 1st section. Inc 1 pattern each side in next row (to inc: insert hook in base of turning ch, pull up loop, insert hook in 1st st, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 3 loops, * ch 1, insert hook into same space as before, pull up loop, insert hook under next st, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 3 loops, repeat from * once, 1 pattern inc), work in pattern across next 15 patterns, * ch 1, insert hook in same space as before, pull up a loop, insert hook in next st, pull up a loop, insert hook in next st, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 3 loops, repeat from last * once, (2nd inc). There are 20 patterns in

row. Increase 1 pattern each side every 2 inches 2 (3,4) times more. Work even on 24 (26, 28) patterns until sleeve is 1 inch less than desired length.

SHAPE CAP: Sl st across 1st 2 patterns, work across row to within last 2 patterns; then dec 1 pattern at beg and end of every row until 6

(8, 10) patterns remain, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams together. Press seams on wrong side

under damp cloth.

EDGE: With Fisherman and right side facing, starting at lower edge of right front, work a row of sc across all edges. At neck edge turn shaped edges to wrong side to provide smooth line. At back of neck, work 2 sc in each pattern. At the end of left front, ch 4, drop Fisherman. Go back to beg of row and join Raspberry, work 1 dc into each sc working 3 dc in each corner st at neck edge, at end of row, ch 1, drop Raspberry.

ROW 3: Pick up Fisherman, turn, * skip 1 dc, work 1 sc in next dc, ch 1, repeat from *

across row, cut yarn.

ROW 4: Go back to beg of row 3, pick up Raspberry, * work 1 sc under Fisherman ch 1 space, ch 1, repeat from * across, end row with 2 sc, ch 2, turn.

ROW 5: Work 1 hdc in each st working into both loops of each sc and under each ch 1 space, cut yarn.

Sew sleeves in position. Work edge all around lower edge of sleeves as follows: for right sleeve start at top of slit and work around edge working 3 sts in corner across lower edge of slit. For left sleeve, start at lower edge and work all around to top of slit.

WRAP AROUND

SKIRT

Sizes: 8-10, 12-14, 16

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz.

skeins

4 skeins Fisherman

skein Raspberry (all

sizes)

7 inch zipper Elastic for waist H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 2 patterns = 1 inch5 rows = 1 inch

NOTE: The skirt is planned for 22½ inch length. Any adjustment in length should be made before 1st dec row.

Directions are given for 8-10 size. Change for size 12-14 and size 16 are given in parentheses.

With Fisherman ch 86 (88, 92), work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, 85 (87,91) sc, ch 2, turn.

ROW 2: Work 42 (43, 45) patterns across row same as Jacket on page 4. Work even in pattern until section measures 10 inches. Dec 1 pattern at end of each of next 2 rows; then dec 1 pattern each end at 14 and 18 inches. Work 2 rows, then dec 1 pattern at end of next 2 rows. Repeat last 4 rows once more. Work on remaining 32 (33, 35) patterns until section is desired length, cut yarn.

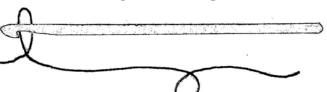
LEFT FRONT SECTION: Ch 54 (56, 58), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 2, turn. Work 26 (27, 28) patterns across row. Work even in pattern working decs at side edge only at 10, 14 and 18

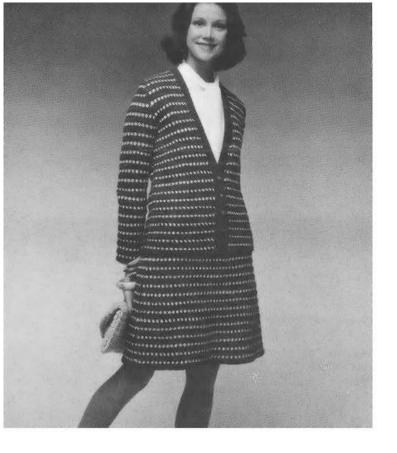
NOTE: (Decs do not have to be worked in corresponding rows of back). When 18 inches of pattern have been completed and there are 23 (24, 25) patterns remaining, work 3 rows; then dec as before. Repeat last 4 rows once more. Work on 21 (22, 23) patterns until same length as back, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT SECTION: Work to match left front section reversing shaping.

FRONTBAND: With right side facing and Fisherman, work a row of sc along straight front edge. Complete edge same as jacket. Work 2nd front to correspond.

FINISHING: Sew side seams together matching rows and leaving opening at top of left side seam for zipper. Work a row of sc along both sides of opening. Sew zipper in place. Press side seams. Cut elastic to fit waist. Sew each end of elastic to zipper opening. Allow the right front section to overlap the left front section by about 8 inches. Sew top edge of elastic to skirt. Work cross stitch over elastic to hold in place on wrong side of waist.





CARDIGAN

Directions are given for sizes 8-10. Changes for sizes 12-14, 16 are given in brackets.

Sizes: 8-10, 12-14, 16

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz.

skeins

4 (4, 5) skeins Raspberry

1 (all sizes) Fisherman

5 Buttons

Circular Knitting Needle #7

G Crochet Hook for beginning

H Crochet Hook for main part OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE for H Hook: 4 sts = 1 inch; 3
pattern rows = 1
inch

BACK: Starting at lower edge with Raspberry and G hook, ch 71 (73, 77), 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each rem st of ch; 69 (71, 75) sts. Continue in pattern st same as skirt for 5 inches. Change to H hook and continue until work measures 17 inches from beg or is length desired to underarm ending with an sc row. For skirt — See page 47. SHAPE ARMHOLES: SI st across 1st 4 st (all sizes), work to within last 4 sts; Dec 1 st each side in each of next 2 rows, then continue even on 57 (59, 63) sts until armholes measure 7½ (7¾, 8) inches.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Sl st across 6 sts, (all sizes), work to within 6 sts, turn. Sl st across 11 (12, 13) sts, work to within last 11 (12, 13) sts; 23 (23, 25) sts remain for back of neck.

LEFT FRONT: Ch 39 (41, 45), 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each rem st of ch; 37 (39, 43) sts. Work same as back until section measures 10 inches, end at front edge. Mark

this point for beg of Neck shaping.

SHAPE NECK: Dec 1 st at neck edge, then repeat dec every 3rd row at neck edge 11 (12, 15) times altogether. AT THE SAME TIME, when side edge measures same as back to underarm SHAPE ARMHOLE: At armhole edge, sl st across 1st 4 sts, then dec 1 st at armhole edge in 4 following rows. When 17 (18, 19) sts remain, work same as back to shoulder.

SHAPE SHOULDER: Work same as back.

RIGHT FRONT: Work same as left front

reversing all shaping.

SLEEVE: With G hook, ch 37 (39, 43), dc in 4th ch from hook and in each st of ch; 35 (37, 41) dc. Work in pattern inc 1 st each side every 2 inches 6 times changing to H hook when work measures 5 inches. Continue on 47 (49, 53) sts until sleeve measures 17 inches or is desired length to underarm.

SHAPE CAP: SI st across 1st 5 sts, work to within last 5 sts. Dec 1 st each side on next 12

(12, 13) rows.

NEXT ROW: SI st across 1st 2 sts, work to within last 2 sts; 9 (11, 13) sts remain, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew side and shoulder seams. Using circular knitting needle and Raspberry, starting at lower right front edge, pick up sts along all front edges and neckline. NOTE: There should be the same number of sts on each side of fronts; therefore pick up 8 sts across the 6 rows of each pattern. Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 2 rows.

ROW 3: (Right Front) Starting from the point where neck shaping finishes, mark position for 5 evenly spaced buttons. BUT-TONHOLES: Bind off 2 sts over markers having even number of sts between button-holes.

ROW 4: Complete buttonhole by casting on 2 sts over bound off sts.

ROW 5 & 6: Work even in ribbing.

ROW 7: Bind off in ribbing.

Press seams on wrong side. Sew sleeve seams and sew sleeves in position. Sew buttons in position.

DIRNDL

Directions on page 47

A DASH OF MOHAIR

MATERIALS: Pure Mohair
HAT-2 oz. White
SCARF-3 oz. White

K Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW GAUGE: 3 sts = 1 inch; 4 rows = 1 inch

BERET

Ch 3, join to form a ring, ch 1, work 8 sc in ring, do not join this or following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd ROUND: 2 sc in each sc around.

3rd ROUND: * 2 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next sc; repeat from * around (24 sc).

4th ROUND: * 2 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from * around.

5th ROUND: * 2 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from * around (40 sc).

6th THROUGH 10th ROUND: Continue increasing in above manner always having 1 more sc between increases until there are 8 sc between increases.

11th THROUGH 17th ROUND: 1 sc in each sc around (80 sc).

18th ROUND: Dec 6 sts evenly spaced all around. (To dec: insert hook into first sc, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert hook in next sc, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and work off 3 loops on hook - 1 dec made).

19th AND 20th ROUNDS: Repeat 18th round for each round.

21st AND 22nd ROUNDS: Dec 5 sts evenly spaced in each round.

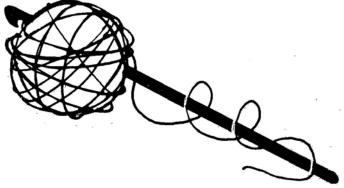
23rd AND 24th ROUND - RIBBING: * working in back loops only 1 sc in each of next 2 sc, working in front loops only 1 sc in each of next 2 sc.

Repeat from * all around.

25th ROUND: SI st in each st all around; cut yarn.

If desired lace white round elastic through ribbing; secure ends and adjust to fit head size.





SCARF 7" X 42"

Working loosely throughout ch 19, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across (18 sts), ch 2, turn.

2nd ROW: Turning ch 2 counts as 1st dc, 1 dc in each sc across (18 sts), ch 1, turn.

3rd ROW: Sc in each dc across including top of turning ch, ch 2, turn.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternating dc and sc rows until yarn is used up, end with an sc row.

THE BIG CAPE COAT

One size molds to fit 10-16

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz. skeins

COAT & 4 skeins Navy

BERET 3 skeins each White and

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 1 ripple pattern = 3½ inches

BACK: With Navy, starting at lower edge, ch 169, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 6 chs, * 3 sc in next ch, 1 sc in each of the next 7 chs, skip 2 chs, 1 sc in each of the next 7 chs, repeat from * across, end 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of the last 7 chs, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Working in back loops of sts throughout, skip 1st sc, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, * 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, skip 2 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sc, repeat from * across, end 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 6 sc, skip 1 sc, sc in last sc, ch 1, turn. Repeat row 2 for pattern throughout working 2 more rows Navy, * 4 rows White, 4 rows Aqua, 4 rows Navy. Repeat from last * for color scheme until 27 rows have been completed.

SHAPING: Dec row. Keeping in established color sequence, dec 1 st between points having 6 sc between points. (20 sc dec)

NEXT 11 ROWS: Work even. Then repeat dec row having 5 sc between points. Then repeat dec row every 4th row twice more. There will be 3 sc between points. Work even until back measures 20 inches from beg or desired length to underarm.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: 1 sc in each of the 1st 6 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, work in pattern across to within last 10 sts, skip 2 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the last 6 sts, turn.

NEXT ROW: SI st across 8 sts, work in pattern to within last 9 sts, ch 1, turn (1 ripple pattern dec'd at each side).

Work even in pattern until armholes measure 8 inches.

NEXT ROW: Skip 1 st, 1 hdc in each of the next 3 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, 1 hdc in each of the next 3 sc, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sc, 1

hdc in each of next 3 sc, repeat from * across, end sc in next sc, 1 hdc in each of the next 3 sc, ch 1, turn.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Work 1 sc in each of the next 16 sts, ch 1, turn. Work 1 more row in sc, cut yarn.

Skip 4 points for back of neck, attach yarn and work other shoulder to correspond.

LEFT FRONT: Ch 84, work in pattern same as back to underarm ending with same color row as back.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: Work shaping same as back; and at the same time, dec 1 st at neck edge every 4th row 4 times; then dec every other row 4 times; then dec every row 4 times.

SHAPE SHOULDER: Work same as back.

RIGHT FRONT: Work same as left front reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES: Ch 84, work in pattern same as back for 15 rows.

NEXT ROW: Work dec row same as back.

Then work dec row every 6th row twice more. Work even until sleeve measures 16 inches from beg, end with same color row as back.

SLEEVE CAP: 1 sc in 1st 6 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, work in pattern across row to within last 10 sts, skip 2 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the last 6 sts, turn.

NEXT ROW: Sl st across 1st 8 sts, work in pattern to within last 9 sts, ch 1, turn (1 point dec'd at each end).

Work even in pattern for 14 more rows, then dec 1 st each end every row 8 times, cut yarn.

COLLAR: With Navy ch 111 loosely, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Working in back loop of sts 1 sc in each sc to within last 3 sc, sl st in next sc, ch 1, turn.

ROW 3: Skip the sl st, 1 sc in each sc to within the last 3 sc, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn. Repeat rows 2 and 3 until there are 20 sc in row, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Skip the sl st, work 1 sc in each sc working 1 sc in each sl st, ch 1, cut yarn at end of last row.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position matching rows and stripes.

EDGE: On right side, join Navy at lower edge on right front, work 1 row of sc all around, holding neck edge in slightly. Sew collar in place.

HE AND SHE FAVORITES

LADIES SWEATER

Sizes: 8-10, 12-14

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted- 4 oz.

skeins

5 (6) skeins Natural 1 (2) skeins Med. Blue

3 (4) skeins Navy

J Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 3 patterns = 2 inches

Directions are given for size 8-10. Changes for size 12-14 are given in parentheses.

BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS: Width across back at underarms 20 (22)", width across each front at underarm not including border 10 (11)".

BACK: With Natural, ch 92 (98), 1 sc, 1 dc in 2nd st from hook, * skip 2 sts of ch, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, repeat from * across ch, end sk 2 sts of ch, 1 sc in last ch, ch 1 to turn all rows.

ROW 2: 1 sc, 1 dc in 1st st (pattern), * skip 1 dc, 1 sc 1 dc in next sc, repeat from * across row. End sk 1 st, 1 sc in last st. 30 (32) patterns. Repeat 2nd row 16 times, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 19: Attach Med. Blue in 1st sc, work in pattern, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 20: Attach Navy in 1st sc, 1 sc in same space and in each rem st, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 21: Attach Med. Blue in 1st sc, sc in same space completing st with Natural, * with Natural sc in next sc completing st with Med. Blue, with Med. Blue sc in next sc, completing st with Natural, repeat from * across completing last sc with Med. Blue, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 22: With Navy, 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 23: With Med. Blue work in pattern, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 24: With Natural work in pattern, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 25: With Med. Blue, 1 sc in each st, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 26: With Navy work in pattern, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 11 ROWS: Work in pattern, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 38: With Med. Blue, 1 sc in each st, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 39: With Natural work in pattern, cut yarn, turn.

ROWS 40 TO 45: Repeat rows 19 to 24. ROWS 46 TO 50: With Natural work in pattern.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: ROW 1: SI st across 1st 6 sts, ch 1, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, continue in pattern to within last 8 sts, skip 1 st, sc in next st, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: (Dec row) Pull up a loop in each of 1st 3 sts, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time (dec over 3 sts), dc in same space where last loop was pulled up, continue in pattern to within last 4 sts, skip 1 st, work a dec; 45 (51) sts remain.

ROWS 3 AND 4: Work even in pattern. Repeat the last 3 rows once, 41 (47) sts. Work even in pattern until armholes measure 7½ (8)" from 1st shaping.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: SI st across 1st 4 sts, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, work 3 patterns, skip 1 st, sc in next st, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Work 2 patterns, skip 1 st, sc in next st, sl st in next st, cut yarn.

Skip 15 (21) sts at center, attach yarn in next st, 1 sc, 1 dc in same space, work 3 more patterns, skip 1 st, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn. NEXT ROW: Skip the sl st, sl st across next 4 sts, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, work 1 pattern, sc in next st, cut yarn.

BORDER: With right side facing, working along starting ch, attach Med. Blue in base of 1st st, 1 sc, dc in same space, * skip 2 sts of ch, 1 sc, 1 dc in base of next st, repeat from * across, end sc in last st, cut yarn, do not turn.

Repeat from Row 20 to 24 of Back.

POCKETS: (Make 2) With Natural, ch 29, work 1st 14 rows same as back, cut yarn, set aside.

LADIES SASH SWEATER Continued from page 10

RIGHT FRONT: With Natural, ch 47 (50), work 1st 14 rows same as back 15 (16) patterns.

ROW 15: Work in pattern across 1st 5 (7) sts, skip 1 st, working through both thicknesses, insert hook in next st and in 1st sc on wrong side of last row of pocket section, work 1 sc, 1 dc in same space, work 8 patterns across pocket section, skip 17 sts of front section, working through both thicknesses, work 1 sc, 1 dc in next st of front and last st of pocket, continue across rem sts of front.

Work 3 more rows even in pattern. Then repeat from row 19 to underarm shaping of back.

NEXT ROW: ARMHOLES: SI st across 1st 6 sts, ch 1, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, continue across in pattern ending with sl st in last sc, ch 1, turn. 12 (13) patterns.

ROW 2: Skip the sl st, sc in next dc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, work 9 (10) more patterns, skip 1 st, work a dec, ch 1, turn.

ROW 3: Work in pattern across row to within last 5 sts, skip 1 st, work a dec over last 4 sts, ch 1, turn.

ROW 4: Work even in pattern, 9 (10) patterns.

ROW 5: Work a dec over 1st 3 sts, dc in same space where last loop was pulled up, continue in pattern across row end with sl st in last st, ch 1, turn.

ROW 6: Skip the sl st, sc in next st, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, continue in pattern across. 7 (8) patterns.

ROW 7: Repeat 3rd row. 6 (7) patterns.

ROW 8: Work even in pattern. 6 (7) patterns. ROW 9: Work in pattern (all sizes) end with sl st in last st for size 12-14 only.

NEXT ROW: For size 12-14 only, repeat row 6.

NEXT ROW: Work 6 patterns, skip 1 st, sc in next st, ch 1, turn. All sizes work even in pattern until armhole has same amount of rows as back ending at armhole edge.

NEXT ROW: Sl st across 1st 4 sts, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, work 3 patterns, skip 1 st, sc in next st, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Work 2 patterns, skip 1 st, sc in next st, sl st in next st, cut yarn.

Work border at lower edge same as back. LEFT FRONT: Work same as right front

reversing the shaping.

SLEEVES: With Natural, ch 41 (44) work 1st 4 rows same as back, 13 (14) patterns.

ROW 5: Work in pattern, end skip 1 st, 2 sc in last st.

ROW 6: Sc in 1st sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next sc, continue in pattern across, end skip 1 st, 2 sc in last st.

ROWS 7, 8 AND 9: Sc in 1st sc, 1 sc, 1 dc in next st, continue in pattern across to within last 3 sts, skip 1 st, 1 sc in each of the last 2 sts.

ROW 10: 1 sc, 1 dc in each of 1st 2 sts, skip 1 st, continue in pattern across to within last st, sc in last st.

ROWS 11 AND 12: Work even in pattern, 15 (16) patterns, cut yarn, turn.

ROWS 13 TO 18: Repeat from row 19 to 24 of back.

ROW 19: With Med. Blue, work in sc inc 1 sc at beg and end of row, cut yarn, do not turn. ROWS 20 AND 21: With Navy, work even 16 (17) in pattern.

ROWS 22 TO 27: Repeat from the 5th to the 10th row of sleeve, 18 (19) patterns.

NEXT 4 ROWS: Work even in pattern, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 32: With Med. Blue, work in sc inc 1 sc at beg and end of row, cut yarn, turn; 19 (20) sts.

ROW 33: With Natural, work in pattern, cut yarn, turn. 19 (20) patterns.

NEXT 6 ROWS: Repeat from row 19 to 24 of back.

NEXT 5 ROWS: With Natural, work in pat-

SHAPE CAP: Work 1st row of armhole shaping.

NEXT 4 ROWS: Work even in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Repeat dec row of armhole.

NEXT 3 ROWS: Work even in pattern.

NEXT ROW: Work a dec row.

NEXT ROW: Work even in pattern.

Repeat last 2 rows once, cut yarn; 7 (8) patterns remain. Work border same as back.

FINISHING: Block all sections. Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams matching rows. Sew sleeves in position. Sew pockets to wrong side of fronts. With Natural, sl st in each st across top of pocket opening.

FRONT BORDER: With right side facing, attach Natural in lower right corner, 1 sc, 1 dc in same space, working up front, * skip 1 row, 1 sc, 1 dc in next row, repeat from * up front, around back of neck and down opposite front to lower corner, ch 1, turn.

NO SAG IN THIS BAG

Approximate size: 13 x 7 inches

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz.

skeins

2 skeins Fisherman ½ yd. lining material

1 Button

I Aluminum Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 3 sc = 1 inch

NOTE: Work bag with double strand of yarn. Ch 34, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn. (33 sc).

Repeat row 2 until there are 39 rows.

START FLAP: Dec 1 st at beg and end of every row 5 times.

NEXT ROW: Sl st across 2 sts, work to within 2 sts, turn.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Repeat last row (11 sc).

NEXT ROW: Sl st across 2 sts, 1 sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3, skip 3 sts for buttonhole, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Sl st in each of next 2 sts, work 3 sc in ch 3 loop, sl st in next st, cut yarn.

EDGE: Join yarn at lower edge on right side and work 1 row of sc around to other end, do not turn, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Working from left to right, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, * ch 1, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, repeat from * to other end (this forms reverse sc), cut yarn.

FINISHING: Fold 17 rows up to beg of flap. Sew side edges tog (6 inches). Sew button in place. Line if desired.

LINING: Cut lining same length and width as bag, plus ½ inch on all edges for seam allowance. Fold lining section same as bag. Stitch side seam. Place lining in bag. Turn raw edges under along top of bag and stitch in place.

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz.

9 (10, 11) skeins Aqua 2 inch Belt Buckle 12 Buttons

H Aluminum Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 7 sts = 2 inches

Directions are given for size 8-10. Changes for Sizes 12-14 and Size 16 are given in parentheses.

BACK: Starting at lower edge, ch 79 (83, 87), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn; 78 (82, 86) sts. ROW 2: 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.

ROW 3: Repeat row 2, end ch 3, turn.

START PATTERN ROW 1: (right side) Skip 1 sc, 1 dc in each of the next 3 sc, insert hook into skipped sc, in front of the 3 dc just completed, draw up a long loop loosely and work off 2 loops, repeat from beg across, ch 1 turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each st, ch 3, turn.

Repeat pattern rows 1 and 2 until back measures 20 inches from beg, end with pattern row 1.

NEXT ROW (dec row): Working in pattern, dec 1 st each side.

Then dec 1 st each side every 3½ inches 5 times more; 66 (70, 74) sts remain. Work even in pattern until back measures 46 inches from beg, end with pattern row 2, do not ch 3 at end of row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Sl st across 6 sts (all sizes), work to within last 6 sts, ch 1, turn. Dec 1 st each side every other row twice; 50 (54, 58) sts remain. Work even until armholes measure 8 (8, 8½) inches, end with pattern row 2, ch 1.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Working remainder of back in sc, sl st across 6 sc, sc across to within 6 sc. Repeat last row once; 26 (30, 34) sts remain for back of neck, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT: Ch 43 (47, 51), mark beg of row for side edge. Work same as back until 3 inches below underarm, dec at side edge same as back, keeping front edge even (no incs or decs).

SHAPE NECK: ARMHOLE AND SHOUL-DER: Dec 1 st at neck edge every row 11 (20, 24) times, then on Size 8-10 only dec 1 st at neck edge every other row 5 times.

ALL SIZES: At the same time, when front measures same as back to underarm shape armhole same as back. Work even on remaining 12 shoulder sts same as back. Shape shoulder same as back.

LEFT FRONT: Work same as right front marking the end of row for side edge and reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES: Ch 31 (35, 39), 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 2 ROWS: 1 sc in each sc, ch 3, turn. Then work in pattern same as back until sleeve measures 3½ inches from beg, end with pattern row 1.

NEXT ROW: Inc 1 st each side working row in pattern. Then repeat inc row every 6th row 5 times more; 42 (46, 50) sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 17½ inches from beg ending with pattern row 2.

SLEEVE CAP: SI st across 6 sts, work to within 6 sts. Then dec 1 st at each side every other row until 20 (24, 28) sts remain.

NEXT ROW: Working remainder of sleeve in sc, sl st across 2 sts, work to within 2 sts, turn. Repeat last row once, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew sleeves in position.

NECK AND FRONT BANDS: Join yarn on right side at lower right front, work 1 row of sc up right front, around neck and down left front working sufficient sc to keep work flat and having same amount of sts on each front, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.

Mark left front for 12 buttons having 1st marker about 9 inches from lower edge and last marker at beg of neck shaping, remaining markers evenly spaced between. Work button holes on right front opposite markers.

BUTTONHOLES: Ch 2, skip 2 sc, in next row work 2 sc in each ch 2 space of button-

Sew buttons in position.

BELT: Ch 7, sc in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.

Repeat last row until belt measures about 30 inches or is desired length. Dec 1 st at each side until all sts are dec'd, cut yarn. Sew buckle in place to other end.



SHEER BRILLIANCE

SILVER METALLIC HALTER

* ...

Sizes: 10, 12, 14

MATERIALS: Silver Metallic yarn 4 (4, 5) 1 oz. balls

G Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 3 sc and 2 ch 1 spaces = 1 inch Directions are given for Size 10. Changes for Sizes 12 and 14 are given in parentheses.

BODY SECTION: Starting at lower edge, ch 132 (142, 152), 1 sc in 2nd st from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, sc in next ch, repeat from * across, ch 1, turn, 66 (71, 76) sc.

ROW 2: 1 sc in 1st sc, * ch 1, 1 sc in next sc, repeat from * across, ch 1, turn.

Repeat row 2 for pattern until section measures 6 inches from beg.

SHAPE BACK & ARMHOLE: Sl st across 2 sc, work in pattern to within 2 sc, do not ch 1 at end of row (4 sc dec).

NEXT 18 ROWS: Sl st across 1st 2 sc at beg of each row completing row in pattern; 26 (31, 36) sc.

Work even in pattern on the 26 (31, 36) sc until section measures 12 inches from beg.

NEXT ROW: Work in pattern across 10 (12, 14) sc, ch 1, turn.

Work even in pattern on the 10 (12, 14) sc for 12 (12½, 13) inches, cut yarn. Skip 6 (7,8) sc on last long row and work other side to correspond.

FINISHING: Sew back seam. EDGE: Join yarn on upper edge of right side at back seam, and work 1 row of sc, do not turn.

NEXT ROW: Work 1 sc in each sc, join.

NEXT ROW: Working from left to right work reverse sc (to work reverse sc: * ch 1, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc), repeat from * all around, join, cut yarn.

Work edge in same manner on lower edge.

BUTTONS: Make 4. Ch 3, join to form ring, ch 1, work 6 sc in ring, do not join, place a marker at beg of each round.

RND 2: 2 sc in each sc.

RNDS 3 & 4: 1 sc in each sc, fill cup with cotton or yarn.

RND 5: * Skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, repeat from * until all sts are dec, cut yarn. Sew buttons in position. Cross straps at neck and button thru edge of strap.

HAIRPIN LACE SKIRT

Sizes: 8-10, 12-14, 16

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz. skeins 4 (5-5) skeins Aqua

Metallic Yarn-1 oz. balls 2 (2-3) balls Silver

4 inch Hairpin Lace Loom

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 5 patterns = 4 inches

Directions are for size 8-10. Changes for sizes 12-14 and 16 are in parentheses.

HAIRPIN LACE

STEP 1: Form slip loop ½ the size of loom, place left prong in loop, replace bar.

STEP 2: Wind yarn around right prong of loom and across back, insert crochet hook in loop to left of center.

STEP 3: Pick up and pull through, yarn over and pull through loop.

STEP 4: Drop loop from hook, insert hook in loop in back of loom.

STEP 5: Always turn loom toward you from right to left, ch 1.

STEP 6: Sc in front loop to left of sts at center.

Repeat steps 4, 5 and 6 until required number of loops are on each side of loom.

With Aqua, make 26 strips, having 90 (96-102) loops on each side of loom. Make 12 strips having 45 (48-51) loops on each side of loom.

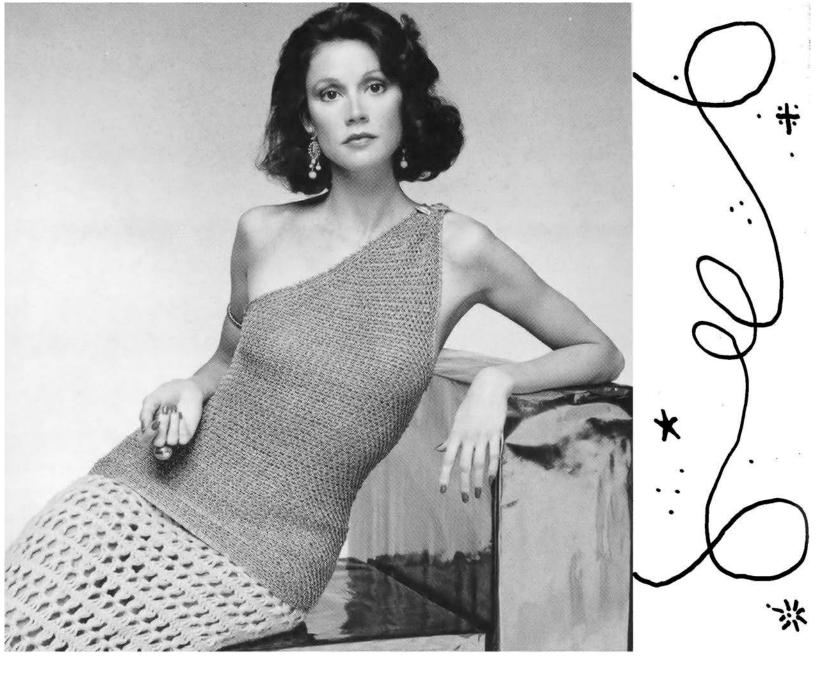
With Silver Metallic, make 2 strips having 150 (160-170) loops on each side of loom. Make 4 strips having 75 (80-85) loops on each side of loom.

BACK: Starting at lower edge, join strips in this manner: Working from right to left, take 1 strip of Aqua 90 (96-102) loops and 1 Silver strip 150 (160-170) loops, place Silver strip above Aqua strip, insert hook through 3 loops of Aqua, draw 5 loops of Silver through the 3 loops of Aqua, then draw 3 loops of Aqua through the 5 loops of Silver, continue in this manner until all loops are worked, tie at end. Repeat with 1 more strip each of Aqua and Silver (total, 2 strips of Silver, 2 strips Aqua). Then work 14 more strips with Aqua, working 3 loops through 3 loops. Finish top of skirt by drawing 3 loops through 3 loops.

FRONT: For Split: 1st Half: With smaller strips, work in same manner as back having 2

BACK: Starting at lower edge ch 79 (85, 91), sc in 3rd st from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, 1 sc in next ch; repeat from * across, ch 2, turn, 39 (42, 45) sc.

ROW 2: Skip 1st sc, sc in next ch 1 space, * ch 1, sc in next ch 1 space; repeat from * across, ch 2, turn.

Repeat row 2 for pattern until back measures 14 inches from beg or desired length to underarm.

SHAPE ARMHOLE & SHOULDER: Sl st across 3 sc, mark this side for arm edge, mark other side for shoulder edge. Work in pattern across to within last 2 sc, dec 1 sc (to dec: draw up a loop in next ch 1 space, draw up a loop in next ch 1 space, yarn over and through all 3 loops), then dec 1 st at arm edge every other row 2 (3, 4) times. Dec 1 st at shoulder edge every other row until there are 16 (17, 18) sc, then every row 7 (8, 9) times. There will be 9 sc rem (All Sizes). Work even on the 9 sc until armhole measures 7½ (7½, 8) inches, cut yarn.

Hat-1 skein Cream Scarf-2 skeins Cream

Q Crochet Hook K Crochet Hook

NOTE: Work with two strands of yarn throughout.

With Q hook ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 work 8 sc in ring, do not join throughout. Place a marker at beg of each round.

1st ROUND: 2 sc in each sc around. (16)

2nd ROUND: * 1 sc in 1st sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around.(24)

3rd ROUND: * 1 sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around. (32)

4th ROUND: * 1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc

in next sc; repeat from * around. (40) 5th THROUGH 10th ROUND: 1 sc in each sc

around. (40)
11th ROUND: Change to K hook. * 2 sc in
1st sc, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from *

around, end with 2 sc in last sc.

12th ROUND: * 1 sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around.

13th ROUND: * 1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around.

14th ROUND: * 2 sc in first sc, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc; repeat from * around.

15th & 16th ROUNDS: 1 sc in each sc in each round working the 16th round loosely, sl st in last sc, cut yarn.

TIE: With K hook ch 85, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch, cut yarn and weave in end. If desired, weave round elastic in 1st round of brim to fit headsize. Secure elastic.

FRINGED SCARF

With Q hook ch 11, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 1 to turn this and following rows.

ROW 2: Counting ch 1 as 1st sc, sc in next sc and in each sc across, end with sc in turning ch of last row.

Repeat 2nd row until scarf measures 72 inches or desired length.



EDGE: After last row do not ch 1 but turn and work 3 sc in corner space, * 1 sc in next space, 2 sc in next space; repeat from * across working 3 sc in corner, * 1 sc in side of 1st horizontal row along side, 2 sc in side of next row; repeat from last * along side working 3 sc in next corner. Continue 1 sc, then 2 sc across ch at starting edge catching in a vertical loop from row below to avoid large spaces, work 3 sc in corner and continue along 2nd side in same manner, join, cut yarn.

FRINGE: Cut yarn into 16-inch strands. Fold 4 strands in half and pull through, draw ends tightly through loop. Work a fringe in each st at short ends of scarf. Trim fringe evenly.

TENNIS DRESS

Sizes: Small, Medium, Large

MATERIALS: Synthetic Baby Yarn or

Fingering Yarn-1 oz.

skeins

10 (12, 14) skeins White

G & H Crochet Hooks OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN

GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE for H Hook: 4 shells = 6 inches;

7 shell rows = 3

inches

GAUGE for G Hook: 4 tr = 1 inch

NOTE: In order to obtain gauge it may be necessary to draw up a slightly longer loop in working dc's of shells.

Directions are given for Small size. Changes for Medium and Large sizes are given in

parentheses.

SKIRT

BACK: Starting at waistline with H hook, ch 58 (64, 70) loosely. Change to G hook, tr in 5th ch from hook and in each ch across; 55

(61, 67) tr (right side), turn.

ROW 2: Change to H hook, ch 3 (count as 1 dc) 2 dc in 1st tr, * skip 2 tr, sc in next tr, skip 2 tr, 5 dc in next tr (shell), repeat from * across row, end 3 dc in last st, ch 1, turn; 8 (9, 10) full shells with ½ shell at each end.

ROW 3: sc in 1st dc, * 5 dc shell in next sc, sc in center dc of next shell, repeat from * across row, end sc in last st, ch 3, turn; 9 (10,

11) full shells.

ROW 4: 2 dc in 1st sc, * sc in center dc of next shell, 5 dc in next sc, repeat from * across, end 3 dc in last sc, ch 1, turn; 8 (9, 10) shells with ½ shell at each end.

ROW 5: (Inc row) Mark the 4th sc from each end of row, work in pattern across row working 5 dc, 1 sc, 5 dc in each marked sc (2 shells inc); 11 (12, 13) full shells.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Work even in pattern.

ROW 8: (Inc row) Mark 4th sc from each end of row and work inc's same as 5th row; 12 (13, 14) full shells with ½ shell at each end.

Continue in pattern working inc's as before in the 12th (12th, 12th) rows. There will be 14 (15, 16) full shells. Work even in pattern until section measures 11½ (12, 13) inches from beg or is about ½ inch less than desired length of skirt from waistline.

TOP: With right side facing and G hook, join yarn on other side of starting ch in base of 1st tr, ch 4, 1 tr in base of each tr across, turn.

NEXT ROW: Change to H hook and work in

pattern same as skirt until the 1st inc row has been completed. There will be 11 (12, 13) full shells at end of inc row. Work even until top measures 7¼ (7¾, 8¼) inches or is about ½ inch less than desired length to armhole, end with 3rd row (all sizes) of pattern, cut yarn, turn

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Join yarn and sc in center dc of 1st full shell, continue across row in pattern, end sc in center dc of last full shell, cut yarn, turn. Repeat last row once, do not cut yarn, turn.

NEXT ROW: Work in pattern as established,

turn.

SHAPE NECK: Work in pattern to se of 3rd (3rd, 4th) full shell, cut yarn, turn. Join yarn in center de of next full shell, continue in pattern to armhole edge, turn. Continue in pattern dec at side of neck until 1 sc, 1 full shell, 1 sc remain.

NEXT ROW: Work ½ shell, 1 sc, ½ shell. Repeat last 2 rows for shoulder straps for 8½ (9, 9½) inches or until straps are about 1½ inches less than desired length, end with ½ shell at each edge, cut yarn.

Join yarn, ch 1, sc in corresponding full shell of other shoulder. Complete strap and shoulder to correspond, reversing shaping.

FRONT: Work skirt and top same as back until armhole shaping has been completed. Work even in pattern until armholes measure 3 (3½, 4) inches.

SHAPE NECK AND SHOULDER: Work same as back working only until straps measure 7 (7½, 8) inches or desired length to shoulder, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Block and steam sections lightly. Matching rows and patterns, sew side and shoulder seams. Leave opening on left

side seam for zipper (if desired).

EDGE: With right side facing and G hook, join yarn in seam at armhole, ch 3, 2 dc in seam, then continue around armhole in shell pattern holding edge in. NEXT ROW: 2 sc in top of ch 3, 1 sc in each of the next 2 dc, * sl st in both loops of next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 2 dc, ch 3, sl st in 1st ch (picot), 2 sc in 3rd dc of shell, picot, 1 sc in each of the next 2 dc, repeat from * around omitting picots at underarm shell, working edge to within the top of 1st back shoulder strap, sl st in 1st sc, ch 6, sl st in 1st ch for buttonhole, 1 sc, picot as before across shell, work buttonloop, then complete all around with picot edge, cut yarn.

Work edge around 2nd strap to correspond. HEMLINE: With right side facing and H hook, join yarn at a seam and work picot edge all around, join, cut thread. CORDS: Make 2. With double strand of yarn and H hook, ch 2,



draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over and draw through 1st loop on hook, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook, do not turn.

NEXT AND FOLLOWING ROWS: * Draw up a loop between loops of previous row, yarn over and draw through loop, yarn over and

draw through both loops on hook, repeat from * until cord is length desired to tie around waist (about 54 or 60 inches long). Starting at center front, lace each cord through a row of tr's. Make a knot in each end of cord. Finish end with tassels or pompons. Knot cord at waist.

TOOTSIE TOASTER #1

Sizes: Small, Medium, Large

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz.

skeins

1 skein each White and

Aqua (all sizes)

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 3 sc = 1 inch

Directions are given for Small size. Changes for Medium and Large sizes given in parentheses.

NOTE: Entire slipper is worked with double strand of yarn.

SOLES: With Aqua ch 7, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch (6 sc), ch 1 to turn all rows.

ROW 2: (inc row) Inc 1 sc at beg and end of row.

ROW 3: Work even in sc.

ROW 4: Repeat row 2 (10 sc).

Work even on the 10 sc for 9 (10, 11) rows from beg.

NEXT 3 ROWS: Dec 1 st at end of each row (7 sc).

Work even on the 7 sc until sole measures 8½ (9, 9½) inches from beg, cut yarn.

UPPER SECTION: Starting at toe with White, ch 10, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows (9 sc).

NEXT 2 ROWS: Inc 1 st at beg and end of row (13 sc).

Work even on 13 sc until there are 11 rows from beg.

SIDE SECTION: Work across 5 sc, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 6 ROWS: Work 1 sc in each sc.

NEXT ROW: Inc 1 st at beg of row for top edge.

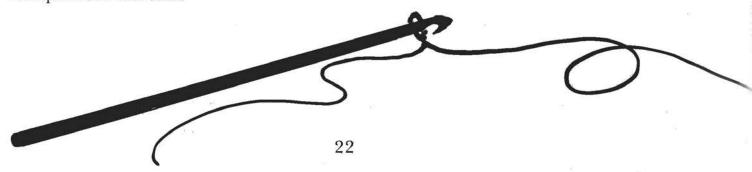
Work even on the 6 sc until top fits sole to center back of heel, cut yarn. Skip 3 sc at center on last long row and work other side to correspond. Sew back seam.



With wrong sides together, crochet upper section to sole section with Aqua. Join Aqua at back seam and work 1 round of sc around top edge, join, cut yarn.

POMPONS: Work 2. Wind Aqua 100 times over a 4 inch cardboard, tie in center, cut both ends and fluff into shape. Sew in place to each slipper.

TOP SECTION: With White, ch 38 (50), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 4 (6) chs, * 3 sc in next ch, 1 sc in each of the next 5 (7) chs, skip next 2 chs, 1 sc in each of the next 5 (7) chs, repeat from * across ch, ch 1, turn.

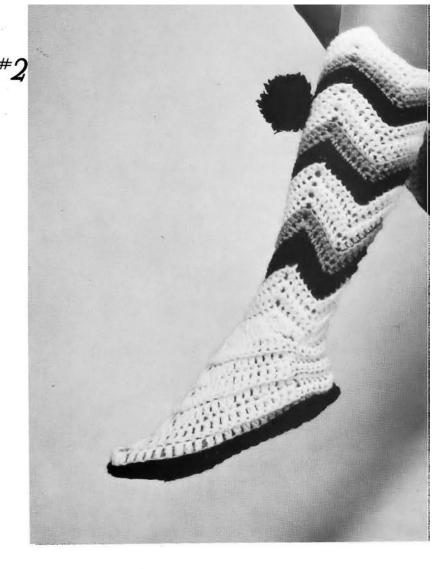
ROW 2: Working in back loops of sts only, skip 1st st, 1 sc in each of the next 5 (7) sc, * 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 5 (7) sc, skip 2 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 5 (7) sc, repeat from * to within last 2 sc, skip 1 sc, sc in last sc, ch 1, turn. Repeat row 2 for pattern working 2 more rows White, join Navy.

SMALL-MEDIUM SIZE ONLY: Repeat row 2 but work 5 sc in each inc point.

LARGE SIZE ONLY: Work same as row 2. ROW 6 (BOTH SIZES): Skip 1st sc, 1 sc in each of the next 6 (7) sts, * 3 sc in next st, 1 sc in each of the next 6 (7) sts, skip next 2 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 6 (7) sts, repeat from * to within last 2 sts, skip 1 sc, sc in last

sc, ch 1, turn.

Repeat last row for pattern alternating colors as follows: 2 rows Aqua, * 4 rows White, 2 rows Navy, 2 rows Aqua, repeat from * once, end with 4 more rows White. There will be 28 rows, cut yarn and sew seam matching rows. INSTEP AND FOOT SECTION: With White join in inc st to right of seam on starting ch, pick up a loop in each of the next 2 (2) sts, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time, 1 sc in each of the next 3 (4) sts, pick up a loop in each of the next 2 (3) sts, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time, 1 sc in each of the next 3 (3) sts, complete row around front of instep for SMALL-MEDIUM SIZE as follows: (see directions below for



LARGE SIZE) keeping last loop of each dc on hook, work 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time * 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, repeat from * once, 1 dc in next st, 5 dc in sc at inc point, * 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, repeat from last * once, 1 dc in next st, keeping last

MY WILD IRISH CROCHET

Sizes: Small, Medium, Large

MATERIALS: Bedspread Cotton-250

yd. Balls

5 (6, 6) balls White

Steel Crochet Hook #5 OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN

GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: Mesh pattern 9 (dc, ch 1) meshes = 2 inches

8 rows = 2 inches

Directions are given for small size. Changes for medium and large sizes in parentheses.

ROSE: Ch 6, join with sl st to form ring, ch 1, work 12 sc in ring, join in 1st sc with sl st.

RND 2: Ch 6, * skip 1 sc, 1 hdc in next sc, ch 4, repeat from * around, join with sl st in 2nd st of ch 6. (6 loops in round).

RND 3: Work 1 sc, 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc in each ch 4 loop, sl st in 1st sc of 1st petal, (6 petals) cut thread, conceal end.

Work a 2nd rose same as 1st rose until 5 petals have been completed, work 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc in next ch 4 loop, sl st in center dc of any petal of 1st rose, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc in same loop of 2nd rose, join with sl st in 1st sc. Join the next rose to 2nd rose in same manner having 2 free petals each side of joining. Continue to join roses in this manner until there are 4 (4,5) strips of 9 (9,10) roses for back panel and 4 (4,5) strips of 7 (7,8) roses for front panel.

TO COMPLETE STRIPS: First strip: Mark center petal of rose at one end of strip for bottom and mark center petal of rose at other

end for top of strip.

Join thread with an sc in center dc of bottom petal, ** ch 3, dc in next hdc of same petal, ch 7 (corner), sc in center dc of next petal, ch 5, sc in center dc of next petal, * ch 5, dc in hdc of joined petal of same rose, dc in hdc of joined petal of next rose, ch 5, sc in center of next petal of same rose, ch 5, sc in center of next petal of same rose, repeat from * along side of strip until sc in last side petal of last rose has been completed, ch 7, dc in hdc of next petal at top, ch 3, sc in center dc of same petal, repeat from ** around strip, ch 3, sl st in starting sc, cut thread.

NEXT AND FOLLOWING STRIPS: Work as for 1st strip until 1st side has been completed, end with sc in center dc of top petal, ch 3, dc in hdc of same petal, ch 3, sl st in center st of ch 7 loop of 1st strip, ch 3, sc in center dc of



next petal of 2nd strip, * ch 2, sl st in center st of next ch 5 loop of 1st strip, ch 2, sc in center dc of next petal of 2nd strip, ch 2, sl st in center st of next ch 5 loop of 1st strip, ch 2, dc in next hdc of joined petal of same 2nd strip, dc in next hdc of joined petal of next rose of 2nd strip, ch 2, sl st in center st of ch 5 loop of 1st strip, ch 2, sc in center st of ch 5 loop of 1st strip, ch 2, sc in center dc of next petal of 2nd strip, repeat from * joining in same manner around side of strip and joining corner same as 1st corner, end ch 3, dc in hdc of last petal, ch 3, sl st in starting sc of 2nd strip, cut thread.

Join remaining strips in same manner until strips for front and back panels have been

completed.

BACK: Working lengthwise of rose panel, attach thread with sl st in center st of corner ch 7 loop at upper right corner, working along side of panel, ch 4 (counts as 1 dc and ch 1), dc in same loop, * ch 1, dc in next sc, (ch 1, hdc) twice in ch 5 loop, ch 1, dc in next sc, ch 1, dc in loop before 2 dc s, ch 3, dc in loop after 2 dc s, repeat from * to corner ch 7 loop, ch 1, dc in corner ch 7 loop, ch 1, dc in 4th ch of same loop, turn. (This will be the right half of back.)

NEXT ROW: Ch 3, dc in 1st ch 1 space, (ch 1, dc) in each ch 1 space, (ch 1, dc) twice in each ch 3 loop across row, end (ch 1, dc) in last ch 1 space, dc in 3rd st of turning ch.

There are 62 (62, 69) ch 1 spaces between dc s with 2 dc s at each end of row, turn.

NEXT ROW: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), * dc in next ch 1 space, ch 1, repeat from * across, end dc, ch 1, dc, in top of turning ch (and increase at end of row), ch 52 (56, 58) for side of neck, turn.

NEXT ROW: Dc in 4th ch from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, dc in next st of ch, repeat from * across ch, continue in ch 1, dc mesh across row end dc in 3rd st of turning ch.

Continue in mesh pattern as established, dec 1 mesh at shoulder edge in the 3rd and 5th row of shoulder strap, 86 (88, 96) ch 1 spaces.

(TO DEC A MESH: Work in 2 ch 1 spaces as follows: thread over hook, insert in ch 1 space and pull up a loop, thread over hook and through 2 loops, insert in next ch 1 space and pull up a loop, thread over and through 2 loops, thread over hook and through all loops on hook.)

Work even until there are 11 rows of mesh

pattern, end at lower edge.



ALL DRESSED UP

Sizes: 4, 6, 8

MATERIALS: SPORT YARN-2 oz.

*

skeins

2 (3, 3) skeins each, Color A and Color B

Model made in Pink (A) and Coral (B)

Neck Zipper

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 7 sc = 2 inches

8 sc rows = 2 inches

Directions are given for size 4. Changes for sizes 6 & 8 are given in parentheses.

NOTE: The ch 1 before each sc row to turn does not count as a st; but the ch 3 at start of dc rows counts as 1st dc. The skirt is crocheted lengthwise. To lengthen skirt, work more chs and add to the number of dc's worked. To shorten skirt, work less chs to start and reduce the number of hdcs worked.

SKIRT

LEFT BACK: With B ch 46 (52, 60) loosely, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across; 45 (51, 59) sc. Mark this for wrong side and beg of row for hem edge, * drop B, join A, turn.

ROWS 2 & 3: Work 1 sc in each sc, drop A, pick up B, turn. Work should measure approximately 13 (14¾, 16¾) inches.

RÔW 4: Ch 1, 1 sc in each of the 1st 8 (10, 10) sc, 1 hdc in each of the next 12 (16, 16) sc, 1 dc in each of the last 25 (25, 33) sc, turn.

ROW 5: Ch 1, 1 sc in each st across, drop B, pick up A, turn.

ROWS 6 & 7: Work 1 sc in each sc, drop A, pick up B, turn.

ROW 8: Ch 1, 1 sc in each of the 1st 8 (10, 10) sc, 1 hdc in each of the next 16 (20, 22) sc, 1 dc in each of the last 21 (21, 27) sc, turn.

ROW 9: Ch 1, 1 sc in each st across.

Repeat from * until there are 6 (7, 7) stripes A.

SIZES 4 & 8: Work 1 more B stripe, drop B, pick up A, turn, ch 1, 1 sc in each st across, cut yarn.

SIZE 6: Drop A, pick up B, turn, ch 1, 1 sc in each st, cut yarn.

RIGHT BACK: Zipper opening. With right side of work facing and counting from waist-line, join B in 16th st of starting ch, ch 17, turn, working along ch, 1 sc in 2nd st of ch and in each of next 15 sts of ch, working on other side of starting ch of left back, sc in 16th ch and in each of the next 28 (34, 42) sts; 45 (51, 59) sc, drop B, join A, turn.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Work 1 sc in each sc, * drop

A, pick up B, turn.

NEXT ROW: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 1 dc in each of next 24 (24, 32) sc, 1 hdc in each of the next 12 (16, 16) sc, 1 sc in each of the last 8 (10, 10) sc, turn.

NEXT ROW: Ch 1, 1 sc in each st across,

drop B, pick up A, turn.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Work 1 sc in each sc, drop

A, pick up B, turn.

NEXT ROW: Ch 3, 1 dc in each of the next 20 (20, 26) sc, 1 hdc in each of the next 16 (20, 22) sc, 1 sc in each of the last 8 (10, 10) sc, turn.

NEXT ROW: Ch 1, 1 sc in each st across, drop B, pick up A, turn.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Work 1 sc in each sc.

Repeat from * until there are 6 (7, 7) A stripes on right side of back.

SIZES 4 & 8: Work 1 more B stripe, drop B, pick up A, turn, ch 1, 1 sc in each st across, cut yarn.

SIZE 6: Drop A, pick up B, turn, ch 1, 1 sc in each sc across, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT: Work same as left side of back.

LEFT FRONT: With wrong side facing, working on other side of starting ch, join B at waistline edge, ch 1, 1 sc in each of 45 (51, 59) sts, drop B, join A.

NEXT 2 RÔWS: 1 sc in each sc. Then repeat from * of right back.

BODICE

LEFT BACK: With A, ch 21 (23, 25), starting on right side of work at center back, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch; 20 (22, 24) sc. Work even in sc for 5 (7,9) rows, end at side edge.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: NEXT ROW: SI st over 1st 3 (3, 4) sc, ch 1, 1 sc in each remaining sc. NEXT ROW: Dec 1 sc at armhole edge (to dec: work 2 sc tog.) Then dec 1 sc every other row 1 (2, 2) times more. Work even on 15 (16,17) sts until section measures 6½ (7, 7½) inches from beg, end at center back edge.

SHAPE NECK: NEXT ROW: Sl st over 1st 5 (5, 6)sc, ch 1, 1 sc in each remaining sc across row.

NEXT ROW: Dec 1 st at neck edge.

Continue even until section measures 7 (7½, 8) inches from beg, end at neck edge.

SHAPE SHOULDER: 1 sc in each of the 1st

5 sc, cut yarn.

RIGHT BACK: Work same as left back, but

reverse shaping.

FRONT: With A, ch 43 (47, 51), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch; 42 (46, 50) sc. Work even for 5 (7, 9) rows.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: NEXT ROW: Sl st over 1st 3 (3, 4) sc, ch 1, 1 sc in each st to within last 3 (3,4) sc, turn.

NEXT ROW: Dec 1 sc at each armhole edge. Then dec 1 st every row 1 (2, 2) times more. AT THE SAME TIME, when section measures 2½ (3, 3½) inches from beg.

SHAPE NECK: Mark center 8 (8, 10) sts.

NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each st to within 1st marker, turn. Working on one side of neck at a time, sl st over 1st 2 sc, ch 1, 1 sc in each remaining sc.

NEXT ROW: Dec 1 sc at neck edge.

Work even over 9 (10, 10) sc until armhole is same length as back to shoulder.

SHAPE SHOULDER: Work same as back. Join yarn at 2nd marker on other side of neck and complete to correspond to 1st side

reversing shaping.

FINISHING: Block and press sections. Join bodice front to back on wrong side. Back st shoulder seams together tapering from ¼ to ½ inch at armhole edge. Weave side seams

together.

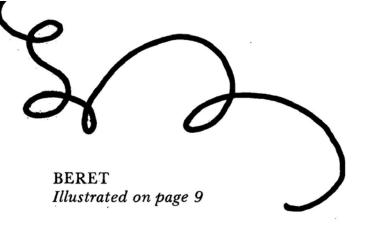
EDGE: With right side facing, starting at waistline with A, work sc along center back edge, work 3 sc at corner of neck edge, sc around neck edge working 3 sc at corners, sc down back edge to waistline, cut yarn. Join B at same starting point, sl st in back loops of each sc all around, then work sc all around waistline on other side of starting ch, do not turn. Working from left to right, 1 sc in back loop of each sc along waistline edge, cut yarn.

With right side of work facing, join B at neck edge of right back, working from left to right sc in back loop of each st around neck, cut yarn.

Work edge around each armhole in same manner (a row of sc with A, a row of sl sts in back loops of sts with B and a row of sc worked from left to right), cut yarn.

NOTE: Entire beret is worked in back loops of sts only. With Navy ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 3, work 15 dc in ring. Do not join rounds, place a marker at beg of each round.

ROUND 2: With White, * skip 1 st, 5 sc in next st, repeat from * all around (8 points). ROUND 3: With White, skip 1 st, * 1 sc in next st, 5 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, skip 2 sc, repeat from * all around.

Continue color scheme same as jacket.

ROUND 4: * 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts, 5 sc in next st, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

ROUND 5: * 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, 5 sc in next st, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

NEXT 7 ROUNDS: Work in same manner as last round having 1 more st between points in each round.

ROUND 13: * Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in each of the next 9 sts, 3 sc in next st, 1 sc in each of the next 9 sts, work 2 sc tog, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

ROUND 14: * Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in each of the next 8 sts, 3 sc in next st, 1 sc in each of the next 8 sts, work 2 sc tog, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

ROUND 15: * Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in each of the next 15 sts (no inc at points), work 2 sc tog, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

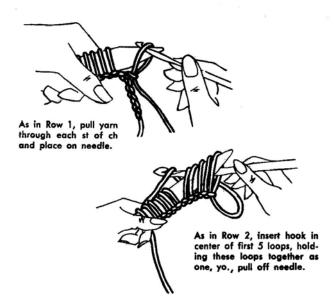
ROUND 16: * Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in each of the next 11 sts, work 2 sc tog, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

ROUND 17: * Work 2 sc tog, 1 sc in each of the next 7 sts, work 2 sts tog, skip 2 sts, repeat from * all around.

ROUND 18: 1 sc in each of the next 7 sts, skip 2 sts, repeat from beg all around, cut yarn.

ROUNDS 19, 20 and 21: With Navy 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn.

If necessary lace elastic through back loops of last 2 rounds to adjust to headsize. Secure ends of elastic.

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz.

skeins

2 skeins Red

4 skeins Blue

K Crochet Hook

GAUGE: 5 patterns = 5½ inches 5 pattern rows = 6 inches

With White ch 200, pull up last loop and place on knitting needle held in left hand, * insert crochet hook in next st of ch, pull yarn through and place on knitting needle, repeat from * across (200 loops).

ROW 2: Insert crochet hook through 1st 5 loops on knitting needle, holding these 5 loops tog as 1, yo and pull off needle, ch 1, work 5 sc in loop, * work 5 sc in each group of 5 loops as before, repeat from * across row (40 patterns). Do not turn, pull up a loop in last st and place on knitting needle.

ROW 3: Insert hook in back loop of next sc, pull loop through and place on knitting needle, repeat from beg row, do not turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 for pattern working 8 rows White, 4 rows Navy, 2 rows White, 4 rows Red. Repeat last 18 rows until there are 108 rows, then work 8 more rows White, cut yarn. Weave all ends under.

YOUNG MISSES JACKET

Sizes: 8-10-12

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted

6 (6, 7) 3½-oz. skeins Variegated Color 1 4-oz. skein (all sizes)

Contrasting Color (CC)

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 4 sts = 1 inch; 5 rows = 2 inches Directions are given for Girl's Size 8. Changes for Sizes 10 and 12 are given in parentheses.

MEASUREMENTS	8	10	12
Chest	26"	28"	30"
Back at underarm	12½"	14"	16"
Front AT UNDERARM	7"	8"	9"

BACK: With Main Color, starting at neck ch 18 (22, 22), 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd ROW: 2 dc in 1st dc, * post st around next dc, (post st: insert hook under next dc bringing hook up on right side, pick up yarn, pull through and complete dc), 1 dc in each of the next 3 dc, repeat from * across row ending post st around next dc, 2 dc in last dc (do not work in ch 3 at end of rows throughout and do not count ch 3 as a st), ch 3, turn. There are 4 (5, 5) post sts; 17 (21, 21) sts in all.

3rd ROW: 2 dc in 1st and last dc working 1 dc in each dc and working a post st around each post st inserting hook under post st from wrong side, ch 3, turn. The last 2 rows form the pattern st.

4th & 5th ROWS: 2 dc in 1st dc, 1 dc in each dc and post st around each post st, 2 dc in last dc, ch 3, turn.

Continue in pattern as established working an additional post st around 2nd and next to last dc in next and in every 4th row until 3 (all sizes) post sts have been increased at each end of row. There will be 41 (45, 45) sts in row, cut yarn for Size 8. Work 2 more rows in pattern without inc at beg and end of each row for Size 10, cut yarn. Work 4 more rows (inc as before until 1 post st at each end has been inc for Size 12), cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT: Ch 6 (all sizes). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd ROW: (Armhole edge) 2 dc in 1st dc, post st around next dc, 3 dc in last dc (neck edge), ch 3, turn.

3rd ROW: 3 dc in 1st dc, 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc, post st around next dc, 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in last dc, ch 3, turn.

Continue in pattern as established on Back working armhole incs same as back and continuing incs at neck edge 2 (3, 3) times. Continue in pattern until same row as back for each size, cut yarn.

LEFT FRONT: Work same as Right Front, but work neck edge incs at beg of 2nd row and armhole edge incs at end of 2nd row. Continue shaping until same row as back for each size, cut yarn.

BODY SECTION: Attach yarn in next st of RIGHT Front, work across sts of front working 2 dc in center st of each dc group between all posts sts, work across sts of back and left front in same manner. In next row inc a sufficient number of sts at each underarm to work a post st at underarm. Continue in pattern as established on all sizes until desired length from underarm, cut yarn.

SLEEVES: Ch 6 (10, 10), 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 3 turn.

2nd ROW: 2 dc in 1st dc, post st around next dc, 1 dc in each of the next 0 (3, 3) sts, post st around next st of Size 10 and 12, 2 dc in last dc (all sizes), ch 3, turn.

Continue in pattern as established working incs same as back and ending with same row as back for each size. Then work even for 2 (3, 4) rows. Dec 1 st each end in next row, then dec 1 st each end every one inch 4 (4, 5) times more. Continue even until sleeve is desired length from underarm, cut yarn.

Complete other sleeve to correspond.

POCKETS: Work 2. With Main Color, ch 22, 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 3, turn.

2nd ROW: 1 dc in each of the next 3 dc, * post st around next dc, 1 dc in each of the next 3 dc, repeat from * across row, ch 3, turn

NEXT 9 ROWS: Repeat last row, cut yarn.

With contrasting color work 2 rows of sc all around edge same as jacket.

FINISHING: Block sections to measurements. Matching pattern and rows, weave sleeve seams and weave sleeves in position.

Sew pockets in position.

EDGE: With Contrasting Color, starting at center back, work 1 sc in each dc skipping all post sts. 3 sc in each corner st at lower edge, work 2 sc over each row up front and around neck shaping, work 1 sc in each dc around neck edge skipping all post sts, complete other side, join, ch 1.

2nd ROW: Work 1 sc in each sc all around working 3 sc in corner st at each front, join, cut yarn. Work 2 rows of sc in same manner

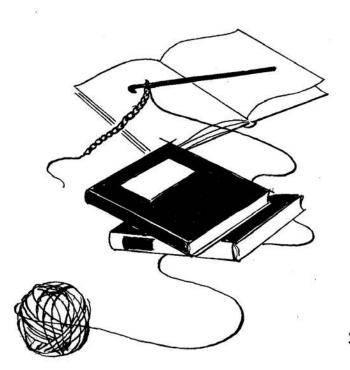
around sleeve edge.

COLLAR: With right side facing, using 2 strands Contrasting Color, join in 1st sc at neck shaping on Right Front, 1 sc in each sc to corresponding sc in Left Front, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: Work 1 double loop st in each sc (double loop st: wind yarn twice around index finger, insert hook in st and under all loops on finger, pick up yarn and pull through, yarn over and complete sc), ch 1, turn.

3rd ROW: 1 sc in each double loop st, ch 1,

4th ROW: Repeat 2nd row, cut yarn.

CORD: With contrasting color work a ch about 90 inches long, cut yarn. Lace through post sts at waist line.

GAUGE: 7 sc = 2 inches

6 sc rows = 2 inches

SACQUE

YOKE: With White, ch 49, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and in each of the next 7 sts of ch (front), 3 sc in next st (inc point), 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts (sleeve), 3 sc in next st (inc point), 1 sc in each of the next 16 sts (back), 3 sc in next st (inc point), 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts (sleeve), 3 sc in next st (inc point), 1 sc in each of the next 8 sts (front); (56 sts), ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Working in front loop of sts, 1 sc in each sc working 3 sc in center st at inc points, ch 1, turn.

ROW 3: Repeat last row but work in back loop of sts, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 4 ROWS: Repeat rows 2 and 3 twice. ROW 8: Repeat row 2; (112 sts), cut yarn, turn.

ROW 9: Working in back loop of sts only, join Yellow with an sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in each of the next 16 sts, ch 2 for underarm, skip 22 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 34 sts, ch 2 for underarm, skip next 22 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 17 sts, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 10: Working in front loop of sts, join White with sl st in 1st st, ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 1 dc in each remaining st and in each st of ch at underarms (72 sts).

ROW 11: Working in back loop of sts, ch 3, 1 dc in each dc and in top of turning ch 3.

NEXT 6 ROWS: Work 1 dc in each alternating front and back loop, cut yarn.

SLEEVES: Working in back loop of sts, with WRONG SIDE OF LAST ROW OF YOKE facing, attach Yellow in 2nd st of Yellow ch 2 at underarm, sc in next White st already worked in, 1 sc in each of the next 22 sts, sc in next st already worked in, sc in next ch, join in 1st sc, cut yarn, turn (26 sc).

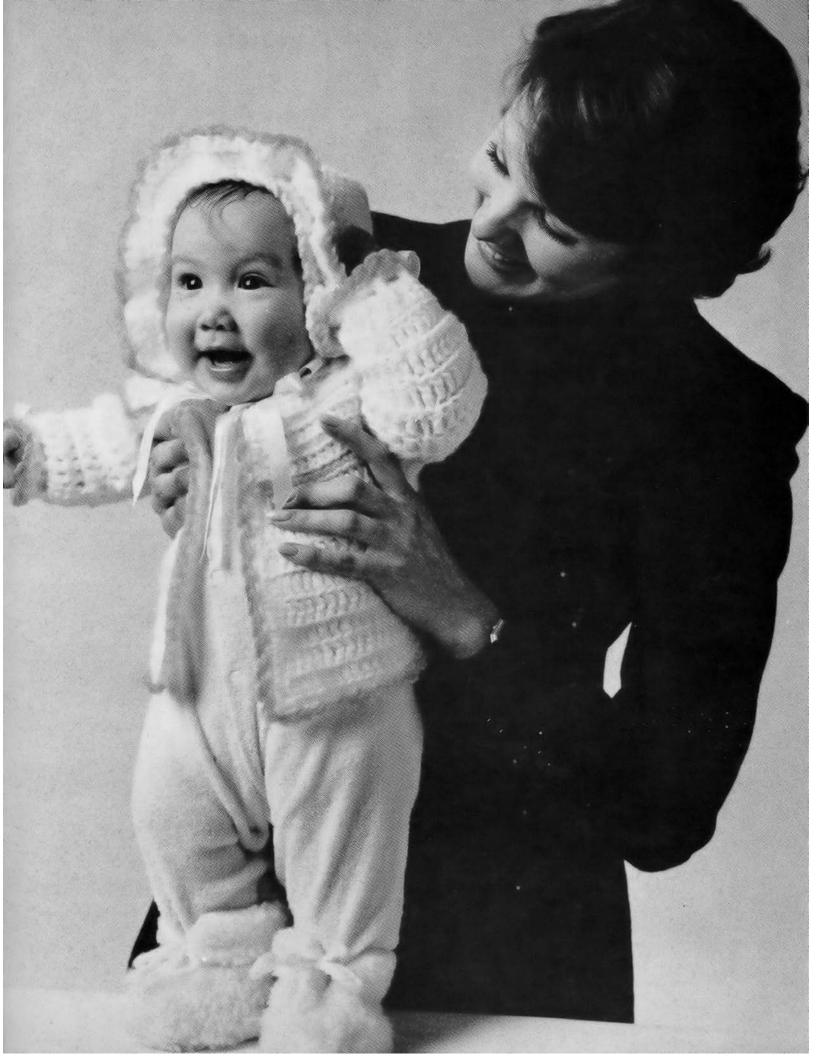
ROUND 2: Working in front loop of sts, attach White with a sl st in joining, ch 3, keeping last loop of each st on hook 1 dc in each of the next 2 sts, yarn over and work off all loops at one time (a dec), 1 dc in each remaining st to within last 2 sts, dec in last 2 sts as before, join in 3rd st of ch, turn (24 dc). ROUND 3: Working in back loop of sts, ch 3, 1 dc in each dc, join in 3rd st of ch 3, turn. ROUND 4: Working in front loop of sts, repeat row 3.

NEXT 4 ROUNDS: Repeat last 2 rounds twice.

ROUND 9: BEADING—Ch 3, skip 1 dc, working in both loops of sts, 1 hdc in next dc, * ch 1, skip 1 dc, 1 hdc in next dc, repeat from * all around, ch 1, join in top of ch 3. ROUND 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in each ch 1 space all around, join in 1st sc, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROUND 11: Attach Yellow in joining with sl st, * ch 2, skip 1 sc, sl st in next sc, repeat from * all around, ch 2, join, cut yarn.

NECK BEADING: With right side of 1st row facing and working on opposite side of starting ch, attach White in 1st st, ch 3, skip 1 st, 1 hdc in next st, * ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 hdc in next st, repeat from * 9 times, ch 1, hdc in next st, * ch 1, skip 1 st, hdc in next st, repeat from last * 11 times, do not turn; working down front, 1 sc in each of the 1st 10 rows of Yoke, * work 3 sc over side of 1st dc, 2 dc over side of next dc row, repeat from last * to corner; 3 sc in corner working in back loop of sts, 1 sc in each st across lower edge, 3 sc in end st, work up other front to correspond, 3 sc in upper corner, 1 sc in each st across neck edge, 3 sc in last st, cut yarn, do not turn.

EDGE: With right side facing, attach Yellow in center st of right front corner, * ch 2, skip 1 st, sl st in next st, repeat from * all around entire outer edge, join, cut yarn.

CAP

FRONT SECTION: With White ch 43, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1 to turn all rows.

ROW 2: Working in back loop of sts 1 sc in each sc.

ROW 3: Working in front loop of sts, 1 sc in each sc. Repeat pattern rows 2 and 3 alternately until section measures 4 inches from beginning ending with 2nd row, cut yarn, turn.

BACK SECTION: Working in back loop of sts, skip 1st 14 sts of front section, join White with an sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 13 sts, ch 1 to turn all rows.

NEXT 7 ROWS: Work in pattern same as sacque.

NEXT ROW: Dec 1 st at beg and end of row (to dec 1 st: skip 1 st),

NEXT ROW: Work even in pattern.

NEXT 2 ROWS: Repeat last 2 rows once.

NEXT ROW: Dec 1 st at beg and end of row, do not turn. Working on side section, work 1 sc over side of each row, 1 sc in next st already worked in, working in back loops of sts, 1 sc in each of the next 14 sts, cut yarn.



Work opposite side to correspond.

FINISHING: Block and steam lightly. Working through back loop of sts only, overcast

back seams together at both sides.

RUFFLE: With right side facing, working along starting ch of front section, attach White in 1st st, work 1 sc in this and remaining sts (42) sc, turn keeping cap to right side.

ROW 2: Ch 3, working in back loop of sts of row just completed, work * 2 dc in next sc, 1 dc in next sc, repeat from * across, ch 1, turn. ROW 3: Working through both loops, 1 sc in each dc, cut yarn, turn.

Work Yellow edge same as Sacque. This completes ruffle.

FRONT EDGE: Join White in 1st free loop of same sc at base of dc row of ruffle, 1 sc in each st across, cut yarn, do not turn. Attach Yellow in 1st sc and work edge same as

Sacque, cut yarn.

BEADING: With right side facing, attach White in corner st, work 45 sc across neck edge ending at opposite corner, turn.

Work beading same as Sacque, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Sl st loosely over each ch 1 space and in each hdc, cut yarn. Lace ribbon through all beadings on cap and sacque.

BABY HATCH

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz. skeins

2 skeins each White and

1 speed Polyester

1 spool Polyester Sewing Thread

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: Each motif is a 6 inch square.

With White ch 2, work 8 sc in 1st st, do not join rounds, place a marker at beg of each round.

ROUND 2: Working in back loop of sts only throughout, * 3 sc in next sc, (corner), 1 sc in next sc, repeat from * 3 times.

ROUNDS 3 TO 8: Work 1 sc in each sc working 3 sc in center st at each corner: (there should be 15 sc between each center st of corners in last round), end sl st to corner to even round, cut yarn.

Work 8 more motifs as above.

Work 9 more motifs alternating colors.

FINISHING: With Polyester transparent thread, sew 3 x 3 motifs together alternating White and Yellow and Yellow and White squares for front of hatch. Work a 2nd section for back. Then sew front and back sections together.

TOP EDGE: Join Yellow with sc in 1st st next to side seam, work 1 sc in each sc all around, join.

ROUND 2: Ch 1, 1 sc in each sc all around, join, cut yarn.

ROUND 3: Join White with an sc in same st as sl st, 1 sc in each sc all around, join.

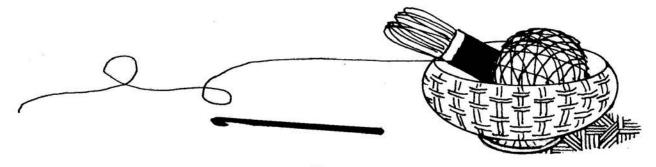
ROUND 4: Ch 3, (counts as 1 st dc), 1 dc in each rem sc, join, cut yarn.



CORD: With double strand White work a ch 60 inches long, cut yarn. Lace cord through dcs at top of hatch

STRAPS: Make 2. With Yellow ch 9, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and in each rem st of ch, ch 1 to turn each row. Continue in sc until strap measures 8 inches or length desired. With White work sc around entire strap.

Sew straps next to one another at center back. Sew 2 buttons to each strap and button into dc at top of hatch on front.

5 Buttons

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 5 sc and 4 ch 1 spaces = 2 inches

CARDIGAN

BACK: With White throughout, ch 58 (62, 66), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, * ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, sc in next ch, repeat from * across, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in 1st sc, * ch 1, sc in next sc,

repeat from * across, ch 1, turn.

Repeat row 2 for pattern until back measures 10 (11, 12) inches from beg or desired length to underarm, allowing 2 inches for border to be worked later.

SHAPE RAGLAN: SI st across 2 sc, work in pattern to within last 2 sc, ch 1, turn. Dec 1 sc at each end of next row, then dec 1 sc each end every 4th row 4 times (all sizes). Then dec 1 sc each end every other row until 12 (12, 14) sc with ch 1 between each sc remain, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT: Ch 30 (34, 38), work in pattern same as back to underarm.

RAGLAN AND NECK SHAPING: SI st across 2 sc for armhole, work in pattern to end of row, ch 1, turn.

Dec 1 sc at arm edge on next row, then every 4th row on arm edge 4 times (all sizes). AT THE SAME TIME dec 1 sc at neck edge every 4th row 4 (5, 6) times, then every other row 2 (2, 3) times; decreasing at arm edge twice more, cut yarn.

LEFT FRONT: Work same as right front reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES: Ch 30 (34, 38), work in pattern for 3 inches.

Inc 1 sc each side of next row, then inc 1 sc each side every 8th row twice. Work even on the 21 (23, 25) sc (with ch 1 between) until sleeve measures 9 (10, 11) inches from beg allowing 2 inches for border (to be worked later).

RAGLAN SLEEVE CAP: Sl st across 2 sc, work to within 2 sc, ch 1, turn. Dec 1 sc each end on next row, then every other row until 3 sc with ch 1 between remain, cut yarn.

SLEEVE BORDER: Join yarn on right side of work at cuff edge with sl st, ch 8, 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, sl st across 2 sts of sleeve, turn.

R OW 2: Skip the 2 sl sts, 1 sc in each sc working in back loops of each sc, ch 1, turn. ROW 3: 1 sc in each sc, sl st in 2 sts on sleeve.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 across sleeve, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew raglan sleeves to fronts and back.

Sew side and sleeve seams.

WAISTBAND: Join yarn in right front at lower edge. Work border seam as sleeve across waistband.

NECK AND FRONT BANDS: Join yarn at lower edge on right side of work, work a row of sc up right front, around neck and down left front, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.

Mark for 5 evenly spaced buttons on left front for boy, right front for girl, having 1st marker ½ inch below 1st neck dec and last marker ½ inch above lower edge, remaining markers evenly spaced between.

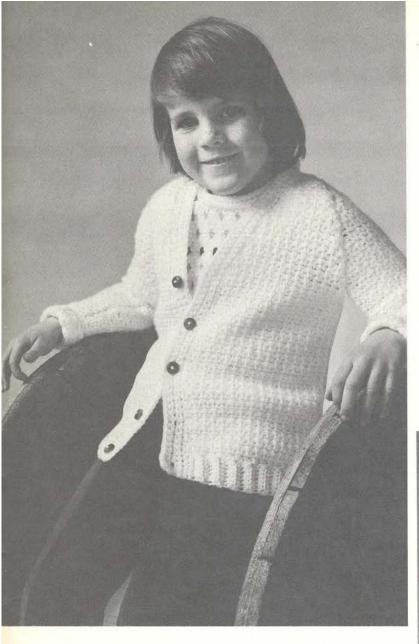
ROW 3: Work buttonholes opposite markers. Buttonholes: Ch 1, skip 1 sc.

ROW 4: 1 sc in each sc and in ch 1 space of buttonhole.

ROW 5: 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Steam sections lightly. Sew seams and sew buttons in position.

PULLOVER

BACK: With White ch 54 (58, 62), drop White, do not cut, holding yarn in back of work, with Navy ch 1, sc in 4th ch from hook, drop Navy, with White ch 1, skip 1 ch, sc in next ch, drop White, * with Navy ch 1, skip 1 ch, sc in next ch, drop Navy, with White ch 1, skip 1 ch, sc in next ch, repeat from * across, cut Navy, ch 2, turn.

ROWS 2, 3 & 4: With White, 1 sc in next ch 1 space, * ch 1, 1 sc in next ch 1 space, repeat from * across working last sc in ch 2 space at end of row, ch 2, turn.

ROW 4: Sc over 1st ch 1 space, drop White, with Gold ch 1, sc over next ch 1 space, drop Gold, with White ch 1, sc over next ch 1 space, repeat from * across, end ch 1, sc over end loop, cut Gold, ch 2, turn.

ROWS 5, 6 & 7: Repeat row 2, 3 & 4, end ch 1, turn.

ROW 8: With Aqua ch 1 more, sc over 1st ch 1 space, * with White ch 1, sc over next ch 1 space, with Aqua ch 1, sc over next ch 1 space, repeat from * across, end with White ch 1, sc over end space.

Repeat from 2nd through 8th rows and follow color sequence until back measures 8 (9, 10) inches from beg or is desired length to underarm. (Allowing 2 inches for border, end with 4th or 8th pattern row).

NEXT ROW: With White repeat 2nd row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Sl st to 3rd ch 1 space, work across row to within 3rd ch 1 space from end, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: SI st in 1st ch 1 space, ch 2, sc in next ch 1 space, continue in pattern to within one ch 1 space, ch 1, pull up a loop in next ch 1 space and turning ch, yarn over and pull through all loops on hook, end ch 2, turn (8-ch 1 spaces decreased).

SHOULDER: Work in pattern across 5 ch 1 spaces, ch 2, turn. Work even until armholes measure 5½ (6, 6½) inches, cut yarn.

Work other shoulder to correspond.

FRONT: Work same as back. Continue in color sequence same as back to underarm.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Work same as back. Continue in pattern until armholes measure 3 (3½, 4) inches, end on wrong side.

NECK AND SHOULDER SHAPING: Work across 7 (all sizes) ch 1 spaces, ch 2, turn. Dec 1 st at neck edge every other row twice. Work even until shoulder is same length as back, cut yarn. Work other shoulder to correspond.

BORDER: (LOWER EDGE) Starting at side seam with White, work border same as cardigan. Sew seam.

NECK BAND: Join White on left shoulder seam with sc, work a row of sc taking care to keep work flat, join, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Working in back loops of sts only, 1 sc in each sc all around, join, ch 1, turn.

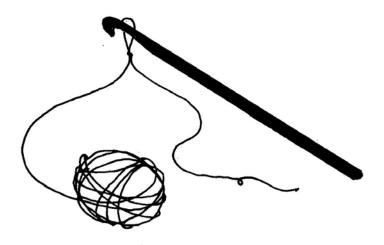
ROW 3: Repeat last row, join, ch 1, turn.

ROW 4: Working in back loops of each sc, work 1 sl st in each sc, join, cut yarn.

SLEEVES: Ch 39 (43, 47), work in same pattern as back for 4 inches.

SHAPE CAP: Repeat the 2 rows of armhole shaping of back armhole shaping, then dec a ch 1 space on each side of next row, then every other row 2 (3, 4) times more, cut yarn.

Sew sleeve seam. Sew sleeve in place. BORDER: Join yarn at underarm and work same as neck band.

White (all sizes)

5 Buttons

H Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: 4 sts = 1 inch

Directions are for Size 36-38. Changes for sizes 40-42 and 44-46 are given in parentheses.

BACK: With Red, ch 81 (89, 97), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn; 80 (88, 96) sts.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each sc.

Repeat row 2 for pattern until section measures 10 inches from beg or desired length to underarm. (There will be a 2 inch border to be worked later).

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Sl st across 1st 4 (5, 6) sts, work to within last 4 (5, 6) sts; ch 1, turn. Dec 1 st at beg and end of every other row 4 (5, 6) times. Work even on the 64 (68, 72) sts until armholes measure 9 (10, 11) inches from underarm.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Sl st across 1st 8 (8, 9) sts, work to within last 8 (8, 9) sts, ch 1, turn. Repeat last row once more, cut yarn; 32 (36, 36) sts for back of neck.

RIGHT FRONT: With Red, ch 43 (47, 53), 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each of the next 3 (5, 3) sts of ch, * ch 1, skip 1 ch, 1 sc in each of the next 2 chs, ch 1, skip 1 ch, 1 sc in each of the next 6 sts of ch, repeat from * across ending last repeat with 1 sc in each of the last 4 (6, 4) sts of ch, working last sc off with White, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: 1 sc in each of the next 4 (6, 4) sc, * ch 1, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, ch 1, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in each of the next 6 sc, repeat from * across.

Repeat row 2 working 2 rows White and 6 rows Red until there are same number of rows as back to underarm.

SHAPE ARMHOLES AND NECK: Work same as back and AT THE SAME TIME dec 1

st at neck edge every other row 18 (20, 22) times. Work even on the 16 (16, 18) sts to match shoulder to back. Work shoulder same as back.

LEFT FRONT: Work same as right front reversing all shaping.

VERTICAL STRIPES: Starting in the 1st ch 1 space from front edge, with White work a ch st through each ch 1 space in each row working from lower edge to shoulder of sweater. Repeat vertical stripe with Black in next ch 1 space. Work through each ch 1 space alternating colors White and Black. Continue in this manner to side edge. Complete other front to correspond.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder and side seams.

BORDER: Join Red on lower edge of left front on right side of work, ch 11, work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, sl st across 2 sts on waistband edge of vest, turn.

ROW 2: Skip the 2 sl sts, work 1 sc in each sc working in back loops of sts only, ch 1, turn. ROW 3: 1 sc in each sc working in back loops of sts only, sl st across 2 sts in vest, turn. Repeat rows 2 and 3 across lower edge of

vest, cut yarn.

NECK AND FRONT BANDS: Join Red on right side at lower right front and work a row of sc up right front, around neck (holding neck edge in slightly), work sc down left front to corner, ch 1, turn. (Make sure you have same number of sc down each front and neck edge), ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Working in back loop of sts, work 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.

Repeat 2nd row 3 more times.

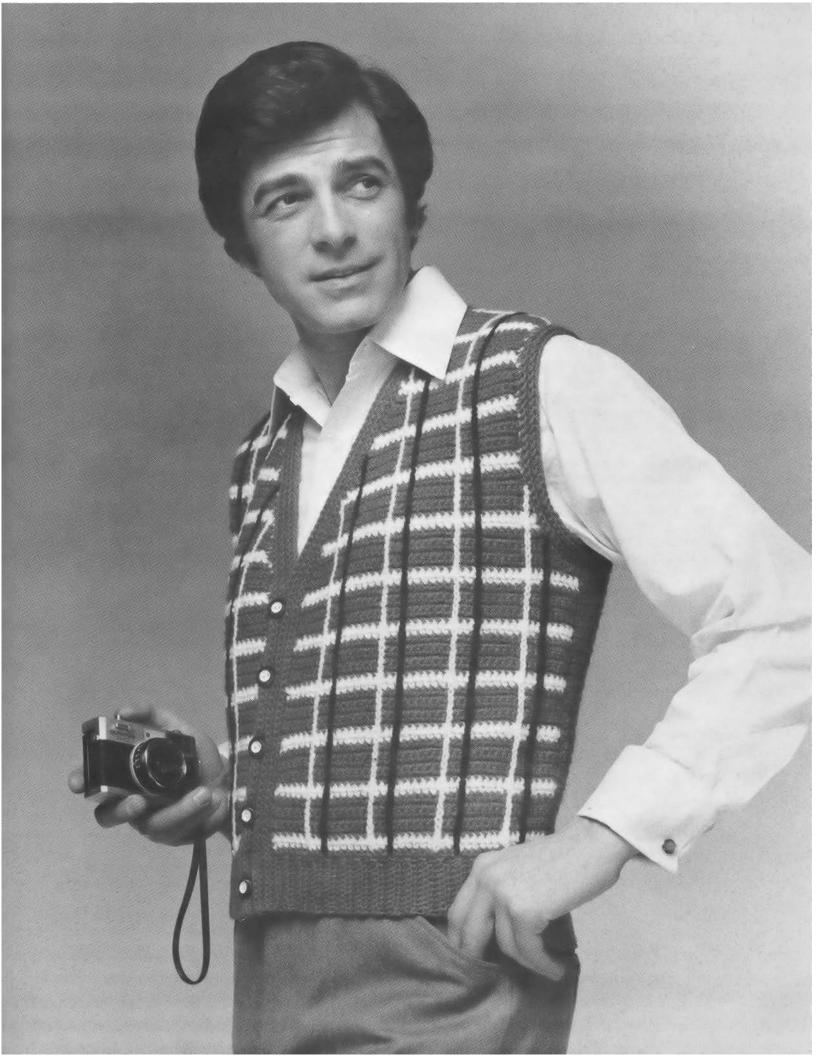
Mark position for 5 evenly spaced buttons, having 1st button 1 inch below neck edge, last button 1 inch above lower edge and the others evenly spaced between. In next row work buttonholes opposite markers.

Buttonholes: Ch 2, skip 2 sc. On next row work 1 sc in each ch 2 loop of buttonhole.

ARMBANDS: Join Red at underarm seam. Work 1 row of sc working sufficient sc to keep work flat, join, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Working in back-loop of sts only, work 1 sc in each st, join, ch 1, turn.

Repeat 2nd row 3 times more, join, cut yarn. Steam lightly. Sew buttons in position at markers.

skeins

7 (7, 8) skeins Red

6 Buttons

F Crochet Hook & G Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RE-SULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE for G Hook: 3 sts = 1 inch; 6 rows = 2½ inches

Directions are given for size 38-40. Changes for sizes 42-44 and 46-48 are given in parentheses.

BACK: With F hook, ch 65 (71, 77), work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch; 62 (68, 74) dc, ch 1, turn.

Continue in pattern same as Row 2 and 3 of slipover on page 47 for 6 inches. Change to G hook and work until section measures 16½ inches or desired length to underarm.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: SI st in each of the 1st 6 sts, work to within last 6 sts. Dec 1 st each side in next 2 rows; 46 (52, 58) sts remain. Work even until armholes measure 10½ (11, 11½) inches.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: SI st in each of the 1st 7 (8, 9) sts, work to within last 7 (8, 9) sts. Repeat last row once more, cut yarn; 18 (20, 22) sts remain for back of neck.

RIGHT FRONT: With F hook, ch 36 (39, 42), work 1 dc in 4th st from hook and in each remaining st of ch; 33 (36, 39) dc, ch 1, turn. Continue in pattern for 6 inches ending with a long dc row at front edge. Change to size G hook and continue until same length as back to underarm, end at front edge.

SHAPE ARMHOLE AND V-NECK: Work armhole same as back. AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at end of each of next 11 (12, 13) sc rows for neck shaping. Work on remaining 14 (16, 18) sts until same length as back to shoulder.

SHAPE SHOULDER: Work same as back, cut yarn.

LEFT FRONT: Work same as right front reversing all shaping, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT BAND: Using G hook, ch 6, work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn. * Working in back loop of sts only, work 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn. Repeat from * working 3 rows of sc for each (1 sc, 1 dc) row of pattern until required length has been reached. Work 3 (34, 3½) more inches for back of neck, cut

yarn. Pin band in place on right front edge. Mark position for 6 evenly spaced buttons on right front band having top button about ¼ inch below neck shaping and last button about 1 inch above lower edge, remaining 4 buttons evenly spaced between.

LEFT FRONT BAND: Work same as right front band working buttonholes to correspond to markers. Buttonholes: Work 2 sc, ch 2, skip 2 sc, 1 sc in last sc, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each sc working 2 sc in each ch 2 of buttonhole. Complete band same as right front band.

SLEEVES: With F hook, ch 29 (29, 32), work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch; 26 (26, 29) dc, ch 1, turn. Work even in pattern for 1½ inches.

NEXT ROW: Inc 1 st each side.

Repeat inc row every 1½ inches 11 (12, 12) more times, always working inc sts into established pattern, and changing to G hook after 6 inches has been completed. Work even on the 50 (52, 55) sts until sleeve is 19 inches or desired length to underarm.

SHAPE CAP: SI st in each of the 1st 5 sts, work to within last 5 sts.

NEXT AND EVERY FOLLOWING ROW: Dec 1 st at beg and end of row until 8 (8, 11) sts remain, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew bands to front edges and to back of neck. Sew sleeves in position. Press seams. Sew buttons in position opposite buttonholes.

strips of Silver and 6 strips of Aqua. Work other half the same. Join next Aqua strip of 90(96-102) loops to both halves. Join 9 more strips to match back. Sew side seams.

WAISTBAND: On right side, join yarn at side seam and work 1 row of sc around, holding in slightly, join. Work 3 more rows working 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn.

EDGE ON SPLIT: On right side of work, join yarn at lower right edge and work 1 row of sc, keeping work flat around split, ch 1, turn. Work 1 row of double loop stitch working 1 double loop st in each sc. (Double Loop St: Insert hook in 1st st, winding yarn clockwise, wind yarn twice around index finger, insert hook from left to right through loops on finger, pick up both loops and pull through st, drop loops from finger, yarn over and pull through all loops on hook.)

TIE: With 2 strands of Aqua, work a 60 inch ch. Lace as illustrated.

17 (19) skeins Natural 4 skeins Toast both sizes 6 (7) skeins Wood Brown

J (K) Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: Size J hook; 3 sts = 1 inch Size K hook; 11 sts = 4 inches

Same directions are used for both sizes. Change of hook will adjust the size. Hook for larger size is given in parentheses.

BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS: Width across back at underarm 24 (26)"; width across each front at underarm not including border 12 (13)"

BACK: With Natural and J (K) hook, ch 73, sc in 2nd st from hook, * ch 1, leaving loops on hook pull up a ½" loop in each of next 2 sts, yarn over and work off all loops at one time (pattern), repeat from * across ch, end sc in last st, ch 1, turn. (Note: There will always be a ch 1 after the 1st sc but not before the last sc)

ROW 2: Sc in 1st sc, * ch 1, work a pattern over next 2 sts, repeat from * across row, end sc in last sc (pattern row). Repeat last row twice, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 5: Attach Brown in 1st st, work in pattern, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 6: Attach Toast in 1st sc, work 1 sc in each st (72 sts), ch 1, turn.

ROW 7: 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 8: Attach Brown in 1st sc, 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 9: Attach Natural in 1st sc, repeat last

ROW 10: Attach Brown, 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.

ROW 11: 1 sc in each sc, drop Brown, turn. ROWS 12 TO 18: Work in sc following chart for Back starting at A. Carry colors not being used loosely on wrong side and pick up new color from under dropped color, completing last half of st with next color. With Brown, ch 1 to turn last row.

ROWS 19 AND 20: 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn, do not turn last row.

ROW 21: With Natural, 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 22: With Brown, 1 sc in each sc, cut yarn, turn.

ROWS 23 AND 24: With Toast, 1 sc in each sc, ch 1 to turn each row.

ROW 25: With Brown, work in pattern, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 26: With Natural, work in pattern, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 15 ROWS: Work in pattern. Repeat from the 5th to the 26th row once.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Row 1: Sl st across 1st 6 sts, ch 1, sc in next st, work in pattern to within last 7 sts, sc in next st (60 sts), ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: Pull up a loop in each of 1st 3 sts, yarn over and work off all loops at one time (a dec), ch 1, continue in pattern across row to within last 3 sts, work a dec (56 sts).

Work 1 row even. Repeat last 2 rows 3 times (44 sts). Work even in pattern until armholes measure 8 (8½)" from 1st shaping.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: SI st across 1st 6 sts, sc in next st, ch 1, work 3 patterns, sc in next st, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Sc in sc, ch 1, work 2 patterns, sc in next st, sl st in next st, cut yarn. Skip 16 sts at center, attach Natural in next st, sc in same space, ch 1, work 3 patterns, sl st in next st, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: Skip the sl st, sl st across next 5 sts, sc in next st, work in pattern across rem sts, cut yarn.

POCKETS: (Make 2) With Natural, ch 24, 1 dc in 4th st from hook and in each rem st of ch, turn.

ROW 2: Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), 1 dc in each rem dc, turn.

Repeat last row 6 times, cut yarn, turn.

ROW 9: With Toast, work 1 sc in each st, cut yarn, do not turn.

ROW 10: With Brown, work in pattern, cut yarn. Set aside.

RIGHT FRONT: With Natural, ch 37, work same as back following chart for front to row 25.

ROW 26: With Natural, work in pattern across 1st 7 sts, ch 1, pull up a loop in next st, then pull up a loop in 2nd st of Brown row of one pocket section, yarn over and work off all loops at one time, ch 1, work 9 patterns across top of pocket section, ch 1, pull up a loop in next st, skip 20 sts of front section, pull up a loop in next st, yarn over and work off all loops at one time, continue in pattern across front, ch 1, turn.

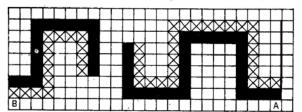

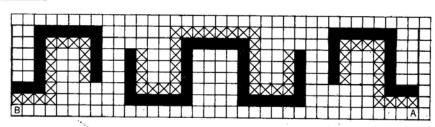

NEXT ROW: (LARGE SIZE). 1 sc in each of the next 11 sts, 1 dc in each of the next 9 sts, 5 dc in center st at point, 1 dc in each of the next 9 sts, 1 sc in each remaining st, join, ch 1, turn.

NEXT 5 ROWS: (LARGE SIZE). Work 1 sc in each sc, 1 dc in each dc working 5 dc in center dc of 5 dc group, joining and turning each row, cut yarn. This completes instep and foot for large size.

SOLE: With Navy and double strand of yarn, ch 18 (21), 2 dc in 4th st from hook, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next 4 (5) sts, 1 hdc in each of the next 4 (5) sts, 1 sc in each of the next 4 (5) sts, 3 sc in last st, working on opposite side of starting ch, 1 sc in each of the next 4 (5) sts, 1 hdc in each of the next 4 (5) sts, 1 dc in each of the next 4 (5) sts, 2 dc in next st, join in 3rd st of ch, do not turn.

ROUND 2: Working through both loops of sts, ch 3, dc in same space, 2 dc in each of the next 3 (3) sts, 1 dc in each of the next 12 (15) sts, 2 dc in each of the next 2 (2) sts, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in each of the next 2 (2) sts, 1 dc in each of the next 12 (15) sts, 2 dc in next dc, join.

ROUND 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in each of the next 8 (8) sts, 1 sc in each of the next 15 (18) sts, 2 sc in each of next 6 sts, 1 sc in each of the next 15 (18) sts, 2 sc in next st, join, cut yarn.

With double strand of Navy, join sole to top section with a row of sc, join, cut yarn. Work other boot in same manner.

With right side facing and B, work a row of sl sts around zipper opening.

HEM: With right side of work facing, starting at center back with B, work 2 rows of sc all around, then work 1 sc in each sc working sc from left to right and in back loops of sts, cut yarn.

Join bodice to skirt as follows: Overlap the bodice edging on waistline of skirt, so the side seams, back openings coincide and the center front of skirt is at center front of bodice. Adjust any fullness in skirt evenly all around. Top stitch bodice to skirt just below edging. Sew zipper in place.

Then dec 1 mesh at armhole edge every row until 51 (51, 58) ch 1 spaces remain. Work even in pattern until there are 22 (24, 25) rows of mesh pattern in all, cut thread.

LEFT SIDE OF PANEL: Work to correspond to right side reversing shaping as follows: join thread in 4th ch at corner of neck edge.

Starting this side at neck edge automatically

reverses the shaping.

BLOUSE FRONT: Left Half: Work in same manner as for right half of back, over 7 (7,8) roses for 2 rows, then inc 1 mesh at end of row, ch 90 (92, 94) for side of neck. Work across ch same as back, 93 (94, 102) ch 1 spaces. Continue in same manner as back dec at shoulder edge, same as right half of back. Work even until there are 11 rows of mesh, end at hem edge, turn.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: Work across 55 (55, 62) ch 1 spaces, dec 1 mesh, turn. Dec 1 mesh at armhole edge every row until 51 (51, 58) ch 1 spaces remain. Work even until there are 22 (24, 25) mesh rows, cut thread.

RIGHT SIDE: Join thread in 4th ch of corner, ch 7 at neck. Work in same manner as for left side of back, complete the right front to correspond to left front reversing shaping.

FINISHING: Join front to back at shoulders and side seams. With right side of work facing, join thread at neck edge of right shoulder seam, work 2 sc in each space 4 times along straight sides of neck, 1 sc in next space, work 2 sc over side of each dc post or ch; across rose panels, work 2 sc in 1st and last loops, and 3 sc in each rem loop between.

NEXT ROUND: Continue in sc around neck, dec 1 sc 3 times at neck corners and 5 (5,6) times at even intervals across each rose panel. NEXT ROUND: Work in sc, dec at even intervals as follows: once at each shoulder seam, twice across each side of back of neck, twice at each of the 4 corners, 4 times along each side of the fronts.

NEXT ROUND: * Ch 3, skip 3 sc, sc in next sc, repeat from * around.

NEXT ROUND: Work a shell in each loop as follows: 1 sc, 1 dc, ch 3, sl st in 1st ch for picot, 1 dc, 1 sc, sl st in next sc, end with sl st in 1st sc of last round.

ARMHOLES: With right side facing, join thread at underarm seam, around curve work

2 sc over each ch or post of dc, work along straight edge same as neck.

NEXT ROUND: Work in sc same as neck dec at even intervals.

NEXT 2 ROUNDS: Repeat last 2 rounds of neck dec as necessary in 3rd round, cut thread at end of 4th round.

LOWER EDGE: Join thread in side seam, work 2 sc over each dc post or ch along edge, join.

NEXT 2 ROUNDS: Work 1 sc in each sc, join each round.

4th ROUND: Repeat last round of neck edge.

MATERIALS: Knitting Worsted-4 oz. skeins 4(4, 5) skeins White

G Crochet Hook OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN GUAGE BELOW

GAUGE: 3 sts = 1 inch; 6 rows = 2½ inches Directions are given for Size 38-40. Changes for Sizes 42-44 and 46-48 are given in parentheses.

BACK: Ch 62 (68, 74), work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each rem st of ch; 59 (65, 71) dc, ch 1, turn.

ROW 2: (Wrong side) Work 1 sc in each dc, ch 3, turn.

ROW 3: Work 1 dc in each of next 2 sc, * yarn over hook, insert hook from right to left under the post of next dc of row below, work 1 long dc, skip the sc in back of long dc just worked, work 1 dc in each of the next 2 sc, repeat from * across row, ch 1, turn.

Repeat last 2 rows for pattern working long dc under long dc of previous row until 9½ inches or desired length to underarm. (Note: 6 inch ribbed border will be worked later) SHAPE ARMHOLES: Sl st in each of the next 3 sts, work to within last 3 sts, turn.

Repeat last row once, then dec 1 st each side of next 3 rows; 41 (47, 53) sts remain. Work even until armholes measure 10 (10½, 11) inches.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Sl st in each of the 1st 5 sts, work to within last 5 sts, turn.

NEXT ROW: SI st in each of the 1st 6 (9, 9) sts, work to within last 6 (9, 9) sts, cut yarn.

19 (19, 25) sts remain for back of neck.

FRONT: Work same as back until section measures same as back to underarm. On last row, dec center st, drop yarn. Join another skein of yarn and work to end of row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES AND NECK: Working both shoulders at one time, work armholes same as back. At the same time shape neck: dec 1 st at neck edge only in each of the next 9 (9,12) sc rows. Work on remaining 11 (14, 14) sts until same length as back to shoulder. SHAPE SHOULDER: Work same as for back, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew shoulder and side seams. BANDS: Armholes and Neck: ch 6, work same as for front band of cardigan working in back loop of sts only.

WAISTBAND: Ch 26, turn, work 1 sc in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

NEXT ROW: 1 sc in each sc, ch 1, turn. Repeat last row for length required. Sew bands in position to edges.

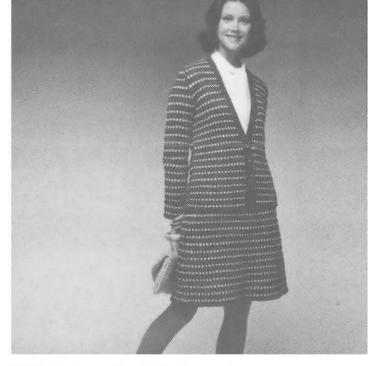

ROW 2: Attach Fisherman in 1st dc, ** sc in 1st dc, * ch 1, skip 1 dc, 1 sc in next dc, repeat from * across, ch 4, drop Fisherman, do not turn.



ROW 3: Insert hook in dropped Raspberry loop at beg of row, ch 1, sc in 1st sc, sc in next ch 1, * ch 1, sc in next loop, repeat from * across working 1 sc in last sc, turn.

ROW 4: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), then work 1 dc in each remaining sc and in each ch 1 loop,

drop Raspberry, do not turn.

ROW 5: Insert hook in last loop of dropped ch 4 Fisherman loop at beg of row, sc in top st of Raspberry ch, * ch 1, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, repeat from * across, ch 4, drop Fisherman, turn.

ROW 6: Insert hook in dropped Raspberry loop, ch 1, 1 sc in 1st sc, sc in next ch 1 loop, * ch 1, sc in next ch 1 loop, repeat from * across row, end sc in last sc, turn.

ROW 7: Repeat row 4, but turn at end of row and pick up Fisherman.

Then repeat from ** of row 2 to row 7 for pattern taking care to have Fisherman sts directly over Fisherman sts of previous rows. Continue in pattern as established until section measures 4 inches, end with 1st pattern row; then dec 2 sc as follows: work 2nd row in pattern to within last 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st; work 3rd pattern row, but omit last sc; this dec's 2 sc on one side edge.

Work 2 inches even in pattern, end with 4th pattern row. Dec 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc rows as follows: work 5th pattern row to within last 2 sts, skip 1 st, sc in last st; in 6th pattern row, pull up a loop in each of the 1st 2 sts, yarn over and work off all loops at one time, sc in next loop, complete row in pattern; this dec's 1 sc in each of 2 sc rows on other side edge.

Repeat dec rows on alternate sides 5 times more.

CHAIN STITCH

*Put yarn over hook from back to front and pull thru loop on hook for first chain stitch; repeat from * for desired number of stitches.

SLIP STITCH

Insert hook under one strand only from front to back in 2nd stitch of foundation chain (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook from back to front. Pull yarn thru both stitch and loop at the same time to complete slip stitch.

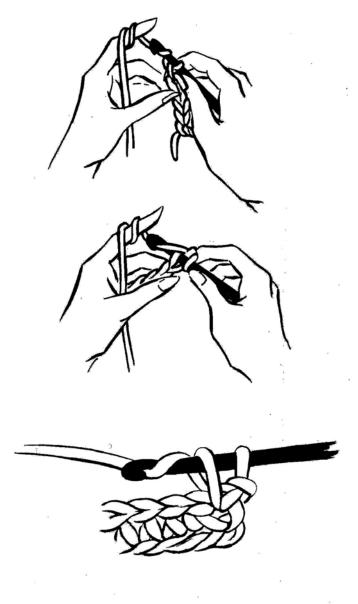
Work a slip stitch in each stitch along foundation chain.

If slip stitches are not worked in foundation chain, insert hook under 2 top strands of stitch below.

SINGLE CROCHET

1st ROW: Make foundation chain; insert hook in 2nd stitch from hook. Yarn over hook from back to front, pull up a loop thru stitch on hook (2 loops on hook). Yarn over hook again and draw thru 2 loops on hook completing first single crochet. Do second stitch in same manner, inserting hook in next stitch.

2nd ROW: Ch 1, turn, insert hook under 2 top strands of sc below and complete sc exactly as before.

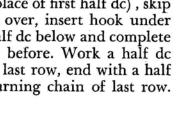


HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

1st ROW: Make foundation chain; yarn over hook from back to front, insert hook in 3rd st from hook.

Yarn over hook from back to front, pull up a loop thru stitch on hook (3 loops on hook); yarn over hook again and draw thru all 3 loops on hook (completing half dc); work a half dc in each chain st.

2nd ROW: Ch 2, turn, (the turning chain usually takes the place of first half dc), skip first half dc, yarn over, insert hook under 2 top strands of half dc below and complete half dc exactly as before. Work a half dc in each half dc of last row, end with a half de in top st of turning chain of last row.

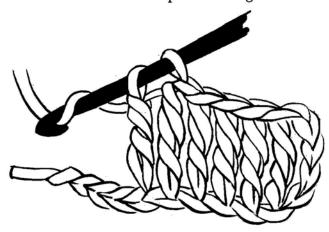

Directions are given for Size 8-10. Changes for Sizes 12-14 and Size 16 are given in parentheses.

PATTERN STITCH: Work same as Skirt on page 47 but reverse colors.

BACK: With Fisherman ch 67 (69, 73), 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and in each remaining st of ch; 65 (67, 71) sts across ch. Continue in pattern same as skirt on page 6 until back section measures 7½ (7½, 7¾) inches.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Sl st across 1st 4 sts, work to within last 4 sts. Dec 1 st each side in next 4 rows. Work on remaining 49 (51, 55) sts until armholes measure 7½ (7½, 7¾) inches.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: SI st across 7 sts (all sizes), work to within last 7 sts. In next row sl st across 1st 7 (8, 9) sts, work to within last 7 (8, 9) sts; 21 (21, 23) sts remain for back of neck.

FRONT: Work same as back until 5¼ (5½, 5¾) inches have been completed above 1st row of armhole shaping.

NECK: Work 19 (20, 21) sts, sl st across 11 (11, 13) center sts, work to end of row. At neck edge, sl st across 2 sts, then dec 1 st in next 3 rows at neck edge. Work on remaining 14 (15, 16) sts until armhole is same length as back armhole to shoulder.

SHAPE SHOULDER: Work same as back. Work 2nd shoulder to correspond.

FINISHING: Sew left shoulder.

TURTLE NECK: With knitting needle and Main Color, starting at back of neck, pick up 24 (26, 28) sts, pick up 20 (24, 26) sts from shoulder seam to center, pick up 2 sts in each st across the center sts, pick up 20 (24, 26) sts from center to shoulder. Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 6 inches. Bind off in ribbing.

Sew 2nd shoulder and weave turtle neck seam together.

ARMHOLE BAND: With right side toward you, pick up 64 (70, 76) sts around armhole edge. Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for ¾ inch. Bind off in ribbing.

Complete other armband in same manner.

BORDER: (Back and Front alike) With right side toward you, pick up 1 st in each of 1st 23 (23, 24) sts, then pick up 2 sts in each of the 18 (20, 22) center sts, pick up 24 (24, 25) across remaining sts. Work in K 1, P 1 ribbing for 5 inches or desired length. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

Sew side seams together. Press all seams on wrong side.

Work should measure 18 inches and 72 (79, 83) sts remain. Work even until skirt is 1 inch shorter than desired length, cut yarn.

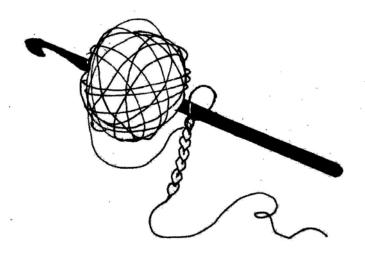

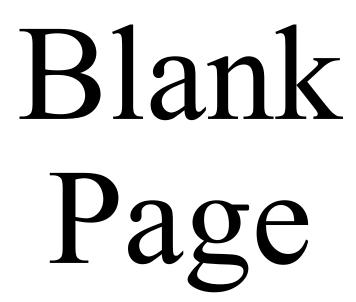
